**AFTERNOON AT A PARK:** [The Beloit Sky Carp beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 7-4 yesterday at Neuroscience Group Field at Fox Cities Stadium.](#) Dalvy Rosario broke a 4-4 tie with a two-out, RBI single in the top of the fourth to put Beloit in front. Yiddi Cappe added a two-run homer with two outs in the ninth for some insurance runs.

**HEY, JOE!** Rattlers starting pitcher Joseph Hernandez allowed two first inning runs last night, but that was about it. He pitched six innings, hit two batters, allowed four hits, walked one, and struck out four to earn his second consecutive quality start.

**MULTI-BALL:** Joe Gray Jr had two hits and three RBI for the Timber Rattlers yesterday. Gray has six multi-hit games and two three-RBI games for Wisconsin this season.

**IN A PINCH:** Jose Acosta replaced Eric Brown Jr as a pinch-runner in the first inning after Brown was hit by a pitch. Acosta went 3-for-3 with a double, a triple, two runs scored, and an RBI in the game.

**SIX-PACK:** Brown had reached base six straight times in six plate appearances in the series.

**TO THE MAX:** Max Lazar pitched four scoreless innings of relief for the Timber Rattlers yesterday. He allowed two hits, walked two, and struck out two in the game.

**ON ASSIGNMENT:** Milwaukee Brewers reliever Gus Varland joins the Timber Rattlers for a rehabilitation assignment tonight. Varland, a Rule 5 draft selection of the Brewers out of the Los Angeles Dodgers organization last December, went on Milwaukee's injured list on April 16 after he was hit on his right hand and face by a 105-mph line drive off the bat of Manny Machado in a game at San Diego on April 15. Varland, who pitched with the Beloit Snappers in 2018 as a member of the Oakland Athletics organization, has made six appearances out of the Milwaukee bullpen this season.

**ABOUT BELOIT:** The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's third season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Billy Gardner Jr is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp.

**ABOUT THE MARLINS:** The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP STIVEN CRUZ:** Signed by Milwaukee as an International Free Agent out of Nicaragua on July 2, 2019.

**DELAYED START:** Cruz began his pro career with the Brewers-1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He was 3-3 with a 1.37 ERA and 73 strikeouts over 52-2/3 innings pitched in twelve games – eleven starts.

**MUDDY WATERS:** Cruz started the 2022 season with the Carolina Mudcats in the Carolina League. He went 3-5 with a 4.60 ERA in fifteen starts for Carolina. Cruz walked 18 and struck out 89 over 72-1/3 innings pitched.

**ON TO WISCONSIN:** Cruz joined the Timber Rattlers on August 16, 2022. He made four starts with the Rattlers and allowed one run on six hits with six walks and twenty strikeouts over nineteen innings pitched for a 1-1 record with a 0.47ERA.

**IT'S A MAJOR AWARD:** Cruz beat Lansing at home on August 24, 2022. He allowed a hit with a walk and seven strikeouts over six scoreless innings in the game. Cruz was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on August 29 for this game.

**LAST START:** Cruz had a [no decision at Quad Cities on April 21](#). He allowed four runs on three hits with four walks and five strikeouts over four innings. The River Bandits hit a pair of homers against Cruz in the game.

**VS. БЕЛОИТ (2023):** Cruz made the start and had a [no decision at Beloit on April 9](#). He allowed two runs on three hits with two walks and three strikeouts over four innings.

## БЕЛОИТ SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP EDGAR SANCHEZ:** The Marlins signed Sanchez as an International Free Agent on February 10, 2017 out of the Dominican Republic.

**TO THE GULF:** Sanchez made his professional debut with the Marlins Gulf Coast League affiliate in 2019. He was 2-3 with a 3.13 in ten games – two starts. Sanchez walked 33 and struck out 31 in 31-2/3 innings pitched.

**BACK AT IT:** Sanchez started the 2021 season with Jupiter in the Florida State League and allowed nine runs – seven earned – in two innings over three relief appearances. He also was 1-1 with eight walks and 23 strikeouts over 19-2/3 innings in nine games – two starts – back in the Gulf Coast League in 2021.

**HAMMER IT HOME:** Sanchez started the 2022 season with the Jupiter Hammerheads and went 5-3 in fifteen games – thirteen starts – with a 4.24 ERA. Sanchez walked 26 and struck out 74 with Jupiter before he was promoted to Beloit on August 2.

**SKY HIGH:** Sanchez made six starts for Beloit and was 0-1 with a 4.07 ERA in 2022. He walked fourteen and struck out twenty over 24-1/3 innings pitched in the Midwest League last season.

**LAST START:** Sanchez had a [no decision at Cedar Rapids on April 21](#). He allowed two runs – one earned – on five hits with two walks and seven strikeouts over four innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN (2023):** Sanchez had a [no decision against the Timber Rattlers at Beloit on April 9](#). He allowed four runs on five hits with two walks and four strikeouts. Ernesto Martinez Jr and Robert Moore both hit home runs off Sanchez in the game.
