INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Indianapolis Indians were swept by the Louisville Bats in Saturday's seven-inning doubleheader, losing game one by a score of 5-1 and dropping game two, 7-2. In the first contest, Nick Solak reached base safely three times for the Indians, going 2-for-3 with a walk. Abraham Gutierrez tallied a pair of hits for his second multi-hit effort of the season. In game two, Malcom Nuñez connected on his second home run of the season in the sixth inning off major league rehabber Alexis Diaz. He finished the game 2-for-3 with a double, home run and two RBI. It marked Indy's sixth home run of the series against the Bats. Darick Hall extended his hitting streak to four games, collecting three hits throughout the doubleheader and posting his first multi-hit contest of the season in game two.

DAVIS TO PITTSBURGH: Henry Davis was recalled by Pittsburgh yesterday. In eight games with the Indians he hit .286 (8-for-28) with three doubles, two RBI, three walks and two stolen bases opposed to just four strikeouts. He ended his stint with three consecutive multi-hit games in this series, which is his longest multi-hit run since a four-gamer from Aug. 14-18, 2024, vs. St. Paul. Over those three games, Davis hit .500 (6-for-12) with three doubles, two RBI and a 1.288 OPS.

PEGGY PROWESS: Liover Peguero went 1-for-3 in game one yesterday, extending his team-high on-base streak to nine games and extending his season-high hitting streak to six games. In this nine-game run, he is hitting .303 (10-for-33) with two doubles, three RBI, three walks and one stolen base. He has one-plus hit in eight of those games. He posted back-to-back multi-hit games in games two and three of this series, doing so for the first time since Aug 14-15, 2024, vs. St. Paul. Wednesday night's performance marked his first game with two-plus hits and two-plus RBI since Aug. 30, 2024, vs. Louisville.

SLEESTAK SOLAK: Nick Solak extended his hitting streak to six games, tying Liover Peguero for the longest active streak on the team, with a two-hit performance in game one and notching another hit in game two. He is hitting .318 (7-for-22) during the six-game run with two home runs and three RBI. He reached base safely three times in game one, going 2-for-3 with a walk. Solak deposited his second home run of the season in the third inning on Friday, extending the Indians lead, 2-0.

NUNI NUKES: Malcom Nuñez launched his second home run of the season and the series in game two yesterday. In the sixth inning, he deposited a two-run homer to left field off major league rehabber Alexis Diaz. He finished the game 2-for-3 with a double, home run and two RBI. Four of his eight hits this season have gone for extra bases, including three this series.

DARING TODAY, AREN'T WE?: Darick Hall extended his hitting streak to four games, going 1-for-3 in game one and 2-for-3 in game two. He is hitting .385 (5-for-13) with one walk and no strikeouts in this span. This, on the tails of going hitless (0-for-12) and striking out one-plus times in each of his first four games.

GALLANT GORSKI: Matt Gorski's eight-game on-base streak and seven-game hitting streak to begin the season came to a close yesterday, going 0-for-6 across both games of the doubleheader. In those eight games he hit .310 (9-for-29) with three doubles, one home run, four RBI, three walks, two stolen bases and a .892 OPS.

EXIT MUSIC (FOR A BASEBALL): In his first game after being reinstated from the 7-day injured list, Nick Yorke launched his first home run of the season to give Indianapolis a 5-3 lead in the fifth inning on Friday. In five games this season, he is hitting .300 (6-for-20) with three doubles, one home run, two RBI, and a .964 OPS. He has a five-game hitting streak to begin the season and has reached base safely two-plus times in three of those games.

TODAY'S SERIES FINALE: The Indians and Bats conclude their six-game series with today's finale scheduled for 1:05 PM. The Indians can secure a 3-3 series split with a win. A loss would mark the team's second consecutive series loss. Pirates top prospect Bubba Chandler is set to make his third start of the season after throwing 4.0 shutout innings with eight strikeouts on Tuesday. He aims to continue his good fortune against the Bats with 9.0 shutout innings and 13 strikeouts in his career opposite the squad. Chandler is yet to allow a run this season in 6.2 innings with 12 strikeouts. Facing off with Chandler is Bats right-hander Chase Petty, who did not factor into the decision in game one of the series on Tuesday, limiting the Indians to one run across 4.0 innings.

ON THIS DATE IN 2022: Following the completion of the first homestand, the Indians hit the road to St. Paul for a series against the Saints. With wind chills in the teens, Indy's pitching trio of Chase De Jong, Austin Brice and Yerry De Los Santos iced the Saints offense over 9.0 innings, yielding only two walks en route to the organization's first no-hitter since 2012 and 15th overall. The 5-0 victory also marked the first no-hitter in professional baseball for the 2022 season. De Jong struck out nine and issued both walks over 7.0 innings pitched before Brice (1.0ip, 1k) and De Los Santos (1.0ip, 2k) slammed the door in the eighth and ninth. The three pitchers, along with catcher Jason Delay who was behind the plate for all 27 outs of the no-hitter, played for Pittsburgh at various points over the remainder of the season.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Bubba Chandler: Right-hander Bubba Chandler is currently rated the No. 15 overall prospect in Minor League Baseball according to MLB Pipeline and is the Pirates No. 1. He is yet to allow a run in two starts this season, striking out 12 batters in 6.2 innings opposed to just seven total baserunners (2h, 5bb). In nine career starts with the Indians, the right-hander owns a 1.57 ERA (8er, 46.0ip) with 66 strikeouts, a 1.04 WHIP and .173 opponent average (28-for-162). He has punched out eight or more batters in five of those nine starts and posted six-plus strikeouts in seven of them.

Last Outing: Chandler tossed 4.0 shutout innings against the Bats on Tuesday with one hit, two walks and eight strikeouts.

Against the Bats: Chandler has thrown 9.0 shutout innings with 13 strikeouts across two career starts opposite Louisville.

IL Pitcher of the Week: Chandler was named the International League Pitcher of the Week for Aug. 5-11, 2024, after tossing 7.0 shutout innings with two hits, one walk and six strikeouts while he secured the win.

EAS Pitcher of the Week: Chandler was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on June 23, 2024, after tossing 7.0 shutout innings with two hits, one walk and 10 strikeouts while he secured the win.

Miscellaneous: Selected by Pittsburgh in the third round (72nd overall) of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of North Oconee (Bogart, GA.) High School. . Selected to the 2024 All-Star Futures Game and struck out Royals prospect Gavin Cross.
