INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Nick Yorke homered and reached base three times as the Indianapolis Indians surged to a sixth consecutive victory with a 7-2 triumph over the Columbus Clippers on Tuesday night at Huntington Park. Yorke proved to be the key performer for Indianapolis, but a two-run fourth inning was decisive in the victory. With the game tied at two, Ronny Simon lined a double into the left-field corner to plate Shawn Ross and Alike Williams. The smash put the Indians ahead for good. The teams traded two-run frames early in the contest. Yorke worked a walk in the top of the first inning and scored on a double by Jack Suwinski. Billy Cook's first of three hits on the night advanced Suwinski home, and the Indians led 2-0. That lead was erased when Columbus plated a pair in the bottom of the third. An error allowed the first run to score, and a single by Chase DeLauter tied the game. After they regained the lead with the rally in the fourth, the Indians added to their advantage. A sacrifice fly by Williams advanced the lead to 5-2 in the sixth, and Yorke provided the knockout punch in the eighth. With Williams aboard via a single, Yorke pulled his fourth home run of the season down the left-field line to extend the Indians lead and give the game its final margin. Bubba Chandler started the game for Indy and received a no-decision. He conceded a pair of runs over four innings. Ryder Ryan fired scoreless frames in the fifth and sixth to earn the win. Columbus starter Doug Nixhazy took the loss. He allowed four runs in five innings pitched.

SIX IS A SERIOUS NUMBER: The Indians' six-game winning streak dating back to May 12 vs. St. Paul is their second-longest of the season, only trailing a seven-game streak from May 11-18. This is the first time the Indians have ripped off multiple winning streaks of six or more games in the first half since 2017, when they won six straight from 5/6-11 and eight straight from 5/16-21. The Indians offense has scored 36 runs across their winning streak, which is the most by an International League team in this span. Additionally, they rank third among International League clubs in batting average (.293, 56-for-191) and fifth in OPS (.816). Indy's pitching staff has struck out the second-most batters (58) in Triple-A in this span and rank fifth in ERA (2.25, 13er/52.0ip), WHIP (1.06) and opponent OPS (.602).

WHAT WAS SIX AFRAID OF?: The Indians have scored seven runs in each of their last two games and in three of their last four since June 13 vs. St. Paul. Indy is 17-0 in games where they score seven runs this season, joining Jacksonville (12-0) as the only Triple-A teams to have not lost a game in which they scored seven. This is the first time Indianapolis has been undefeated in games they score seven through June 17 since 2017, when they were 15-0 at this point in the season.

THERE'S NO TYING IN BASEBALL: The Indians battled to win another tie game on Tuesday night. Indianapolis leads International League clubs this season with a .309 batting average when the team is tied and ranks third with a .833 OPS. Indians' hitters improve that mark to a .332 batting average and .870 OPS when runners are on base in the same situation, which rank first and third respectively among International League offenses.

JACK ATTACK: Jack Suwinski doubled and drove in a run last night, extending his on-base streak to 16 games since May 28, only trailing Ji Hwan Bae's active 20-game run as the longest on the team this season. Across his streak, Suwinski is hitting .310 (18-for-58) with four doubles, a triple and four homers while tying for the third-most RBI (16) and ranking seventh in OPS (1.012) among International League hitters in this span. Additionally, he's hit safely in a season-high seven straight games since June 8 at Memphis and is hitting .370 (10-for-27) with a 1.178 OPS in that stretch. Suwinski leads Indians hitters this season in home runs (9), RBI (36) and extra-base hits (17) despite playing his first Triple-A game on April 25. Since his Triple-A season debut, he is tied for the fourth-most RBI and sixth-most home runs of any International League hitter. With runners in scoring position this season, he ranks second among Triple-A hitters (min. 50 PA) in batting average (.415, 17-for-41) and third in OPS (1.240).

NEW YORK(E) STATE OF MIND: Nick Yorke went 2-for-4 with a two-run home run in the eighth inning, marking his second straight game with multiple hits and RBI. Yorke's homer snapped a streak of 33 games without a home run since May 3 at Omaha. That homerless streak was the second-longest of his career, only behind the first 35 games he played in professional baseball from May 4-June 18, 2021, while with Low-A Salem. Yorke has hit safely in 22 of his last 27 games dating back to May 15 vs. Louisville. In that stretch, he is hitting .323 (32-for-99) with six doubles, a triple, 14 RBI, and 14 runs scored and a .814 OPS. During this span, he ranks third among International League hitters with a .281 batting average (18-for-64) in two-strike counts (min. 60 PA). Yorke is also hitting .345 (10-for-29) with three doubles, a triple, 12 RBI and a .958 OPS with runners in scoring position in this stretch.

RONNY RAKES: Ronny Simon went 1-for-4 with a walk and a two-run double in the fourth inning, which proved to be the game-winning hit. Simon has hit safely in eight of nine games he has played since joining the Indians on June 6 at Memphis, and he has reached base multiple times in six of those games. Since debuting with Indy, Simon is hitting .297 (11-for-37) with three doubles, a homer, five RBI, five stolen bases and a .840 OPS.

YEAN SHORTS: Eddy Yean started on Sunday as part of a bullpen game and turned in 2.0 scoreless innings while facing the minimum six batters despite surrendering a walk. It was Yean's first start since June 23, 2023, vs. High-A Winston-Salem and his fourth career scoreless start in 30 chances. Yean has not allowed an earned run in any of his last five appearances and has allowed no runs in 16 of his 19 appearances since April 11 at Louisville. He has pitched to a 4-0 record and has the tenth-lowest ERA (1.71, 5er/26.1ip) of any Triple-A pitcher with at least 25.0 innings pitched in that span.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians and Columbus Clippers continue their six-game set on Wednesday night at 7:05 PM from Huntington Park. Indianapolis has not lost a series this season after winning the first game this season, winning four sets and splitting one. Tonight's billing features a pair of southpaws with Hunter Barco, MiLB's No. 88 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, taking the mound for Indy against Columbus' Parker Messick. Barco has faced Columbus once, in his Triple-A debut on May 9, and he held them to two hits and one run while striking out five across 4.1 innings of work. Messick made his sole start against the Indians the next day on May 10 and struck out nine across 5.0 scoreless innings.

ON THIS DATE IN 1933: With two base knocks, Frank Sigafos extended his hitting streak to 37 games to break the American Association record. Paul "Daffy" Dean, brother of Dizzy Dean, earned the win in a complete-game effort.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Hunter Barco: The southpaw ranks as Pittsburgh's No. 5 prospect and Minor League Baseball's No. 88 overall prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

Historic Zeroes: Barco did not allow a run in his six starts with Double-A Altoona, totaling 25.2 consecutive scoreless innings to begin the season, marking the longest scoreless streak in Curve history.

Last Outing: Barco earned the win, allowing three hits and a run while striking out three across 5.0 innings of work in Game 1 of a doubleheader on June 12 vs. St. Paul.

Against the Clippers: Barco made his Triple-A debut against Columbus on May 9 and allowed two hits and a run while striking out five in 4.1 innings.

EAS Pitcher of the Month: Barco was awarded the 2025 Eastern League April Pitcher of the Month Award after leading the league (min. 20ip) in ERA (0.00, 20.2ip) and batting average against (.132, 9-for-68), while ranking second in WHIP (0.63) and tied for fourth in strikeouts (30).

Mowing Them Down: Barco finshed his award-winning April with back-to-back eight-strikeout starts, the last of which came in just 3.0 innings of work on April 27 at Double-A Chesapeake. He became the first Pirates full-season farmhand to strike out eight or more batters in 3.0 innings or less since Osvaldo Bido also struck out eight in 3.0 innings vs. Triple-A Louisville on Aug. 4th, 2022.

Miscellaneous: Barco was selected by the Pirates in the second round (44th overall) of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Florida (Gainesville).
