AUGUST, 2024:

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Great Lakes Loons beat the Wisconsin Timber Ratters 5-4 in twelve innings at Dow Diamond. Wisconsin had leads of 1-0, 2-1, 3-2, and 4-3, but stranded fourteen runners on base while going 3for-24 with runners in scoring position. Five Wisconsin pitchers combined to record 22 strikeouts in the game. Sam Mongelli drove in the winning run in the bottom of the twelfth with an RBI double. Wisconsin has lost four games in a row for the first time this season. They have also lost seven games in a row at Dow Diamond dating back to a 2022 trip here.

HE GOES TO ELEVEN: Wisconsin starting pitcher Alexander Cornielle matched his professional singlegame high for strikeouts last night. Cornielle allowed one run on four hits with three walks and struck out eleven over 4-2/3 innings

NOTES ABOUT A STREAK: The Timber Rattlers have scored first in each of the four games of their current losing streak. The Rattlers have lost on their opponents final at bat in the last three games. Wisconsin is 7-for-44 with runners in scoring position during the four-game losing streak.

A NOTE ABOUT ANOTHER STREAK: Eduardo Garcia extended his current hitting streak to seven games with an RBI double in the top of the twelfth to give Wisconsin a 4-3 lead.

ABOUT GREAT LAKES: The Great Lakes Loons came into existence in 2007 after the Midwest League team left Battle Creek, Michigan at the end of the 2006 season. The team in Battle Creek had been known as the Michigan Battle Cats, Battle Creek Yankees, and the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays. The Loons have been affiliated with the Los Angeles Dodgers since 2007. They have made the Midwest League playoffs nine times since 2007. The Loons won the Midwest League title in 2016 and lost to Cedar Rapids in the Midwest League Championship Series in 2023. Notable Great Lakes alumni include Clayton Kershaw, Kenley Jansen, Nathan Eovaldi, Joc Peterson, Julio Urias, Walker Buehler, and Gavin Lux. Jair Fernandez, who played in 52 games with the Timber Rattlers in 2007, is the manager of the Loons in 2024. ABOUT THE DODGERS: The Los Angeles Dodgers were only in the Midwest League for a few seasons prior to

affiliating with the Loons. They were in Dubuque in 1967 and in Clinton from 1977 to 1979. Orel Hershiser and Steve Sax were notable Dodgers to play in Clinton. PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places six

active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Cooper Pratt (#4), Luis Lara (#8), Luke Adams (#15), Jadher Areinamo (#21), Patricio Aquino (#28), Ryan Birchard (#30). MLB Pipeline has six Loons on their list of Top 30 Dodgers prospects: Josue De Paula (#2), Maddux Bruns (#18), Patrick Copen (#20), Peter Heubeck (#26), Payton Martin (#28), and Jesus Galiz (#30).

THE SEASON SO FAR: The Loons were 34-32 in the first half and missed the playoffs. They are currently 27-21 in the second half. They are in third place in the East Division and trail first place Dayton by four games.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JOSH TIMMERMAN: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Timmerman in the sixteenth round of the 2023 draft out of Ohio State University

THE OSU: Timmerman pitched one season at Ohio State. He appeared in thirteen games – six starts – and was 2-2 with an 8.37 ERA.

WABASH CANNONBALL: Timmerman pitched two seasons at Wabash Valley Community College before attending Ohio State. In 2022, he was 8-1 with a 3.41 ERA for Wabash Valley.

ARIZONA: Timmerman started his pro career with Milwaukee's Arizona Complex League. He was 0-1 in two games – one start – with two runs allowed on four hits over three innings in the regular season. Timmerman was the starting pitcher in Game One of the ACL Championship Series on August 25, 2023. He allowed two hits over three scoreless innings for a no decision.

BEFORE WISCONSIN: Timmerman was 4-2 with a 3.99 ERA in seventeen games – twelve starts – for the Carolina Mudcats before his promotion to Wisconsin on August 20. Timmerman walked 32 and struck out 62 over 56-1/3 innings for the Mudcats this season.

LAST START: Timmerman lost at Delmarva on <u>August 15</u>. He gave up an unearned run on three hits with a hit batsman and four strikeouts over three innings.

VS. GREAT LAKES: Timmerman has never pitched against the Loons prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers.

GREAT LAKES STARTING PITCHER:

RHP PETER HEUBECK: The Los Angeles Dodgers selected Heubeck in the third round of the 2021 draft out of Gilman High School in Baltimore, Maryland.

DON'T GO INTO THE FOREST: Heubeck signed with the Dodgers over a commitment to Wake Forest University.

THE RANKINGS: MLB Pipeline places Heubeck at the #26 spot in their list of Top Dodgers Prospects. *Baseball America* rates him at #21.

REPEATING THE LEVEL: Heubeck made a brief pro debut with the Dodgers Arizona Complex League team with two appearances in 2021. He began the 2022 season at Rancho Cucamonga in the California League. He was 0-1 with a 7.39 ERA in fifteen games — thirteen starts — and walked 25 with 42 strikeouts over 31-2/3 innings. Heubeck started the 2023 back in Rancho Cucamonga and went 3-5 with a 5.11 ERA in nineteen starts with 91 strikeouts over 68-2/3 innings before a promotion to Great Lakes on August 4, 2023.

AS A LOON LAST YEAR: Heubeck was 2-2 with an 8.47 ERA in six games – five starts – for the Loons in the regular season at the end of 2023. Heubeck also made two relief appearances without a decision in the 2023 Midwest League Playoffs for the Loons.

LAST START: Heubeck had a no decision at Lake County on <u>August 15</u>. He allowed a run on three hits with three walks, a hit batsman, and four strikeouts over four innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Heubeck lost at Wisconsin on May 2. He allowed two runs on four hits with six walks and five strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings.
