**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Beloit Snappers beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 8-7 in ten innings. The Timber Rattlers had a 5-1 lead, but Beloit rallied with a run in the seventh and three runs in the ninth to tie the game. LG Castillo gave Wisconsin a 7-5 lead in the top of the tenth with a two-run home run. The Snappers scored three times in the bottom of the tenth for the walkoff win.

**DID YOU KNOW?** Wisconsin has played three extra-innings games this season. All three have been on the road. The Rattlers have had the lead in all three extra-innings games this season. The opponents have rallied to win the game all three times.

**LONG GONE:** The Timber Rattlers hit three home runs in last night's game. Thomas Dillard hit a solo home run in the second inning and David Hamilton hit a two-run homer in the third inning before Castillo's blast in the tenth. On the Snappers side of the ledger, Griffin Conine hit a solo home run in the fourth inning. Conine has homered in each of the first two games of this series and has hit 15 home runs this season.

**A DECADE:** Hayden Cantrelle drew a walk in the top of the ninth inning last night. He has drawn at least one walk in ten straight games and had 47 walks in 44 games. He is tops in the High-A classification and tied for third in MiLB in walks.

**OTHER STREAKS:** Castillo had a double to go along with his home run last night to move his current hitting streak to six games. Korry Howell had a single last night to send his hitting streak to seven games. Those are the longest hitting streaks of the season for both players.

**MITCHELL REPORT:** Garrett Mitchell went 2-for-4 with a double, a stolen base, and a run scored last night. It was his third multi-hit game in the last four games. His OPS is at 1.028 through 24 games this season.

**ABOUT БЕЛОИТ:** The Beloit Snappers are in their first season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers will say "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field and [move into ABC Supply Stadium when they host the Timber Rattlers on August 3](#). Mike Jacobs is in his first season as the manager of the Snappers. Jacobs managed the Clinton LumberKings in 2019, Clinton's last year as an affiliate of the Marlins.

**ABOUT THE MARLINS:** The Florida/Miami Marlins had a history in the old Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and current Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings and went 78-61 to qualify for the playoffs. They were beaten by the Cedar Rapids Kernels in the Best-of-three Western Division Finals two games to one.

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP REESE OLSON:** Selected by Milwaukee in the 13<sup>th</sup> round of the 2018 draft out of North Hall High School in Gainesville, Georgia.

**NOT GOING TO GET TECHNICAL:** Olson signed with the Brewers over a scholarship to Georgia Tech.

**MY OLD SCHOOL:** Olson was a junior when North Hall High School won the Georgia State 3A Baseball Championship in 2017. The Bulldogs made the state playoffs again in 2018.

**DESERT DEBUT:** Olson went 0-2 with a 5.23 ERA in four games – two starts – for the AZL Brewers in 2018. He walked four and struck out six in 10-1/3 innings pitched.

**FIRST PRO WIN:** Olson came on in relief at Lansing on May 1 after the April 30 game had been suspended at Cooley Law School Stadium. He pitched five innings and picked up the win for his first professional victory.

**2019:** Olson was 4-7 with a 4.66ERA in 27 games – 14 starts – with Wisconsin in 2019. Olson walked 47 and struck out 84 in 94-2/3 innings.

**LAST START:** Olson had a no-decision [against Peoria at home on June 25](#). He allowed three runs on four hits with two hit batsmen and seven walks over four innings. Olson had four strikeouts.

**VS. BELOIT (2021):** Olson beat the [Snappers at Neuroscience Group Field on May 7](#). He allowed two hits and recorded seven strikeouts over five scoreless innings.

## BELOIT STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP KYLE NICOLAS:** Selected by the Miami Marlins in Competitive Balance Round B with the 61<sup>st</sup> pick of the 2020 draft out of Ball State University. This evening is his professional debut.

**BALL STATE:** Nicolas went 4-6 with six saves, a 5.30 ERA, and 133 strikeouts over 108-2/3 innings over his first two seasons with the Cardinals. In his abbreviated junior season, Nicolas made four starts, went 0-1 and struck out 37 in 23 innings.

**THAT SEEMS LIKE A LOT:** In what turned out to be the final start of his collegiate career, Nicolas pitched seven shutout innings, allowed one hit, walked one, and struck out 17 for a no decision against Sacred Heart on March 6, 2020. Nicolas was named the Rawlings National Player of the Week for that performance.

**THE CAPE:** Nicolas was the closer for the Cotuit Kettleers in 2019 to help that team win the Cape Cod League Championship.

**LAST START:** Nicolas had a no decision [against Quad Cities at home on June 25](#). He allowed one run on three hits with a walk and eight strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings. Nicolas left the game with a 3-1 lead. The River Bandits rallied to take the lead, but the Snappers rallied to tie the game and eventually win in ten innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Nicolas made his professional debut with a start against the [Timber Rattlers at Neuroscience Group Field on May 6, 2021](#). He allowed one run on one hit with four walks and eight strikeouts over five innings to earn the win.
