ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Nick Yorke drove in five runs as the Indianapolis Indians offense erupted for 16 runs on Thursday night to defeat the Syracuse Mets at NBT Bank Stadium, 16-1. Indianapolis started the offensive outburst early. Nick Solak smacked a solo home run with two outs in the top of the first to stake the Indians to a lead they would not relinquish. The first big offensive output occurred in the second inning. Sammy Siani and Jase Bowen opened the frame with singles. Brett Sullivan walked to load the bases. Tsung-Che Cheng and Brett Sullivan followed with singles that each plated one run. The big hit of the inning came when Yorke hammered a double into the right-center field gap to clear the bases and knock in three. The inning concluded when Rafael Flores sent Yorke home with a single. Indy played add-on in the fourth. Cheng and Williams walked to open the inning, and Yorke singled to load the bases. Solak then sent Cheng to the plate with a groundout, and Flores capped the fourth with a two-run base hit to left field. The final big offensive onslaught of the night came in the fifth. Bowen led off with a double and moved to third on Sullivan's bloop double. After Cheng walked to load the bases, Williams drilled a single to center to score Bowen and Sullivan. Yorke went then tally two more runs batted in as he doubled to right field for the second time. The early rallies gave Indy a 15-0 lead midway through the contest. Syracuse got on the board in the sixth to prevent being shutout for a second consecutive night. Luke Ritter clubbed a solo home run to right field to trim the deficit to 15-1. The offensive outburst finally concluded in the seventh when the Indians pushed their lead back to 15 runs. Flores singled with one out, his third hit of the night. He scored on Sullivan's infield hit. Jarod Bayless started for Indy on a bullpen day and fired four shutout innings. Eddy Yean (W, 7-5) followed with 3.0 innings of one-run relief, Dauri Moreta twirled a scoreless eighth and catcher Shawn Ross closed the door in the ninth.

THE MET OFFENSIVE: The Indians' 15-run triumph last night marked their largest margin of victory over Syracuse since at least 1988, surpassing a 14-run win (16-2) on May 30, 2006, also at Syracuse. They also matched their most runs against Syracuse since at least 2005 from that same contest. It was also Indy's most runs in a road game since May 21, 2024, at Iowa (18). The Indians went 10-for-21 (.476) with runners in scoring position, which is their highest average with RISP in a game (min. 20 ABs) since April 27, 2018, at Columbus (.524, 11-for-21). Indy recorded 10 hits with runners in scoring position for the fifth time since 2022 after doing so six times from 2005-2021. Nick Yorke (5 RBI), Arika Williams (3 RBI) and Rafael Flores (3 RBI) became the first trio of Indians' teammates to each record three-plus RBI in a game since Matt Gorski (5 RBI), Henry Davis (4 RBI) and Ji Hwan Bae (3 RBI) each did so on May 18, 2024, vs. Toledo.

EAST COAST CONQUEST: The Indians have scored five or more runs in each of their last nine games dating back to the first day of their East Coast road trip on Aug. 12 at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. Indy is 6-3 in this stretch and have a 54-11 record (.831) overall when they score five or more runs, which is the third-best among Triple-A teams this season, trailing Jacksonville (43-8, .843) and Durham (45-9, .833). The Indians have also won the second most games in the International League when scoring five or more runs despite having the eighth most games with five-plus runs (63). They hold the longest active streak of games with five-plus runs in the International League, are tied for the fourth-longest streak by an IL team this season and have matched their longest streak since at least 2005 (also: July 23-Aug. 1, 2024 and June 30-July 8, 2012). Indy is tied for the most hits in the International League across this stretch while ranking third in batting average (.285) and runs scored (64).

ALIKA'S ALL OVER IT: Arika Williams led off last night and went 2-for-5 with three runs scored and three RBI, becoming the first Indians lead-off hitter to record three or more runs and RBI in a game since Nick Yorke (3 R, 3 RBI) on Aug. 30, 2024, vs. Louisville. In August, Williams ranks among International League qualifiers in slugging percentage (.3rd, .667), home runs (T-4th, 5), RBI (T-5th, 16), OPS (5th, 1.067) and total bases (9th, 38). He has hit safely in 13 of 15 games in the month, good for a .333 batting average (19-for-57), and has tallied multiple hits in three of his last four games. Williams' five homers in the month matches June 2022 with High-A Bowling Green for his career high in a calendar month and his eight extra-base hits are his most in a month since racking up 10 in July 2023 with Indy.

NEW YORK(E) STATE OF MIND: Nick Yorke went 3-for-6 with three runs scored, two doubles and a career-high matching five RBI in last night's win. He became just the fourth Indians' hitter since 2005 and the first since Joshua Palacios on Sept. 8, 2024, to tally two or more doubles and five or more RBI in a single game. One of his doubles and three of his RBI came with the bases loaded, a situation in which he holds a .538 batting average (7-for-13) with 12 RBI and a 1.230 OPS. He is also hitting .332 (64-for-193) with 11 doubles, three triples, three homers, 52 RBI and a .860 OPS. Yorke has hit safely in 16 of his last 20 games since July 19 and has racked up nine multi-hit games in that span. Across this stretch, Yorke is hitting .315 (28-for-89) with 13 runs scored, five doubles, a homer and 17 RBI.

RAFA RAKES: Rafael Flores reached base safely five times last night, going 4-for-5 with a run scored, three RBI and a walk. He played first base in the contest and became the first Indians first baseman to record four-plus hits in a game since Miguel Andujar (4 H) on June 3, 2023, vs. Toledo. Additionally, four hits match a single-game career high he has now set four times, last doing so on Sept. 1, 2024, vs. Double-A Reading while with Somerset. He has reached in 12 of 15 games played with Indianapolis since being acquired from New York (NL) in the David Bednar deal on July 31, good for a .377 on-base percentage with the Indians.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians look to secure a series win over the Syracuse Mets in Game 4 of their six-game set on Friday night at NBT Bank Stadium. With a series win, the Indians will have won back-to-back series at Syracuse dating back to July 23-25, 2019. It would be the first time Indy has won two straight sets at Syracuse since at least 2005 and the first time they have done so regardless of setting since taking two of three from June 10-12, 2016, and securing a four-game sweep from Aug. 10-13, 2017, both of which came at Victory Field. RHP Wilkin Ramos will start a bullpen game for Indy. It will be Ramos' third appearance with Indy and the 19th start of his career in 178 appearances. He will be opposed by RHP Jonah Tong, MiLB's No. 44 prospect according to MLB Pipeline. Tong's last start was his first in Triple-A and he spun 5.2 scoreless innings while allowing three hits, two walks striking out nine on Aug. 16 at Rochester.

ON THIS DATE IN 1992: The Indians held ground in the American Association Eastern Division with a 6-4 win at Oklahoma City, the club's fourth straight win on the road. Kent Bottenfield pitched into the seventh inning to earn his team-leading 12th and final win of the season. The victory moved Indy's record 24 games over .500 at 76-52, identical with Buffalo atop the division. Indianapolis faded down the stretch and finished 83-61, four games out of first place.
