ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers defeated the Peoria Chiefs 7-6 in ten innings in the season-opening game for both teams. Ernesto Martínez Jr. hit a two-out, RBI single in the bottom of the tenth inning drive in the winning run.

FALLING DOWN: The Chiefs built a 5-0 lead through 5-1/2 innings. Aaron Antonini and Tommy Jew hit backto-back home runs in the top of the second inning for a 3-0 lead. Antonini added a two-run single in the sixth for the five-run advantage.

ON THE COMEBACK TRAIL: Wisconsin chipped away by scoring a run in the sixth and a run in the seventh without the benefit of a hit. The Rattlers tied the game in the eighth with three runs. Tyler Black, Joe Gray Jr., and Carlos Rodríguez each had an RBI in the eighth.

RIDE MY SEE-SAW: Peoria took the lead in the top of the ninth on a two-out, RBI double by LJ Jones. Wisconsin responded in the bottom of the ninth with an RBI single by Sal Frelick to tie the game.

INTO THE GREAT WIDE OPEN: Cam Robinson pitched a scoreless top of the tenth inning by stranding three Peoria runners. In the bottom of the tenth, Martínez singled to score Black with the winning run.

WALKING THROUGH HISTORY: Last night was the 21st time the Rattlers have beaten the Peoria Chiefs in walkoff fashion. The last time Wisconsin beat Peoria on a walkoff was in game two of a doubleheader on May 21, 2019 when David Fry drove in Connor McVey with the winning run on a single.

HOME OPENER HISTORY: The Timber Rattlers are 17-10 in 27 Home Openers during their history. Wisconsin has played Peoria six times in a Home Opener with a record of 3-3. The Chiefs had beaten Wisconsin in three straight Rattlers home openers prior to last night.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1957 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1956 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels in 1983. They changed their name to the Chiefs and their affiliation to the Chicago Cubs for the 1984 season. They became a Cardinals affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his first year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, and Yadier Molina.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to Springfield from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first time with Peoria. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts eight Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Sal Frelick (#1), Tyler Black (#6), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Zavier Warren (#17), Carlos Rodríguez (#21), and Cam Robinson (#26). MLB Pipeline has six current Chiefs2 on their list of Cardinals prospects – four active and two on the injured list: Maysin Winn (#5), Michael McGreevy (#8), Austin Love (#21), and Gordon Graceffo (#23) are on the active list. Ian Bedell (#22) and Jhon Torres (#24) are on the Peoria Injured List.

■ PITCHING MATCHUPS

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER GAME ONE:

LHP BRANDON KNARR: The Brewers signed Knarr as a non-drafted free agent out of the University of Tampa on July 17, 2020.

GOLDEN DOME: Knarr pitched at Notre Dame as a freshman and appeared in twelve games.

TO FLORIDA: Knarr spent his sophomore season at the College of Central Florida. He was 6-1 with 86 strikeouts and an ERA of 4.66 over 65-2/3 innings in sixteen games – thirteen starts.

TAMPA, TOO: Knarr transferred to the University of Tampa for the 2019-2020 season and was 4-1 with 64 strikeouts and a 2.55 ERA over 35-1/3 innings pitched in six starts before the shutdown.

IN THE MUD: Knarr started the 2021 season with the Carolina Mudcats. He was 7-2 with 103 strikeouts over 75 innings and an ERA of 3.84 in sixteen games – thirteen starts – before his promotion to Wisconsin on August 17.

LAST START: Knarr had a no decision at <u>Great Lakes on September 15.</u> 2021. He allowed two runs on five hits with a walk and four strikeouts over five innings. He left the game with the score tied 2-2 and the Rattlers win the game 4-2.

VS. PEORIA: Knarr has never faced the Chiefs prior to this afternoon. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the St. Louis Cardinals

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER GAME TWO:

RHP TJ SHOOK: The Brewers signed Shook as a non-drafted free agent out of the University of South Carolina on July 24, 2020.

GAMER: Shook pitched three seasons for the Gamecocks. He was 6-1 with three saves in 41 appearances – nine starts – at South Carolina. He struck out 92 and walked 35 in 74 innings pitched with a 3.04 ERA in his college career.

TEAMMATES: Shook was on the same pitching staff as Adam Hill in 2018. Hill was a Timber Rattler in the 2019 season.

TJ AND THE BLOWFISH: Shook pitched for the Lexington County Blowfish in the Coastal Plain League in 2017 and 2018. He was 2-0 with a 1.89 ERA with 28 strikeouts in 33-1/3 innings pitched in 2017. Shook had no record in four games – three starts – for the Blowfish in 2018.

GOLD, TJ....GOLD! Shook started this season with the ACL Brewers Gold. He allowed a run on a hit and struck out ten over 4-2/3 innings in two starts with no record before a quick promotion to the Carolina Mudcats.

COOL CAT: Shook was 4-1 in six starts for Carolina. He walked eleven and struck out 36 in 28 innings before his promotion to Wisconsin.

LAST START: Shook had <u>a no decision at Great Lakes on September 19, 2021</u> in the final game of last season. Shook allowed two hits with a walk and four strikeouts over four scoreless innings and left the game with Wisconsin up 1-0. The Rattlers went on to win 2-0.

VS. PEORIA: Shook has never faced the Chiefs prior to this afternoon. Today is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the St. Louis Cardinals.

PEORIA SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER GAME ONE:

RHP GORDON GRACEFFO: The Cardinals drafted Graceffo in the 5th round of the 2021 out of Villanova.

WILDCAT: Graceffo was 7-2 with a 1.54ERA, 86 strikeouts, and 13 walks in 82 innings pitched in his final season at Villanova. He was Big East Pitcher of the Week on March 8, 2021 and was named Second Team All-Big East.

ON THE BEACH: Graceffo made eleven appearances – one start – for the Palm Beach Cardinals after signing with St. Louis. He was 1-0 with a save, a 1.73 ERA, 37 strikeouts, and nine walks in 26 innings pitched in his first professional season.

DOUBLE BOOKED: Baseball America ranks Graceffo as the #15 prospect in the Cardinals system. MLB Pipeline has him at #23.

LAST START: Graceffo had a no decision against Lakeland at home on August 15, 2021. He allowed two runs on four hits over three innings.

LAST APPEARANCE: Graceffo worked two innings of relief against Daytona on September 14, 2021 and allowed a run on a hit with three walks and three strikeouts.

VS. WISCONSIN: Graceffo has never faced Wisconsin prior to today. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers

PEORIA SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER GAME TWO:

RHP DIONYS RODRÍGUEZ: The Cardinals signed Rodríguez as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic in 2018.

AND TO THE REPUBLIC: Rodríguez pitched of the Dominican Summer League affiliate of the Cardinals in 2018 and 2019. He was 4-0 with two saves despite a 7.40 ERA in nineteen relief appearances in 2018 between the Cardinals Red and the Cardinals Blue affiliates. In 2019, Rodríguez was 2-1 with two saves and a 5.88 ERA in seventeen relief appearances. Rodríguez walked 51 and struck out 58 in 50-1/3 innings pitched in those two seasons.

WILD PALMS: Rodríguez pitched for Palm Beach in 2021 made seven starts after signing with the Cardinals. He made 22 appearances – twelve starts – for the Cardinals last season in the Low-A Southeast and was 4-5 with 22 walks, 88 strikeouts, and a 3.36 ERA in 69-2/3 innings pitched.

RATING BY THE BOOK: Baseball America ranks Rodríguez as the #21 prospect in the St. Louis system.

LAST START: Rodríguez beat the <u>Daytona Tortugas in a home game on September 18, 2021</u>. He pitched five scoreless innings, allowed three hits, walked one, and struck out four in the game.

VS. WISCONSIN: Rodríguez has never faced Wisconsin prior to this afternoon. This is also the first time he will pitch against a stateside affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. Rodríguez made two appearances against Milwaukee Dominican Summer League affiliate in 2018.
