SUNDAY IN THE PARK: The Wisconsin Timber			
Rattlers beat the South Bend Cubs 2-1 at Neuroscience			
Group Field. Alexander Cornielle pitched six shutout			
innings. The Cubs scored a run in the seventh inning			
before Aaron Rund closed out the game with a			
scoreless eighth and a scoreless ninth. Wisconsin			
scored their runs on an RBI grounder by Jadher			
Areinamo in the first inning and an RBI grounder by			
Tayden Hall in the fourth inning. The win was the fourth			
straight for the Rattlers.			

**CAN OF CORN:** Cornielle retired the first nine Cubs of the game. He allowed three hits, walked one, and struck out five for a quality start and his fourth win of the season.

AND ANOTHER: Areinamo was 1-for-4 with an RBI and a run scored yesterday to extend his current hitting streak to fourteen games (21-for-53; .396) during this streak, the longest by a Wisconsin hitter this season. This is the third-longest streak by a Timber Rattler in the High-A Era of the team. Je'Von Ward (17 games) and LG Castillo (15 games) each had longer hitting streaks in 2021.

WE BELIEVE IN AARON: Rund earned his second save by getting the final six outs of the game. He was 1-1 with two saves and allowed two runs with fifteen strikeouts over 14-2/3 innings in eight games during June. In their three-game winning streak, Wisconsin pitchers have allowed three runs, walked four, and struck out 21

**WHAT A RUN:** In the last five games, Wisconsin starting pitchers are 4-0 with a 0.69 ERA. They have combined to allow two runs on twelve hits with four walks and 24 strikeouts in 26 innings pitched.

**PUT IT IN PLAY:** The Timber Rattlers hitters have struck out the fewest times and average the fewest strikeouts per game among all full season MiLB teams. Wisconsin has struck out 504 times in 75 games (6.72/game). Memphis, of the International League, has struck out 556 times in 81 games (6.86/game).

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's fourth season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Billy Gardner Jr is in his second season as the manager of the Sky Carp. Prince Fielder, Rickie Weeks, Chris Bosio, Greg Vaughn, Joey Meyer, BJ Surhoff, Tim Dillard, and Mitch Stetter played in Beloit.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021

# PITCHING MATCHUP

#### WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP MARK MANFREDI:** The Milwaukee Brewers selected Manfredi in the 9<sup>th</sup> round of the 2023 draft out of the University of Dayton.

**THE COLLEGE BEFORE COLLEGE:** Manfredi pitched two abbreviated seasons at Sinclair Community College in Dayton before moving to the University of Dayton. Manfredi was 2-1 with a 3.38 ERA in seven games – three starts – in his two seasons at Sinclair.

RADIO FLYER: Manfredi pitched two seasons at Dayton. He was 4-6 with a 4.42 ERA in 29 games – 24 starts – with 158 strikeouts over 138-1/3 innings pitched. Manfredi finished third in the Atlantic 10 in strikeouts for his senior season.

**SUMMER CATCH:** Manfredi made three starts for Wareham in the Cape Cod League prior to the 2023 draft. He had 16 strikeouts over 13 innings with a 2.08 ERA with three no decisions before signing with Milwaukee.

**PLAYOFF CALL:** Manfredi did not pitch as a professional in the regular season last year. However, he was the starting pitcher for the ACL Brewers in their semifinal playoff game against the ACL Rockies on August 24, 2023. He pitched a scoreless inning with a walk and three strikeouts.

**LAST START:** Manfredi lost to South Bend at home on <u>June 25</u>. He allowed six runs on six hits with two hit batsmen, a walk, and three strikeouts in four innings.

VS. BELOIT: Manfredi had a no decision against Beloit at home on May 15. He allowed a run on three hits with two walks and six strikeouts over four innings.

#### **BELOIT STARTING PITCHER:**

RHP JACOB MILLER: The Miami Marlins selected Miller in the second round of the 2022 draft out of Liberty Union High School in Baltimore, Ohio.

**IS IT IN YOU?** Miller was the Gatorade Player of the Year for Ohio in his senior season after he was 9-1 with 133 strikeouts in 57 innings.

RATINGS: MLB Pipeline places Miller as the #15 prospect in the Marlins system. Baseball America's recent update puts him at #14.

**GETTING YOUR FEET WET:** Miller was 0-2 in four starts in the Marlins system in 2022. He was 0-1 in three starts for Miami's Florida Complex League team and 0-1 in a brief start in which he allowed an unearned run for the Jupiter Hammerheads in the Florida State League. He allowed six runs – three earned – on five hits with two walks and six strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings in 2022.

**SWIMMING WITH SHARKS:** Miller spent most of his 2023 season with Jupiter with just two rehab appearances in the FCL. He was 2-4 in fourteen starts with a 4.70 ERA and 50 strikeouts over 59-1/3 innings for Jupiter last season.

**LAST START:** Miller won at Cedar Rapids on June 25. He allowed an unearned run on four hits with two walks and four strikeouts over seven innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Miller lost at Wisconsin on May 14. He allowed five runs on six hits with two walks, a hit batsman, and two strikeouts over two innings. Matt Wood homered in the first inning against Miller.
