ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Peoria Chiefs beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 4-3 at Dozer Park](#). Peoria hit three home runs early to take a 4-1 lead and they held off a late rally by the Rattlers.

BARRAGE: The Chiefs scored three runs in the second inning. Tyler Reichenborn hit a solo homer with one out and Matt Chamberlain hit a two-run home run with two outs. Those two blasts gave the Chiefs a 3-0 lead. Chandler Redmond homered in the 4th, a solo shot, and Peoria was up 4-1.

PEORIA POWER: The Chiefs have 64 home runs this season. They have hit 29 of those home runs in 21 games against Wisconsin with the other 33 homers coming in 42 games against the rest of the league. Redmond has hit four of his nine home runs this season against Wisconsin.

RATTLER RUNS: Thomas Dillard drove in a run with a double in the top of the fourth. Yeison Coca singled in a run in the seventh and LG Castillo had an RBI single in the top of the ninth.

MISSED IT BY THAT MUCH: Castillo's RBI single came with no outs in the top of the ninth and he was at first with the tying run. He next three batters were retired and the game ended with Castillo stranded at first.

MULTI-BALL: Carlos Rodríguez had two more hits last night for his second straight multi-hit game. He had a single in the seventh and a double in the ninth. Rodríguez is 5-for-10 in the last two games and has twelve multi-hit games this season.

ANOTHER CLOSE ONE: Wisconsin and Peoria have played 21 times this season. Last night was the seventh time the teams have played a game decided by one run. Wisconsin is 3-4 in one-run games against the Chiefs this season.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1957 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1956 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels in 1983.

They changed their name to the Chiefs and their affiliation to the Chicago Cubs for the 1984 season. They became a Cardinals affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. Chris Swauger is back as the manager of the Chiefs this year. Swauger managed the Chiefs in 2017 and 2018 when Peoria was in the Midwest League. The Chiefs made the Midwest League Championship Series but lost to Bowling Green in the Finals under Swauger in 2018. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, and Yadier Molina.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to Springfield from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first time with Peoria. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) puts five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Carlos Rodríguez (#14), Hayden Cantrelle (#16), Nick Kahle (#20), Thomas Dillard (#22), and David Hamilton (#27). [MLB Pipeline](#) has two current Chiefs on their list of St. Louis prospects: Jordan Walker (#6) and Jhon Torres (#7). Ian Bedell (#11) is on the Peoria IL.

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JUSTIN BULLOCK: Selected by the Brewers in the 16th round of the 2017 draft out of South Granville (NC) High School.

HE'S A PLAYER: Bullock was named the North Carolina Baseball Coaches Association 2A Player of the Year in 2017. He was 11-1 with a 0.55ERA and 124 strikeouts in 63-2/3 innings pitched on the mound. Bullock also hit .476 with eleven homers and 46RBI.

LET'S GO PRO: Bullock signed with the Brewers over a commitment to North Carolina State University.

IN ARIZONA: Bullock went 1-0 with a 3.09ERA in six games – one start – for the AZL Brewers after signing with Milwaukee in 2017. He walked three and struck out eleven in 11-2/3 innings pitched in his debut season.

A SEASON IN MONTANA: Bullock made 13 starts for Helena in 2018. He was 2-5 with 66 strikeouts in 58-2/3 innings pitched. Bullock finished fourth in the Pioneer League in strikeouts.

TIME WITH THE TIMBER RATTLERS: Bullock was 2-2 with a 7.78 ERA, 14 walks and 20 strikeouts over 19-2/3 innings in seven games – three starts – for Wisconsin in 2019.

CAROLINA ON MY MIND: Bullock started this season with the Carolina Mudcats in the Low-A East. He was 1-1 in four starts with a 1.42 ERA. He walked five and struck out 27 over 19 innings pitched with the Mudcats this season. He finished on a 15-2/3 inning scoreless streak.

AWARD WINNING: Bullock was the High-A Central League's pitcher of the month for June. He was 3-1 with a 3.00 ERA in four starts with Wisconsin. Bullock walked one and struck out 23 over 24 innings during the month. One of his wins was the first five innings of a combined no-hitter [at South Bend on June 10](#).

LAST START: Bullock lost to Quad Cities at home on [July 9](#). He allowed four runs on eight hits over 5-1/3 innings with two walks and four strikeouts.

VS. PEORIA: Bullock is 2-0 in two starts against the Chiefs this season. He allowed one run on three hits over six innings on [June 22](#) and gave up two runs on five hits as he pitched a seven-inning complete game for a win in [game one of a doubleheader on June 27](#). Both starts were at Neuroscience Group Field and he struck out eight without giving up a walk in the games.

PEORIA STARTING PITCHER

RHP NICK TROGRIC-IVERSON: The Cardinals signed Trogrlic-Iverson as a undrafted free agent out of Gonzaga on June 16, 2020

WHAT COULD HAVE BEEN: Trogrlic-Iverson was drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 15th round of the 2018 draft out of Central Arizona Community College. He elected to attend Gonzaga.

COMMUNITY: Trogrlic-Iverson was 12-6 and had 131 strikeouts over his two seasons with the Vaqueros of Central Arizona CC. In his final season of JUCO, Trogrlic-Iverson had 91 strikeouts over 76 innings pitched.

BULLDOG YEARS: Trogrlic-Iverson was 4-3 with a save in 26 appearances – seven starts – in his first season at Gonzaga. In 2020, Trogrlic-Iverson made four starts and had 20 strikeouts in 21-1/3 innings pitched before the season shut down.

AL BUILT OUR CONDO IN PALM BEACH: Trogrlic-Iverson started the 2021 season with the Palm Beach Cardinals of the Low-A Southeast League. He was 0-1 with a 2.25 ERA in three starts for the Cardinals before getting bumped to Peoria.

LAST START: Trogrlic-Iverson lost at Cedar Rapids on [July 10](#). He allowed four runs on seven hits with four walks and two strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Trogrlic-Iverson is 0-1 in two starts against Wisconsin this season. He had a no decision against the Timber Rattlers [on June 3](#) and lost [game one of a doubleheader on June 27](#). Both starts were at Wisconsin. Trogrlic-Iverson has allowed nine runs on fourteen hits with six walks and six strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings against Wisconsin in 2021.
