ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The South Bend Cubs beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 4-3 at Four Winds Field.](#)

The Cubs built an early lead and withstood late Wisconsin rallies in the sixth, seventh, eighth, and ninth innings. South Bend starting pitcher Nick Dean allowed one hit, walked none, and struck out five over five scoreless innings for the win. Jader Areinamo had two hits, scored a run, and drove in two for the Timber Rattlers.

TURNING POINT: The Cubs had a 2-0 lead after five innings. In the top of the sixth, Wisconsin had runners at second and third with one out but did not score. South Bend scored two runs – one earned – in the bottom of the sixth to take a 4-0 lead.

SO CLOSE: The Rattlers loaded the bases with no outs in the top of the seventh and scored a run on a Tayden Hall sacrifice fly. Areinamo drove in two runs with a two-out double in the top of the eighth. Matt Wood singled to open the ninth but was left stranded at second when the game ended.

A+: Areinamo is 5-for-11 in the first three games of the series. Areinamo has been a part of seven of the eight runs the Rattlers have scored in this series with the Cubs – five RBI and two runs scored.

A SMALL VILLAGE: Wisconsin has stranded 22 runners in the first three games of the series. The Rattlers are 4-for-27 with runners in scoring position so far in this series.

STILL PUTTING IT IN PLAY: Dean had five strikeouts over five innings. The Rattlers struck out just twice over the final four innings and they are still the toughest team in full season minor league baseball to K. Wisconsin and Frisco (Texas League) have each struck out 290 times. The Rattlers have played 42 games (6.90 K/game). Frisco has played 41 games (7.07 K/game).

MAKING A MOVE: The Milwaukee Brewers have assigned pitcher Logan Henderson to Wisconsin. Henderson is the Rattlers starter tonight.

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. South Bend has won Midwest League titles in 1989, 1993, 2005, 2019, and 2022. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, Carlos Gonzalez, and current Timber Rattlers manager Victor Estevez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982. Nick Lovullo, the son of Arizona Diamondbacks manager Torey Lovullo, is in his first year as South Bend's manager.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, and Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP LOGAN HENDERSON: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Henderson in the fourth round of the 2021 draft out of McClennan Community College in Texas.

THERE CAN BE ONLY ONE: Henderson was the NJCAA's Pitcher of the Year in 2021 after going 10-2 with a 1.66 ERA and 169 strikeouts in 97-2/3 innings as he helped the Highlanders to win the NJCAA National Title. He had 31 strikeouts in two appearances, including 17 in eight innings in the title game, during the NJCAA College World Series.

PROSPECT WATCHING: MLB Pipeline rates Henderson as the #16 prospect in the Brewers system. *Baseball America* places him at #23.

CAROLINA IN MY MIND: Henderson did not pitch professionally in 2021 after the draft and needed elbow surgery during spring training in 2022. The surgery held him to 13-2/3 innings late in the season with 11-2/3 innings with the Carolina Mudcats. Henderson made up for lost time in 2023 as he went 4-3 with a 2.75 ERA in eighteen regular season starts for Carolina with 106 strikeouts over 78-2/3 innings. He also was the starting pitcher in Game Two of Carolina's playoff series with Down East. Henderson allowed three runs on four hits with two walks and five strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings for a no decision.

SHORT SHOWCASE: Henderson opened the 2024 season on the IL due to an injury to his left oblique that he suffered while pitching in the Spring Breakout Game against a team of Royals prospects on May 17. He worked his way to the Rattlers with two rehab starts for the ACL Brewers in which he pitched 4-2/3 scoreless innings with ten strikeouts.

LAST START: Henderson made a brief start for the ACL Brewers against the ACL Mariners on [May 16](#). He allowed two hits, walked none, and struck out five over 2-2/3 scoreless innings.

VS. SOUTH BEND: Henderson has never pitched against South Bend prior to this evening. He had a no decision against Myrtle Beach, the Carolina League affiliate of the Chicago Cubs, on [July 15, 2023](#). Henderson allowed two runs on three hits with a walk and eight strikeouts over five innings.

SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

LHP DREW GRAY: The Chicago Cubs selected Gray in the 3rd round of the 2021 draft out of IMG Academy in Bradenton, Florida.

START & STOP START: Gray was the top prep prospect in Illinois in 2020 before transferring to IMG Academy for his senior season. Gray signed after the Cubs picked him, but and made his pro debut in the ACL in 2021 before injuring his elbow in February of 2022. The injury led to Tommy John Surgery. He did not pitch again until 2023.

HARD RESET: Gray got back on the mound with a start against the ACL Padres on June 6, 2023. He made three brief starts in the ACL before a promotion to Myrtle Beach in the Carolina League.

WORKING ON THE BEACH: Gray was 0-3 with a 4.23 ERA in eleven starts for the Pelicans in the Carolina League. Gray walked 23 and struck out 45 over 27-2/3 innings at Myrtle Beach in 2023.

HOW DOES HE RATE? MLB Pipeline puts Gray as the #10 prospect in the Cubs system. *Baseball America* places Gray as the #18 prospect in the Cubs system.

LAST START: Gray had a no decision at Fort Wayne on [May 17](#). He gave up four runs on two hits with five walks and a hit batsman over two innings. Gray struck out two in the game.

VS. WISCONSIN: Gray was the losing pitcher in game one of a doubleheader at Four Winds Field on [April 12](#). He allowed a run on a hit with five walks and four strikeouts in three innings. Wisconsin won the game 1-0.
