#### ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The South Bend Cubs beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 10-6 at Neuroscience Group Field at Fox Cities Stadium.](#)

The Timber Rattlers hit three home runs and took a 6-2 lead into the top of the fourth inning. The Cubs tied the game with four runs in the fourth and scored four runs in the top of the seventh to take the lead. South Bend outhit Wisconsin 15-8.

**TWO-OUT BLUES:** The Cubs scored seven runs after they had two outs in an inning last night. The Wisconsin defense was charged with four errors last night and all four came with two outs in an inning. Opponents are 36-for-115 with an OPS of .905 and 47 RBI with runners in scoring position and two outs against the Rattlers this season.

**MISSED OPPORTUNITIES:** Wisconsin had a runner at second with no outs in the bottom of the fifth and a runner at third with no outs in the bottom of the sixth. Wisconsin could not score either runner to take the lead. Wisconsin is 43-for-248 with runners in scoring position (.173 average and .560 OPS) and 14-for-105 (.133 average and .464 OPS) with runners in scoring position and two outs.

**GOING DEEP!** Je'Von Ward hit a three-run home run in the bottom of the third inning. In the fourth inning, Eric Brown Jr hit a solo homer and Ben Metzinger hit a two-run homer. Brown has extended his current on-base streak to ten games. Metzinger has a six-game hitting streak to match Brown and Darrien Miller for the longest hitting streak on the team.

**YOU SHALL NOT PASS!** Alex Hall threw Fabian Pertuz out at the plate twice last night. Hall leads the Timber Rattlers in outfield assists with four. Miller threw out two of the three Cubs runners who tried to steal a base on him last night. The Rattlers catcher has caught 11 of 32 (34.4%) runners trying to run on him this season.

**RECENT HISTORY:** The Timber Rattlers are on an eight-game losing streak. They have been outscored 15-5 in the first inning in the last eight games.

**ABOUT SOUTH BEND:** The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. They are the defending Midwest League Champions after finishing 73-58 last season, beating Cedar Rapids in the Western Division Finals, and Lake County in the Championship Series. South Bend also won Midwest League pennants in 1989, 1993, 2005, and 2019. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, and Carlos Gonzalez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982.

**ABOUT THE CUBS:** The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

**SEASON SO FAR:** South Bend are 15-12 on the season. They are tied with Peoria for second place in the Western Division. Both teams are 1-1/2 games behind first-place Beloit. In their most recent series, the Cubs went 2-4 at home against Cedar Rapids. South Bend starts a series at Beloit on May 16.

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) places five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Eric Brown Jr (#8), Robert Moore (#10), Hendry Mendez (#15), Eduardo García (#21), and Joseph Hernandez (#28). [MLB Pipeline](#) has four active South Bend players on their list of Cubs prospects: Kevin Alcántara (#2), Cade Horton (#4), James Triantos (#11), and Kevin Made (#15). Ed Howard (#22) has not played this season and is on the South Bend Injured List.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP TYLER WOESSNER:** Drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in the sixth round of the 2022 draft out of Central Arizona College.

**WHAT A SEASON:** Woessner went 11-2 with a 3.55 ERA in nineteen games – eighteen starts – during his final season at CAC. He walked 34 and struck out 122 in 96-1/3 innings pitched for the Vaqueros.

**PITCHING INTO THE FINALS:** Central Arizona College advanced to the 2022 NJCAA College World Series in Grand Junction, Colorado. Woessner was the winning pitcher in the game that got CAC into the Championship game as he allowed three runs and struck out eight over seven innings in the Vaqueros' 7-4 win over Walters State Community College on [June 3, 2022](#). Central Arizona College won the National Title the next day with a 4-2 win over Cowley County Community College.

**NORTH TO ALASKA:** Woessner pitched in three games – one start – for the Mat-Su Miners of the Alaska Baseball League in 2021. He had no record, walked three, and struck out four over seven innings.

**FIRST YEAR AS A BREWER:** Woessner started his pro career with the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and made three appearances – two starts – with eleven strikeouts over six scoreless innings. Woessner also made one start for the Carolina Mudcats at the end of the 2022 Carolina League season.

**LAST START:** Woessner had a [no decision at Peoria on May 5](#). He allowed four runs – two earned – on four hits with three walks and two strikeouts over four innings.

**VS. SOUTH BEND:** Woessner has never faced the Cubs prior to this evening. The only time he has pitched against an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs was on [August 15, 2022](#). Woessner allowed a hit with no walks and five strikeouts over two scoreless innings as the starter for the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League. He had a no decision in that game.

## SOUTH BEND SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP CONNOR NOLAND:** The Chicago Cubs selected Noland in the ninth round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Arkansas. Noland was a teammate of Timber Rattler Robert Moore at Arkansas.

**THE ARK:** Noland pitched four seasons with the Razorbacks and was 14-11 with a 3.85 ERA and 202 strikeouts over 225-2/3 innings in 52 games – 41 starts. In his final season at Arkansas, Noland was 8-6 with a 3.65 ERA in 20 games – 19 start – and 113 strikeouts over 116 innings.

**TWO-SPORT PLAYER:** Noland was recruited to play football at Arkansas and appeared in four games at quarterback in 2018. He made a start against Tulsa on October 20, 2018. Noland was 21-for-42 on passing attempts for 255 yards and one touchdown.

**OMAHA!** Noland was 1-1 in two starts during the Razorbacks run in the 2022 College World Series. He beat Stanford on June 18 with six strikeouts over 6-2/3 scoreless innings and lost to Mississippi on June 23 despite allowing two runs and striking out seven over eight innings.

**GETTING STARTED:** Noland did not pitch professionally in 2022. He made his professional debut with South Bend in a [start at home on April 11, 2023 against the Beloit Sky Carp](#). Noland allowed a run on four hits with no walks and seven strikeouts over four innings for a no decision.

**LAST START:** Noland had a [no decision against Cedar Rapids at home on May 4](#). He allowed a run on five hits with no walks and three strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Noland has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers. Tonight is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
