WEDNESDAY AT THE PARK: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the West Michigan Whitecaps 7-0 at Neuroscience Group Field. Tate Kuehner and Brian Fitzpatrick combined on a one-hit shutout and Felix Valerio hit a grand slam in the third inning to lead Wisconsin to its eighth shutout of the season. Jheremy Vargas added a home run. Luke Adams was also hit by a pitch for the 22<sup>nd</sup> time. Darrien Miller of the Timber Rattlers holds the record for most HBP with 24 in 2022.

PEACHY KEEN: Kuehner allowed one hit, walked three, and struck out two over six scoreless innings for the win. Kuehner matched his pro single-game high for innings pitched with his performance last night.

LIFE OF BRIAN: Fitzpatrick pitched three perfect innings with four strikeouts to earn his first professional save. In July Fitzpatrick has pitched eleven scoreless innings, allowed three hits, walked one and struck out eleven.

ONE IS THE LONELIEST NUMBER: The West Michigan hit of the game was a Seth Stephenson infield single in the first inning.

SHUTDOWN MODE: Wisconsin has recorded back-toback shutouts for the second time in July. Rattlers pitchers had shutouts on July 3 and 4 against Beloit and again on July 9 and 10 against West Michigan. Wisconsin's staff has an ERA of 2.06 with 88 strikeouts over 70 innings pitched in July.

WELCOME TO SLAMTOWN! Valerio's grand slam in the third inning gave the Timber Rattlers a 5-0 lead. His slam was the third of the season by a Timber Rattler. Wisconsin has hit twelve grand slams in the High-A Era that began in 2021. Rattlers hitters had five grand slams in 2021, three in 2022 and one in 2023.

THE NUMBER 23: Wisconsin is 23 games over .500 for the first time since they were 61-38 after a 5-0 road win over the Beloit Snappers on July 25, 2001. The 2001 Timber Rattlers finished that season 84-52 (32 games over .500) for the best record in Timber Rattlers history.

ABOUT WEST MICHIGAN: The West Michigan Whitecaps joined the Midwest League in 1994 when the Madison Muskies moved to Comstock Park, Michigan following the 1993 season. The Whitecaps started play in the league as an affiliate of the Oakland Athletics. They became Low-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers for the 1997 season. The Whitecaps have won six Midwest League Pennants - 1996, 1998, 2004, 2006, 2007, and 2015. Notable former Whitecaps include Nick Castellanos, Joel Zumaya, Fernando Rodney, Francisco Cordero, Brandon Inge, Cameron Maybin, Alex Avila, and Willy Adames. ABOUT THE TIGERS: Detroit has been affiliated with the Whitecaps since 1997. The Tigers had just one other stint in the Midwest League prior to their current partnership. They were with the Clinton Pilots from 1971 through 1975.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places four Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Luis Lara (#8), Luke Adams (#15), Jadher Areinamo (#21), and Patricio Aquino (#28). MLB Pipeline has three active West Michigan players on their list of Top 30 Tigers prospects: Max Anderson (#16), Jaden Hamm (#18), and Roberto Campos (#23). Dylan Smith (#22), Peyton Graham (#24), and Izaac Pacheco (#28) are currently on the West Michigan Injured List.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

#### WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP K.C. HUNT: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Hunt as a non-drafted free agent on July 20, 2023.

**ORIGINALLY:** Hunt was selected by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the twelfth round of the 2022 draft out of Mississippi State University. Hunt elected not to sign with the Pirates and returned to Mississippi State.

**HAIL STATE:** Hunt pitched four seasons with the Bulldogs. He went 4-6 with three saves in 53 appearances – three starts – at Mississippi State. Hunt had 102 strikeouts over 81 innings pitched in college.

HOT FUN IN THE SUMMERTIME: Hunt pitched for three teams in three leagues over four summers while in college. He was with Portland in the West Coast League in 2019, Falmouth of the Cape Cod League in 2021 and 2023, and Trenton of the MLB Draft League in 2022.

**BEFORE WISCONSIN:** Hunt made his pro debut with the ACL Brewers in 2023 with four relief appearances in the regular season and two relief stints during the 2023 ACL playoffs. Hunt made eight relief appearances with Carolina this season and was 3-0 with a save, a 2.48 ERA, 32 strikeouts, and four walks over nineteen innings before his promotion to Wisconsin on May 14, 2024.

SO, WHAT DOES K.C. STAND FOR? Kyle Clemente Hunt was named after Roberto Clemente, his father's favorite baseball player. Mickey Hunt is K.C.'s dad and was also his high school baseball coach at Ramapo (NJ) High.

**LAST START:** Hunt won at Beloit on <u>July 3</u> with 5-1/3 scoreless innings. He allowed one hit, walked two, and struck out ten. Hunt set a new singlegame high as a pro for strikeouts in a game with this performance.

VS. WEST MICHIGAN: Hunt won at West Michigan on <u>June 13</u>. He allowed one hit, walked one, and struck out eight over six scoreless innings.

#### **WEST MICHIGAN STARTING PITCHER:**

RHP COLIN FIELDS: The Detroit Tigers signed Fields as a non-drafted free agent out of Valparaiso on July 26, 2022.

**FOUR YEARS ON CRUSADE**: Fields pitched four seasons at Valparaiso and was 8-22 with a 6.24 ERA with a save 260 strikeouts over 199 innings pitched in 45 appearances – 41 starts.

**LIVING THE DREAM:** Fields made two appearances for Mahoning Valley in the MLB Draft League in 2022 before signing with Detroit. He did not pitch professionally in the Tigers system after joining the organization.

**LAST SEASON:** Fields made on brief start for the FCL Tigers on June 9, 2023 to make his pro debut. He was transferred to the Lakeland Flying Tigers, Detroit's Florida State League affiliate, on June 13, 2023. In fourteen games – eight starts – with Lakeland, Fields was 5-0 with a 3.38 ERA and 51 strikeouts over 45-1/3 innings pitched.

**DOWNER ENDING:** Fields was placed on the Lakeland Injured List on August 29, 2023 and did not pitch in the final stretch of games last season.

**LAST START:** Fields had a no decision at Great Lakes on <u>July 4</u>. He allowed two runs on two hits with three walks and seven strikeouts over five innings. Fields gave up a home run and hit a batter in the game.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Fields had a no decision against the Timber Rattlers at home on <u>June 12</u>. He allowed an unearned run on one hit with two hit batsmen, no walks, and two strikeouts over four innings.
