**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** [The Beloit Sky Carp beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 5-4 in twelve innings.](#) Cody Morrissette hit a two-run walkoff home run in the bottom of the twelfth. The Timber Rattlers had a 2-0 lead heading into the bottom of the ninth, a 3-2 lead heading into the bottom of the tenth, and a 4-3 lead heading into the bottom of the twelfth.

**THAT'S A FIRST:** Last night was the first time the Timber Rattlers have lost a game when leading heading into the ninth. Wisconsin had been 22-0 in that situation before last night.

**YEOMAN'S WORK:** Zach Mort pitched four scoreless innings of relief for the Rattlers. He allowed two hits, walked two, and struck out three in the game.

**SHOUT IT OUT:** Micah Bello doubled and homered for the Rattlers last night. His solo home run in the seventh inning gave the Timber Rattlers a 2-0 lead.

**OPPORTUNITY KNOCKED:** Wisconsin had the bases loaded with one out in the top of the ninth inning but could not add to their lead. The Timber Rattlers stranded thirteen runners and were 3-for-15 with runners in scoring position on Friday night.

**A RARE THING:** Last night was just the third time a Rattlers game reached twelve innings since 2018. Wisconsin won 5-4 at Kane County on June 6, 2019 and lost 13-12 at South Bend on June 9, 2021 were the other twelve-inning games prior to last night.

**ABOUT БЕЛОИТ:** The Beloit Sky Carp are in their first season as the Sky Carp and their second season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and [moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3](#). Jorge Hernandez is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp.

**ABOUT THE MARLINS:** The Florida/Miami Marlins have a history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) puts six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#6), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Zavier Warren (#17), and Cam Robinson (#26). Carlos Rodríguez (#21) is on the Wisconsin injured list. [MLB Pipeline](#) has six current Sky Carp on their Top 30 list of Miami Marlins prospects: Dax Fulton (#9), Victor Mesa Jr. (#14), Cody Morrissette (#16), Nasim Nunez (#18), Evan Fitterer (#19), and Tanner Allen (#23).

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP JUSTIN JARVIS:** Selected by Milwaukee in the 5<sup>th</sup> round of the 2018 draft out of Lake Norman High School in Mooresville, North Carolina.

**THE SENIOR SEASON:** In his final season of high school, Jarvis was 8-2 with a 1.60ERA, and 95 strikeouts. Former Major Leaguer Ty Wigginton was his head coach.

**A PERFECT DAY:** Jarvis pitched a perfect game with 18 strikeouts in a game against East Rowan High School early in his senior season of high school.

**NOT ON CAMPUS:** Jarvis signed with the Brewers over a commitment to UNC-Wilmington.

**YEAR ONE:** Jarvis was 1-2 with a 6.63ERA in ten games – three starts – for Milwaukee's Arizona League affiliate after signing with Milwaukee. He walked four and struck out 18 over 19 innings pitched in the Arizona League.

**2019:** Jarvis was 4-1 with a 3.50 ERA in 18 games – eleven starts – for the Timber Rattlers in 2019. He had 52 strikeouts over 74-2/3 innings.

**2021:** Jarvis was 1-7 with a 5.40 ERA in seventeen starts for the Timber Rattlers in 2021. He had 62 strikeouts over 63-1/3 innings.

**LAST START:** Jarvis earned the [win against Peoria on June 5 at home](#). He allowed one run on three hits with a walk and six strikeouts over six innings in the game.

**VS. БЕЛОИТ (2022):** Jarvis had a [no decision at Beloit in game one of a doubleheader on April 14](#). He allowed four runs on three hits with two walks and struck out five over 4-1/3 innings.

**LHP ZACH KING:** Selected by the Miami Marlins in the 13<sup>th</sup> round of the 2019 draft out of Vanderbilt.

**THE COMMODORE:** King was 3-7 and six saves with a 4.02 ERA in 70 games – six starts – over three seasons at Vanderbilt. He walked 60 and struck out 129 in 130 innings pitched during his college career.

**AS A PRO (2019):** King was 2-0 in six games – three starts – with the Gulf Coast League Marlins after he signed his professional contract. King walked seven and struck out 17 over 16-1/3 innings in the GCL in 2019.

**BEAUTIFUL БЕЛОИТ:** King made sixteen starts for the Beloit Snappers in 2021. He was 2-9 with a 5.88 ERA and 104 strikeouts in 99-1/3 innings pitched.

**LAST START:** King had a [no decision at Quad Cities on June 4](#). He allowed three runs on six hits with three walks and five strikeouts over four innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** [King had a no decision against the Timber Rattlers on April 17 at home](#). He allowed an unearned run on a hit with two hit batsmen and four walks with eight strikeouts over five innings. King was 1-1 in three starts against Wisconsin in three different stadiums last season. He lost to the Timber Rattlers [at Neuroscience Group Field on May 7](#). He allowed four runs on five hits with three walks and four strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings. King beat [Wisconsin at Pohlman Field on July 2](#) when he allowed one run on four hits with two walks and eight strikeouts. [On August 3 at ABC Supply Stadium](#), King had a no decision when he gave up five runs on five hits with two walks and five strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings pitched.
