ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The South Bend Cubs beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 6-4 at Neuroscience Group Field at Fox Cities Stadium on Thursday night. South Bend scored two runs with two outs in the top of the first inning and added a run in the top of the second to take a 3-0 lead. Wisconsin fought back to get to within 3-2 and 5-4, but could not close the distance. The Cubs have won two of the first three games in this series and have taken a 5-4 lead in the nine games between the teams this season.

TWO SMALL VILLAGES: The Rattlers and Cubs combined to strand 30 runners on base last night. South Bend left sixteen runners on base. Wisconsin left fourteen runners on base. Wisconsin pitchers did not record a 1-2-3 inning last night. South Bend hurlers had a 1-2-3 inning in the bottom of the second and in the bottom of the ninth. Both teams were 2-for-14 with runners in scoring position on Thursday.

THAT'S ONLY SEVENTEEN: The teams combined for seventeen walks, three hit batsmen, and eight wild pitches last night. South Bend pitchers walked nine while Wisconsin pitchers walked eight.

A MARATHON: Last night's game time was 3:57. That was two minutes short of Wisconsin's longest game of the season. The Rattlers played a game against Peoria on June 2 that had an elapsed game time of 3:59.

BY THE WAY, WHICH ONE'S PINK: Taylor Floyd pitched 1-2/3 scoreless innings with four strikeouts last night in relief for Wisconsin. He also stranded an inherited base runner. Floyd has inherited 24 runners this season and allowed just three to score. In July, Floyd has allowed one run and struck out fourteen over eight innings in six appearances.

CLOSING THE GAP: David Hamilton stole two bases last night. He has 37 on the season. Devlin Zinn of South Bend went 0-for-6 last night and is stuck on 40 steals to lead the High-A Central in that category.

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs. South Bend won Midwest League pennants in 1989, 1993, 2005, and 2019. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Justin Upton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, and Carlos Gonzalez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JUSTIN BULLOCK: Selected by the Brewers in the 16th round of the 2017 draft out of South Granville (NC) High School.

HE'S A PLAYER: Bullock was named the North Carolina Baseball Coaches Association 2A Player of the Year in 2017. He was 11-1 with a 0.55ERA and 124 strikeouts in 63-2/3 innings pitched on the mound. Bullock also hit .476 with eleven homers and 46RBI.

LET'S GO PRO: Bullock signed with the Brewers over a commitment to North Carolina State University.

IN ARIZONA: Bullock went 1-0 with a 3.09ERA in six games – one start – for the AZL Brewers after signing with Milwaukee in 2017. He walked three and struck out eleven in 11-2/3 innings pitched in his debut season.

A SEASON IN MONTANA: Bullock made 13 starts for Helena in 2018. He was 2-5 with 66 strikeouts in 58-2/3 innings pitched. Bullock finished fourth in the Pioneer League in strikeouts.

TIME WITH THE TIMBER RATTLERS: Bullock was 2-2 with a 7.78 ERA, 14 walks and 20 strikeouts over 19-2/3 innings in seven games – three starts – for Wisconsin in 2019.

CAROLINA ON MY MIND: Bullock started this season with the Carolina Mudcats in the Low-A East. He was 1-1 in four starts with a 1.42 ERA. He walked five and struck out 27 over 19 innings pitched with the Mudcats this season. He finished on a 15-2/3 inning scoreless streak.

AWARD WINNING: Bullock was the High-A Central League's pitcher of the month for June. He was 3-1 with a 3.00 ERA in four starts with Wisconsin. Bullock walked one and struck out 23 over 24 innings during the month. One of his wins was the first five innings of a combined no-hitter at South Bend on June 10.

LAST START: Bullock beat the <u>Peoria Chiefs at Dozer Park on July 16</u>. He allowed one run on two hits with two walks and six strikeouts over five innings.

VS. SOUTH BEND (2021): Bullock beat the Cubs at South Bend on June 10. He pitched five scoreless, hitless innings with no walks, a hit batsman, and ten strikeouts in his debut with the Timber Rattlers this season.

SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JOSE ALBERTOS: The Cubs signed Albertos as an International Free Agent out of Mexico on July 25, 2015.

CLIMBING THE LADDER: Albertos started his professional career with the AZL Cubs in 2016. He split time between the Arizona League and Eugene in the Northwest League in 2017.

ROUGH YEAR: Albertos went 0-9 with a 14.84 ERA in 20 appearances – ten starts – between Eugene and South Bend during the 2018 season. He walked 65 in 30-1/3 innings pitched that season.

IN 2019: Albertos was 1-0 in eight relief appearances for the South Bend Cubs during the regular season.

SOME BEACH...SOMEWHERE: Albertos started this season with Myrtle Beach in the Low-A East. He was 2-1 with a 3.38 ERA in six relief appearances in May before his promotion to South Bend.

LAST APPEARANCE: Albertos pitched in relief against the Depth 16. He pitched the top of the tenth inning, stranded the inherited runner on base, walked one, struck out three and picked up the win when the Cubs scored in the bottom of the tenth

LAST START: Albertos took the loss <u>at Vancouver on July 27, 2018</u> as the starting pitcher for the Eugene Emeralds. He allowed four runs on three hits with two walks and two strikeouts in 2/3 of an inning.

VS. WISCONSIN (2021): Albertos faced the Timber Rattlers twice at South Bend during the series back in June at Four Winds Field. He allowed an unearned on three hits with three walks and five strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings. He was the winning pitcher in extra innings <u>against</u> Wisconsin on June 9.
