TONIGHT'S STARTER

Michael Plassmeyer: The southpaw Plassmeyer will make his fourth start of the season and his second of the series at Toledo.

Last Outing: Plassmeyer started in the series opener on Tuesday and suffered his first loss as an Indian, yielding five earned runs on seven hits (two home runs) and two walks with four strikeouts in 5.0 innings pitched.

Against the Mud Hens: Plassmeyer has made just one career start vs. Toledo, going 0-1 with a 9.00 ERA (5er/5.0ip).

Walk It Off: Of his 14 starts last season with Lehigh Valley, four ended in walk-off fashion – three in favor of the IronPigs. In those three team wins, two of which were come-from-behind victories, Plassmeyer was backed by 27 runs of support.

2023: Began the season with Triple-A Lehigh Valley and went 3-4 with a 5.05 ERA (38er/67.2ip) and 74 strikeouts in 16 games (14 starts). ... Struck out a season-high seven batters over 6.0 two-run innings on 4/21 vs. Worcester; matched that mark on 9/2 vs. Syracuse. ... Was placed on the 7-day injured list on 5/31 and was transferred to the 60-day IL on 7/25 with an undisclosed injury. ...
