### ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The South Bend Cubs beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 8-6 at Four Winds Field.](#)

Owen Caissie hit a walkoff, grand slam home run with two outs in the bottom of the ninth inning to beat the Rattlers.

**RIDE THE SEESAW:** Wisconsin scored two runs in the first inning on an RBI triple by Tristan Peters and a throwing error on the play that let Peters score. The Cubs rallied for single runs in the first, second, and third innings. The Rattlers scored twice in the sixth on an RBI single by Albert Cipion and another error. Joe Gray Jr hit a two-run home run in the top of the seventh and Wisconsin's lead was 6-3. The Cubs scored a run in the seventh. Then, Caissie hit his home run in the ninth for the final lead change.

**GRAY HAVENS:** Gray's home run was his second of the series and eleventh of the season. Gray also had a pair of outfield assists to give him five on the season.

**MEEKER INHERITS THE EARTH:** Wisconsin reliever James Meeker allowed one hit and struck out five over three innings of scoreless relief. He retired nine of the ten batters he faced in the game.

**TRIPLE DECKER:** Peters has seven triples after his three-base hit last night. He is tied with Masyn Winn for the Midwest League lead in triples. Winn had seven triples with Peoria before his promotion in May.

**HEARTBREAK:** Taylor Floyd, Wisconsin's fourth pitcher of the night, walked the lead-off batter in the ninth. He retired the next two batters before allowing a single and issuing a walk on a 3-2 pitch to set the stage for Caissie's walkoff grand slam. Caissie has three homers and fourteen RBI in nine games against the Timber Rattlers this season.

**TO THE FUTURE AND BEYOND:** Antoine Kelly was named to the National League roster for the SiriusXM Futures Game prior to last night's game. He is the 29<sup>th</sup> Rattler or Rattler alumni to be named to a Futures Game roster since the game started in 1999.

**ABOUT SOUTH BEND:** The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs. South Bend won Midwest League pennants in 1989, 1993, 2005, and 2019. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, and Carlos Gonzalez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982.

**ABOUT THE CUBS:** The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

**FIRST HALF:** South Bend finished the first half 34-32. They stumbled to the line as they dropped nine out of twelve games to start June. The Cubs put together a ten-game winning streak as they won the final two games of the first half and the first eight games of the second half. That streak was snapped with a 9-3 loss at Beloit on July 3.

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) puts five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#7), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), and Xavier Warren (#17). Carlos Rodriguez (#21) is on the Wisconsin injured list. [MLB Pipeline](#) has ten current South Bend players on their Top 30 list of Chicago Cubs prospects: Peter Crow-Armstrong (#3), Jordan Wicks (#6), Owen Cassie (#8), DJ Herz (#9), Kohl Franklin (#12), Ed Howard (#14), Yohendrick Pinango (#20), Pablo Aliendo (#21), Jordan Nwogu (#23), and Daniel Palencia (#25).

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP RUSSELL SMITH:** Selected by the Brewers in the second round (51<sup>st</sup> overall selection) of the 2021 draft out of Texas Christian University. He is rated as he #16 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline.

**AREA CODE:** Smith was picked as the Most Outstanding Player at the Area Code Games in 2016. He was also a four-year letter winner at Midlothian (TX) High School.

**NO, CUBS, NO:** The Chicago Cubs picked Smith in the 38<sup>th</sup> round of the 2017 draft. He elected to honor a commitment to TCU.

**HORNED FROGS:** Smith was 7-3 with a 3.83 ERA in fifteen starts during his final season at TCU. He had 101 strikeouts in 82-1/3 innings pitched that season.

**MISSING TIME:** Smith missed the 2019 season due to Tommy John Surgery and most of the 2020 season due to the pandemic shutdown.

**LAST START:** Smith has a [no decision against Cedar Rapids on July 2 at home](#). He allowed one run on three hits with no walks and six strikeouts over six innings.

**VS. SOUTH BEND:** Smith took the [loss against the Cubs at home on May 20](#). He allowed four runs – three earned – on five hits with a walk and four strikeouts over four innings. Owen Caissie hit two home runs off Smith in the game.

## SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP DJ HERZ:** The Chicago Cubs picked Herz in the eighth round of the 2019 draft out of Terry Sanford High School in Fayetteville, North Carolina. MLB Pipeline ranks Herz as the #9 prospect in the Cubs system. *Baseball America* rates Herz at #10 in their mid-season update of Cubs prospects.

**SENIOR MOMENT:** Herz was voted the Player of the Year in the Patriot Athletic Conference in his senior season of high school. He went 8-1 with a 0.51 ERA and 106 strikeouts over 56-1/3 innings pitched. Herz also hit .419 with 26 RBI at the plate in his final season.

**INTO THE DESERT:** Herz made six starts and was 0-1 with a 2.61 ERA with the AZL Cubs-2 after signing with Chicago in 2019. He allowed eight runs – three earned – on ten hits with eight walks and eight strike outs over 10-1/3 innings in his first pro season.

**STARTING OVER:** Herz made seventeen starts for the Myrtle Beach Pelicans and three starts for the South Bend Cubs in 2021. He went 3-4 with 105 strikeouts over 65-2/3 innings for Myrtle Beach and 1-0 with 26 strikeouts over sixteen innings for South Bend. Herz compiled a 3.31 ERA and walked 44 over his 81-2/3 innings between the two levels last season.

**LAST START:** Herz had a [no decision at Beloit on July 2](#). He allowed a run on two hits with four walks and seven strikeouts over four innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Herz had a [no decision against the Timber Rattlers in Wisconsin on May 20](#). He allowed a run on three hits with a walk and seven strikeouts over four innings. Wes Clarke hit a solo home run off Herz in the game.
