SATURDAY IN THE PARK: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the South Bend Cubs 9-2 at Neuroscience Group Field. Brandon Knarr struck out seven over six scoreless innings for the win and Zach Mort worked the final three innings for the save. The Timber Rattlers offense scored three runs in the first and three runs in the second to take an early 6-0 lead. The win snapped a three-game losing streak with the victory.

SIX-PACK: Knarr has won six straight starts. He has allowed two runs over thirty innings in his last four starts. Knarr leads the Midwest League in wins (6) and innings pitched (46.1), is second in ERA (1.17), and is third in strikeouts (55).

FIRST! Mort got the final nine outs of the game to earn his first professional save.

LET'S GO! Tyler Black had three hits, stole three bases, and scored two runs out of Wisconsin's leadoff spot. Saturday was Black's third three-hit game of the season

PRODUCTIVE DAY: Every Timber Rattler in Saturday's lineup reached base at least once. Eight of the nine players in the lineup had at least one hit with Joe Gray Jr., Tristan Peters, Wes Clarke, and Carlos Rodríguez each having two hits. Additionally, the Rattlers were 7for-18 with runners in scoring position in the game.

GOING DEEP: Zavier Warren hit his second home run of the season when he cracked a solo shot in the bottom of the eighth inning on Saturday. The homer was the third of the series for the Timber Rattlers. Wisconsin has hit 28 home runs in 2022 and just eight of those homers have been at Neuroscience Group

**BRING YOUR FRIENDS:** Saturday's attendance of 4,087 is the largest of the season – to date – for the Timber Rattlers. That makes two days in a row for Wisconsin to set a new season-high for attendance on the season.

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs. South Bend won Midwest League pennants in 1989, 1993, 2005, and 2019. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, and Carlos Gonzalez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts seven Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#6), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Zavier Warren (#17), Carlos Rodríguez (#21), and Cam Robinson (#26). # PITCHING MATCHUP

### WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP ANTOINE KELLY:** Selected by the Brewers in the second round of the 2019 draft out of Wabash Valley College in Mt. Carmel, Illinois. He is rated as the #14 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline. *Baseball America* places Kelly at #10 for their in-season update of Milwaukee prospects.

WARRIORS...COME OUT TO PLAY: Kelly was 9-0 with 112 strikeouts in thirteen starts for the Warriors prior to the draft. He allowed 21 hits, 19 earned runs, and 31 walks over 52-2/3 innings pitched at Wabash Valley College

SAYING NO TO SAN DIEGO: The San Diego Padres selected Kelly in the thirteenth round of the 2018 draft after his senior season at Maine East High School in Park Ridge, Illinois. Kelly chose junior college over signing with the Padres

**THE BOYHOOD DREAM COMES TRUE:** Kelly has been a Milwaukee Brewers fan since he was young.

WHAT'S BREWING? Kelly made his pro debut in the AZL with the Brewers Blue and made one start for the Rattlers in 2019. He spent 2020 with the Brewers Alternate Training Site. He underwent surgery for Thoracic Outlet Syndrome on November 5, 2020 and has worked his way back to Wisconsin after a relief appearance in Arizona and seven starts with Carolina before joining the Rattlers near the end of the 2021 season.

**LAST START:** Kelly had a <u>no decision against South Bend on May 17 in</u> the first game of this series. He allowed one run on five hits with a walk and five strikeouts over 6-1/3 innings pitched.

**VS. SOUTH BEND:** Kelly's start on May 17 was the first time he has faced South Bend in his career. It was also his first time pitching against an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs.

### SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

RHP KOHL FRANKLIN: The Chicago Cubs selected Franklin in the sixth round of the 2018 draft out of Broken Arrow (OK) High School. MLB Pipeline ranks Franklin as the #12 prospect in the Cubs system. Baseball America rates Franklin at #21 in their in-season update of Cubs prospects.

**SOONER GO PRO:** Franklin turned down college baseball for the University of Oklahoma to sign with the Cubs. He was the only high school player from Oklahoma to be picked in the 2018 draft.

IT'S ALL RELATIVE: Former Major League pitcher Ryan Franklin is Kohl Franklin's uncle. Ryan Franklin pitched for the Appleton Foxes in 1994.

**STARTING OUT:** Franklin started his professional career in the Arizona League with the Cubs #2 affiliate in 2018. In 2019, he made ten starts for the Eugene Emeralds of the Northwoods League and one start with South Bend in the Midwest League.

**MISSING OUT:** Franklin did not pitch in 2020 due to the shutdown. He also missed the 2021 season due to oblique and shoulder issues.

**LAST START:** Franklin had a <u>no decision against Fort Wayne at home on May 10</u>. He allowed three runs on four hits with a walk and two strikeouts over 2-1/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Franklin had never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this afternoon. He has faced a Brewers affiliate one time in his career before today. Franklin made a relief appearance against Milwaukee's AZL affiliate on August 3. 2018. He allowed a hit with no walks and three strikeouts over two scoreless innings for a no decision.
