ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Cedar Rapids Kernels beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 11-4 at Neuroscience Group Field at Fox Cities Stadium.](#)

The Kernels hit three homers in the game and built an 8-0 lead with two runs in the first and six runs in the second.

POWERING THROUGH: The Kernels have hit ten home runs in the first three games of this series. Cedar Rapids has a total of 31 homers in 21 games against Wisconsin this season.

MULTI-BALL: Carlos Rodríguez had two more hits last night. Rodríguez has 25 multi-hit games to lead the Timber Rattlers in that category. He is 33-for-97 (.340) in 25 games since the start of August to raise his batting average from .250 to .278.

ERROR-FREE: The Wisconsin defense committed no errors on Thursday for their 49th errorless game of the season. Wisconsin fourth in the High-A Central League in fielding percentage.

GOING DEEP: LG Castillo hit a solo home run in the bottom of the second inning for the Timber Rattlers. The homer was his eighth of the season and it happened in his 226th at bat. Castillo had four homers between Wisconsin and Carolina in 271 at bats during the 2019 season.

AT LEAST A TIE: The Kernels clinched at least a tie in the season series against the Timber Rattlers this season.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The Cedar Rapids Kernels are charter members of the High-A Central League. The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels made the Midwest League playoffs every year they were affiliated with the Twins. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, and Ted Simmons.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota's former High-A Affiliate was the Fort Myers Miracle in the Florida State League. From 1995 through 2019, the Twins were affiliated with four teams in the Midwest League. They were with the Fort Wayne Wizards (1995-1998), Quad City River Bandits (1999-2005), Beloit Snappers (2006-2012), and Cedar Rapids Kernels (2013-2019).

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) puts eight Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Sal Frelick (#2), Joe Gray Jr. (#9), Antoine Kelly (#10), Freddy Zamora (#11), Zavier Warren (#14), Carlos Rodríguez (#22), Joey Wiemer (#23), and Victor Castañeda (#30). [MLB Pipeline](#) has four Kernels on their list of Twins prospects: Matt Wallner (#14), Aaron Sabato (#16), Yunior Severino (#27), and Louie Varland (#29). Matt Canterino (#10) and Blayne Enlow (#15) are currently on the Kernels injured list.

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JUSTIN JARVIS: Selected by Milwaukee in the 5th round of the 2018 draft out of Lake Norman High School in Mooresville, North Carolina.

THE SENIOR SEASON: In his final season of high school, Jarvis was 8-2 with a 1.60ERA, and 95 strikeouts. Former Major Leaguer Ty Wigginton was his head coach.

A PERFECT DAY: Jarvis pitched a perfect game with 18 strikeouts in a game against East Rowan High School early in his senior season of high school.

NOT ON CAMPUS: Jarvis signed with the Brewers over a commitment to UNC-Wilmington.

YEAR ONE: Jarvis was 1-2 with a 6.63ERA in ten games – three starts – for Milwaukee's Arizona League affiliate after signing last season. He walked four and struck out 18 over 19 innings pitched in the Arizona League.

2019: Jarvis was 4-1 with a 3.50 ERA in 18 games – eleven starts – for the Timber Rattlers in 2019. He had 52 strikeouts over 74-2/3 innings.

LAST START: Jarvis lost to the [Beloit Snappers at home on September 3](#). He allowed three runs – two earned – on four hits with two walks and ten strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS (2021): Jarvis is 0-1 in two starts against the Kernels this season. He has allowed six runs on seven hits with two walks and seven strikeouts over nine innings.

CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP SEAN MOONEY: The Minnesota Twins selected Mooney in the 12th round of the 2019 draft out of St. John's University.

JOHNNIES: Mooney pitched three years at St. John's. He was 21-6 and a 2.13 ERA in 41 games – 38 starts – and had 249 strikeouts over 244-2/3 innings during his career at St. John's.

AS A FRESHMAN: Mooney was he Big East Pitcher of the Year and the Big East Freshman of the Year in his first season at St. John's. He was 8-2 with a 1.71 ERA in sixteen games – thirteen starts as a freshman.

TOMMY JOHNNIE: Mooney was 2-1 in nine starts with a 2.17 ERA in his final season for the Red Storm, but he missed the final six weeks of the 2019 season at St. John's due to Tommy John Surgery.

STARTING OUT: Mooney started his professional career with the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels in the Low-A Southeast this season. He was 0-1 with a 1.24 ERA in ten games – nine starts – with 52 strikeouts in 29 innings pitched before his promotion to Cedar Rapids.

LAST START: Mooney made his High-A Central debut with [a loss to Quad Cities at home on September 3](#). He allowed five runs on five hits with a walk and six strikeouts over four innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Mooney has never faced the Timber Rattlers. This is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
