ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Great Lakes Loons 6-4 at Dow Diamond.
Wisconsin broke a 2-2 tie with three runs in the top of the fifth inning and held on for the win.

EARLY INDICATOR: Wisconsin took a 2-0 lead on a two-out, two-run double by Hedbert Pérez in the top of the first inning. Wisconsin is 22-8 when they score first.

QUALITY IS JOB ONE: Anthony Flores scattered seven hits and allowed two runs - one earned - over six innings for a quality start. Flores struck out five in the game, his longest start as a pro.

IN THE LEAD: The Loons tied the game with two runs in the bottom of the second. Jadher Areinamo gave Wisconsin the lead back with an RBI double and a second run scored on an error on the play. Blake Burke followed with an RBI single for a 5-3 advantage.

PLAYING IN TRAFFIC: Great Lakes loaded the bases with no outs against Flores in the fifth, loaded the bases with no outs against Bayden Root in the seventh, and had runners on the corners with no outs against Root in the eighth. The Loons scored one run in all those opportunities. Great Lakes left eleven on base and was 2-for-11 with runners on scoring position last night.

**EMERGENCY CLOSER:** Wisconsin reliever Yerlin Rodriguez and Great Lakes outfielder Kendall George were ejected after Rodriguez walked George to start the bottom of the ninth and there was a bench-clearing incident. Miles Langhorne was called into the game to finish the game. He allowed an RBI double to Zyhir Hope and walked Kyle Nevin to bring the potential winning run to the plate, but struck out three for his first Midwest League save.

ABOUT GREAT LAKES: The Great Lakes Loons came into existence in 2007 after the Midwest League team left Battle Creek, Michigan at the end of the 2006 season. The team in Battle Creek had been known as the Michigan Battle Cats, Battle Creek Yankees, and the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays. The Loons have been affiliated with the Los Angeles Dodgers since 2007. They have made the Midwest League playoffs nine times since 2007. The Loons won the Midwest League title in 2016 and lost to Cedar Rapids in the Midwest League Championship Series in 2023. Notable Great Lakes alumni include Clayton Kershaw, Kenley Jansen, Nathan Eovaldi, Joc Peterson, Julio Urias, Walker Buehler, and Gavin Lux. Jair Fernandez, who played in 52 games with the Timber Rattlers in 2007, is in his second season as the manager of the Loons

ABOUT THE DODGERS: The Los Angeles Dodgers were only in the Midwest League for a few seasons prior to affiliating with the Loons. They were in Dubuque in 1967 and in Clinton from 1977 to 1979. Orel Hershiser and Steve Sax were notable Dodgers to play in Clinton.

## **■ PITCHING MATCHUP**

#### WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP SAM GARCIA:** The Milwaukee Brewers selected Garcia in the eighth round of the 2024 draft out of Oklahoma State.

**HITTING THE HIGH POINT:** Garcia pitched three seasons at High Point University from 2021 through 2023. He was a First Team All-Big South selection after his sophomore season when he was 5-4 with a save and a 1.94 ERA in sixteen games – eight starts.

**STILLWATER:** Garcia pitched for Brewster of the Cape Cod League in 2023 and transferred to Oklahoma State University for his final season of collegiate baseball. As a Cowboy, Garcia was 7-3 with a 3.64 ERA in sixteen starts. He had 115 strikeouts over 89 innings.

STARTING OUT: Garcia did not pitch professionally last year. He made his pro debut with the Carolina Mudcats this season and was 5-1 with a save and a 2.08 ERA in ten appearances – two starts. Garcia walked nineteen and struck out 44 in 34-2/3 innings with Carolina before his promotion to Wisconsin on June 3.

**LAST START:** Garcia won his Timber Rattlers debut on <u>June 8</u> at home against Cedar Rapids. He allowed two runs on four hits with a walk and four strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings.

**VS. GREAT LAKES:** Garcia has never faced the Loons before tonight. This evening is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers.

#### **GREAT LAKES STARTING PITCHER:**

**RHP SEAN LINAN:** The Los Angeles Dodgers signed Linan as an International Free Agent out of Colombia on January 15, 2022.

STEP-BY-STEP: Linan pitched for the Dodgers Bautista affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 and the Arizona Complex League Dodgers in 2023. Last year, Linan made six appearances – one start – for the ACL Dodgers and thirteen appearances – four starts – for the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes of the California League. He was 9-2 with a 4.37 ERA with 26 walks and 96 strikeouts in 70 innings in both stops in 2024.

FREQUENT FLYER: Linan started 2025 with Rancho Cucamonga, was assigned to Great Lakes on May 8, assigned to Oklahoma City of the Pacific Coast League on May 17, reassigned to Great Lakes on May 18, reassigned to Oklahoma City on May 23, and moved back to Great Lakes on May 27. He went 2-1 with a 1.21 ERA in six games – five starts at Rancho Cucamonga, 0-1 with a 9.82ERA in two starts for Oklahoma City, and 0-1 with a 2.79 ERA in three games – one start for the Loons.

**LAST START:** Linan lost to Sacramento in a Pacific Coast League game on May 23. He allowed six runs on four hits with three walks and six strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings.

**LAST GAME:** Linan pitched four innings in relief at South Bend on <u>June</u> <u>8</u>. He allowed three runs on three hits with two walks and four strikeouts for a no decision.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Linan has never faced the Timber Rattlers before this evening. The last time he started against an affiliate of the Brewers was on <u>July 5, 2023</u> in an ACL game. Linan allowed five runs – two earned – on six hits with two walks and four strikeouts in three innings.
