ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Quad Cities River Bandits 3-2](#). Wisconsin had a 2-0 lead two pitches into the game. The River Bandits tied the game with a run in the fifth and another run in the sixth. Tristan Peters drove in Joe Gray Jr with the go-ahead run in the top of the eighth with an infield grounder. Cam Robinson pitched two scoreless innings for his sixth save of the season.

FAST START: Tyler Black singled on the first pitch of the game. Xavier Warren homered on the second pitch of the game and Wisconsin had their 2-0 lead. The home run was the first of the season for Warren.

TOP OF THE ORDER: Black has been Wisconsin's lead-off batter in the last four games. He has reached base and scored in the first inning of three of those games. Black has been on base ten times and scored six runs in his four games as the lead-off hitter.

HEY, NINETEEN: Peters was 1-for-4 with a single last night to extend his current on-base streak to nineteen games. He has an OPS of .928 with twelve walks, thirteen runs scored, and eleven RBI during the streak. Colt Keith of West Michigan is on a 26 game on-base streak, which is the longest in the Midwest League this season. Robert Hassell III of Fort Wayne and Alexander Canario of South Bend had twenty-game on-base streaks and David Bradshaw of Beloit has an active twenty-game on-base streak.

KELLY'S GAME: Antoine Kelly pitched 5-2/3 innings as the Wisconsin starter last night. He two runs – one earned – as he set a new professional single-game high for innings with his performance last night.

BETTER MAKE IT FIVE: Wisconsin is on a five-game winning streak. This is the third five-game winning streak for the team this season. The Rattlers have also reached nine games over .500 for the first time since the 2014 season. If the Rattlers win tonight, they will reach ten games over .500 for the first time since they beat [Clinton 6-2 on August 13, 2014](#) to get to 65-55.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams over the years: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo from 1969-1976, Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JUSTIN JARVIS: Selected by Milwaukee in the 5th round of the 2018 draft out of Lake Norman High School in Mooresville, North Carolina.

THE SENIOR SEASON: In his final season of high school, Jarvis was 8-2 with a 1.60ERA, and 95 strikeouts. Former Major Leaguer Ty Wigginton was his head coach.

A PERFECT DAY: Jarvis pitched a perfect game with 18 strikeouts in a game against East Rowan High School early in his senior season of high school.

NOT ON CAMPUS: Jarvis signed with the Brewers over a commitment to UNC-Wilmington.

YEAR ONE: Jarvis was 1-2 with a 6.63ERA in ten games – three starts – for Milwaukee's Arizona League affiliate after signing with Milwaukee. He walked four and struck out 18 over 19 innings pitched in the Arizona League.

2019: Jarvis was 4-1 with a 3.50 ERA in 18 games – eleven starts – for the Timber Rattlers in 2019. He had 52 strikeouts over 74-2/3 innings.

2021: Jarvis was 1-7 with a 5.40 ERA in seventeen starts for the Timber Rattlers in 2021. He had 62 strikeouts over 63-1/3 innings.

LAST START: Jarvis had a [no decision at home against the Fort Wayne TinCaps on May 6](#). Jarvis allowed a run on six hits with two walk and three strikeouts over five innings.

VS. QUAD CITIES (2022): Jarvis is 1-1 in two starts at home against the River Bandits this season. He beat them on [April 19](#) and lost to them on [April 24](#). Jarvis has allowed six runs – five earned – on six hits with five walks and four strikeouts over seven innings in those two starts. He has allowed two homers to Quad Cities this season.

QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CHARLIE NEUWEILER: The Royals selected Neuweiler in the 5th round of the 2017 draft out of Monsignor McClancy Memorial High School in East Elmhurst, New York.

A TREE DOESN'T GROW IN BROOKLYN: Neuweiler signed with the Royals over a commitment to LIU-Brooklyn.

DOWN IN THE DESERT: Neuweiler went 3-3 for the AZL Royals after signing with Kansas City. He appeared in twelve games – five starts – had an ERA of 1.76 and recorded 34 strikeouts over 41 innings pitched.

SPLIT SEASON: Neuweiler made two starts for Burlington in the Appalachian League and eleven starts for Lexington in the South Atlantic League in 2018. He was 2-4 with a 5-70ERA at those two stops in the Royals system.

WE COULD BE LEGENDS: Neuweiler pitched all of 2019 with Lexington and was 7-10 with a 4.36 ERA in 27 starts during the regular season. He allowed three runs in 4-2/3 innings and took the loss in his lone playoff start during the 2019 postseason.

WHAT ABOUT LAST YEAR? Neuweiler started 2021 with two scoreless starts for the Royals affiliate in the Arizona Complex League. He joined the River Bandits in July and made thirteen appearances – twelve starts – during the regular season. Neuweiler was 2-3 with a 4.81 ERA, 23 walks, and 50 strikeouts over 58 innings pitched with Quad Cities.

LAST START: Neuweiler won [at Cedar Rapids on May 6](#). He allowed one hit, walked one, and struck out five over five scoreless innings against the Kernels. Lost to the [Timber Rattlers at Neuroscience Group Field on April 19](#). He allowed two runs on five hits with three walks and four strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN (2022): Neuweiler is 1-1 in two starts against the Rattlers at Wisconsin this season. He lost on [April 19](#) and won on [April 24](#). Neuweiler has allowed three runs on nine hits with four walks and six strikeouts over eleven innings in those two starts.
