### SATURDAY IN THE PARK: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Great Lakes Loons 6-3 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#)

Alexander Cornielle pitched six scoreless innings and struck out six for his second win of the season. Wisconsin scored three runs in the first inning and added three more runs in the third for an early 6-0 lead. Jesus Chirinos hit a two-run home run in the third. The Loons scored three runs in the ninth to avoid the shutout.

**QUALITY IS JOB ONE:** Cornielle allowed two hits and walked three in his six scoreless innings for Wisconsin's second quality start of the series and third of 2024.

**FAST OUT OF THE BLOCKS:** Luis Lara singled to start Wisconsin's first inning. Dylan O'Rae followed with a walk. Luke Adams knocked in Lara with an single. Later in the first Eduarqui Fernández and Terence Doston had two-out, RBI singles to give the Rattlers a 3-0 lead. Wisconsin had outscored opponents 31-14 in the series.

**THREE IS A MAGIC NUMBER:** Lara and Doston both had three hits on Saturday. They accounted for 2/3 of Wisconsin's nine hits in the game.

**A FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING:** Yesterday was the first time this season that Dylan O'Rae played but did not bat in the lead-off spot. O'Rae was 0-for-1 but walked twice and was hit by a pitch to reach base three times. O'Rae scored a run to raise on his league-leading total to 25.

**LOOK OUT...AGAIN!** Luke Adams was hit by a pitch in the sixth inning yesterday. Adams has been hit by a pitch nine times this season, including once in each of the last three games. He leads the Midwest League in that category. Adams tied with Tim Locastro of El Paso, Braiden Ward of Spokane, and Ripken Reyes of San Antonio for the Minor League lead in hit batsmen.

**NO! REALLY! LOOK OUT:** Wisconsin hitters have been plunked nine times by Great Lakes pitchers in this series.

**ABOUT GREAT LAKES:** The Great Lakes Loons came into existence in 2007 after the Midwest League team left Battle Creek, Michigan at the end of the 2006 season. The team in Battle Creek had been known as the Michigan Battle Cats, Battle Creek Yankees, and the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays. The Loons have been affiliated with the Los Angeles Dodgers since 2007. They have made the Midwest League playoffs nine times since 2007. The Loons won the Midwest League title in 2016 and lost to Cedar Rapids in the Midwest League Championship Series in 2023. Notable Great Lakes alumni include Clayton Kershaw, Kenley Jansen, Nathan Eovaldi, Joc Peterson, Julio Urias, Walker Buehler, and Gavin Lux. Jair Fernandez, who played in 52 games with the Timber Rattlers in 2007, is the manager of the Loons in 2024.

**ABOUT THE DODGERS:** The Los Angeles Dodgers were only in the Midwest League for a few seasons prior to affiliating with the Loons. They were in Dubuque in 1967 and in Clinton from 1977 to 1979. Orel Hershiser and Steve Sax were notable Dodgers to play in Clinton.

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Luis Lara (#8), Luke Adams (#15), Dylan O'Rae (#20), Jadhav Areinamo (#22), and Patricio Aquino (#28). [MLB Pipeline](#) has five Great Lakes players on their list of Top 30 Dodgers prospects: Jackson Ferris (#7), Thayron Liranzo (#9), Maddux Bruns (#14), Noah Miller (#26), and Peter Heubeck (#30).

**THE SEASON SO FAR:** The Loons completed a six-game sweep at Fort Wayne on April 28. They are 16-8 and are the top team in the East Division. Great Lakes had an eight-game winning streak before losing last night.

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP EDWIN JIMENEZ:** Milwaukee signed Jimenez as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on October 11, 2018.

**HEADING TO THE CO-OP:** Jimenez was assigned to the Dominican Summer League Co-op team shared between Milwaukee and Cleveland for the 2019 season. Jimenez was 1-5 with a 3.05 ERA in twelve games – eight starts. He walked 26 and struck out 32 over 41-1/3 innings in his first professional season.

**FROM THE ISLAND TO THE DESERT:** Jimenez started the 2021 season with Milwaukee's number two affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. He was assigned to the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League on August 7, 2021. Jimenez went 1-1 with a 1.72 ERA in five games – four starts – in the DSL and 0-4 with a save and a 5.25 ERA in the ACL. He walked twelve and struck out 48 over 39-2/3 innings combined between his two stops in the system that season.

**THE FULL-SEASON JOURNEY:** Jimenez was 4-7 in 25 games – seventeen starts – with the Carolina Mudcats in 2022. He had a 4.75 ERA, walked 41, and struck out 104 over 113-2/3 innings pitched in the Carolina League last season. Jimenez started the 2023 season with Carolina and went 2-0 in four games – one start – with five walks and 23 strikeouts over eighteen innings before his promotion to Wisconsin on May 2. Once he was a Timber Rattler in 2023, Jimenez was 7-5 with a 4.50 ERA in 21 games – 15 starts – with 93 strikeouts over 102 innings pitched.

**NEAR MISS:** Jimenez was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on July 31, 2023 after a taking a no-hitter into the eighth inning against Cedar Rapids on [July 30](#). He earned the award by striking out ten Kernels over 7-1/3 scoreless innings at home. Jimenez walked three and didn't allow a hit until there was one out in the eighth inning.

**LAST START:** Jimenez won at Peoria on [April 28](#). He allowed six runs on nine hits with a walk and two strikeouts over five innings. Jimenez left the game with the Rattlers trailing 6-5, but the offense scored twice in the top of the sixth to take the lead for Jimenez to qualify for the win.

**VS. GREAT LAKES:** Jimenez made two starts – [June 13](#) and [June 18](#) – at Great Lakes in 2023. He had no record and allowed seven runs on nine hits with eight strikeouts over eight innings in the starts at Dow Diamond.

## GREAT LAKES STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP JACKSON FERRIS:** The Los Angeles Dodgers acquired Ferris along with Zyhvir Hope from the Chicago Cubs in exchange for Michael Busch and Yency Almonte in a trade on January 11, 2024.

**ORIGIN STORY:** The Cubs selected Ferris in the second round of the 2022 draft out of IMG Academy in Bradenton, Florida. In his senior season, Ferris was 8-0 with a 1.33 ERA in ten games at IMG Academy. Ferris signed with the Cubs over a commitment to Mississippi.

**A YEAR ON THE BEACH:** Ferris did not pitch professionally in 2022. He began his career with the Myrtle Beach Pelicans in the Carolina League in 2023. Ferris was 2-3 with a 3.38 ERA in eighteen starts. Ferris walked 33 and struck out 77 over 56 innings pitched for the Pelicans.

**YOU JUST MADE THE LISTS:** MLB Pipeline ranks Ferris as the #7 prospect in the Dodgers system. The *2024 Baseball America Prospect Handbook*, which went to press before the trade, had Ferris as the #10 prospect in the Cubs system. The online update at Baseball America's website puts Ferris at #9 in the Dodgers system.

**LAST START:** Ferris had a no decision at Wisconsin on [April 30](#) in game one of this series. He allowed four runs – two earned – on four hits with three walks and three strikeouts over three innings. Ferris was on the hook for the loss until the Loons offense rallied for the lead and an eventual 6-4 win.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Ferris had never pitched against the Timber Rattlers prior to last Tuesday. That was also the first time he pitched against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
