WELCOME BACK: Matulovich was a Timber Rattlers reliever at the end of the 2019 season. He began this season in Carolina and made just two starts before being promoted earlier this week. He allowed five hits, walked none, and struck out four over five innings to pick up the win.

NASH RAMBLING: Walters has not allowed a run in his last six appearances. He gave up three runs before recording the final five outs of his appearance against Quad Cities on July 10. Including those outs, Walters scoreless innings streak has reached 9-1/3 innings over seven appearances

GETTING OFFENSIVE: Wisconsin scored an unearned run in the bottom of the fifth. They added three insurance runs in the eighth inning on RBI singles by Joe Gray Jr and Je'Von Ward and an RBI fielder's choice by LG Castillo.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The Cedar Rapids Kernels are charter members of the High-A Central League. The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels made the Midwest League playoffs every year they were affiliated with the Twins. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, and Ted Simmons

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota's former High-A Affiliate was the Fort Myers Miracle in the Florida State League. From 1995 through 2019, the Twins were affiliated with four teams in the Midwest League. They were with the Fort Wayne Wizards (1995-1998), Quad City River Bandits (1999-2005), Beloit Snappers (2006-2012), and Cedar Rapids Kernels (2013-2019)

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP VICTOR CASTAÑEDA: The Brewers signed Castañeda as a Minor League Free Agent off the reserve list of Toros de Tijuana from the Mexican League on July 4, 2017.

TORO! TORO! Castañeda was 3-1 with a 3.00 ERA over nine games – four starts – for Tijuana in 2017 as an 18-year-old.

FROM MEXICO TO MONTANA: Castañeda was 2-6 with a 5.13 ERA in fourteen games – eight starts for Helena in the Pioneer League in 2018. He walked fifteen and struck out 40 in 47-1/3 innings pitched last season.

WELCOME TO WISCONSIN: Castañeda was assigned to the Rattlers on May 20, 2019. He was 4-2 with six saves in 32 appearance – one start – with Wisconsin. Castañeda walked 14 and struck out 53 in 44 innings pitched during the 2019 season with the Rattlers.

THE SEASON WAS NOT OVER: Castañeda was assigned to the Glendale Desert Dogs for the 2019 Arizona Fall League by the Brewers at the end of the Wisconsin season. He was 3-1 with a 1.99 ERA, six walks, and 29 strikeouts over 22-2/3 innings pitched in six games – five starts – for the Desert Dogs. Castañeda was named the AFL Pitcher of the Wek on September 25. 2019.

AWARD WINNING: Castañeda was named the High-A Central League Pitcher of the Week on May 31 for his performance <u>at Cedar Rapids on May 28</u>. He allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out eight over 6-2/3 scoreless innings in the game.

LAST START: Castañeda beat the South Bend Cubs at home on July 24. He allowed two runs on six hits with three walks and six strikeouts over five innings.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS (2021): Castañeda had a no decision <u>at Cedar</u> Rapids on May 28. He allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out eight over 6-2/3 innings in the game. Wisconsin would win the game 6-2.

CEDAR RAPIDS STARTING PITCHER:

RHP BEN GROSS: The Twins selected Gross in the 10th round of the 2019 draft out of Duke.

BLUE DEVIL DAYS: Gross was 8-4 in his only season at Duke. He had a 4.40 ERA with 76 strikeouts over 75-2/3 innings pitched.

GETTING THE CALL: Gross was the starting pitcher in Duke's first game at the Morgantown Regional in 2019 and picked up the win against Texas A & M. He also started Game One of the Super Regional at Vanderbilt and picked up the win in that game, too.

A TIGER, TOO: Gross pitched three seasons at Princeton before going to Duke. He was picked in the 34th round of the 2018 draft by the Houston Astros after he was named Second Team All-Ivy League after that season with Princeton. Gross elected to head to Duke instead.

2019: Gross was 3-3 with 4.30 ERA in eleven starts for Elizabethton in the Appalachian League after signing with Minnesota. He gave up 56 hits and struck out 49 over 52-1/3 innings at Elizabethton.

LAST START: Gross had a no decision in a start <u>against Beloit at home</u> <u>on July 24</u>. He pitched five shutout innings, allowed four hits, walked one and struck out eight.

VS. WISCONSIN: Gross had a no decision against the <u>Timber Rattlers</u> in Cedar Rapids on May 30. He allowed a run on three hits with a walk and eight strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings.
