ABOUT LAST SEASON: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers finished 20203 with a 62-68 record. The team was 26-38 in the first half. In the second half, Wisconsin and the Peoria Chiefs finished with identical 36-30 records. However, the Chiefs owned the tiebreaker over the Rattlers by virtue of winning the season series. Wisconsin has not made the Midwest League postseason since 2016.

FINISHING STRONG: The Timber Rattlers won their final four games of the season in 2023.

BULLPEN MARKET: Wisconsin's relievers compiled an ERA of 3.56 over 582 innings last season. That was the best bullpen ERA in the Midwest League in 2023. Only the Vancouver Canadians (3.40) and Hudson Valley Renegades (3.40) had a better bullpen ERA last season.

HOME OPENER HISTORY: Wisconsin in 20-8 in their home openers since 1995. The Rattlers have won their last four home openers and six of their last seven. Tonight is the eighth time Wisconsin has their home opener against Peoria.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his third year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, Yadier Molina, Nolan Gorman, and Victor Scott II.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP BRETT WICHROWSKI: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Wichrowski in the thirteenth round of the 2023 draft out of Bryant (RI) University.

BULLDOG: Wichrowski was 7-5 with a save and 109 strikeouts over 92-2/3 innings in 32 appearances – 15 starts – over three seasons at Bryant. In his final season, he was 5-3 with a save, a 4.50 ERA, and 64 strikeouts over 50 innings.

THE LIFE OF BRYANT: There have been two former Bulldogs who made the major leagues. Keith MacWhorter, who pitched in 14 games for the Boston Red Sox in 1980, and James Karinchak, who has pitched in 174 games with fifteen saves for the Cleveland Guardians from 2019 through 2023. Wichrowski is one of two Bryant pitchers to be drafted in 2023. Coleman Picard was selected in the sixth round last year by the Kansas City Royals.

IN THE SUMMER TIME: Wichrowski pitched for Orleans in the Cape Cod League in 2021, Mystic in the New England Collegiate Baseball League in 2022, and with Wareham in the Cape Cod League in 2023.

DEBUTING IN THE POSTSEASON: Wichrowski did not pitch in the regular season after signing with Milwaukee. He made his pro debut with a scoreless, hitless second inning against the ACL Rockies in the Arizona Complex League Semifinal Game on August 24, 2023. He did not have a walk or a strikeout in the inning.

SPRING HAS SPRUNG: Wichrowski worked a scoreless inning against the Chicago White Sox in a Cactus League game on March 7, 2024. He had a strikeout with no walks or hits.

LAST START: Wichrowski was charged with the loss at Maine on [May 19, 2023](#). He allowed three runs on five hits with no walks and three strikeouts over three innings. The Bulldogs lost 3-1 in the game.

LAST APPEARANCE: Wichrowski pitched the second inning of the ACL Semifinal game against the Rockies on [August 24, 2023](#). He retired all three batters he faced.

VS. PEORIA: Tonight is the first time Wichrowski will pitch against the Chiefs. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the St. Louis Cardinals.

STRIKEOUTS:

PEORIA SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP CONNOR HJERPE: The St. Louis Cardinals selected Hjerpe in the first round of the 2022 draft out of Oregon State University.

BUSY BEAVER: Hjerpe went 11-2 with a 2.53 ERA in eighteen games – seventeen starts – during his final season at Oregon State. He walked 23 and struck out 161 over 103-1/3 innings with the Beavers.

HONOR ROLL: Hjerpe was named to four First-Team All-American Teams, First-Team All-Pac-12, Perfect Game's National Pitcher of the Year, a finalist for the Golden Spikes Award, a finalist for the Dick Howser Trophy, and a member of the Corvallis Regional All-Tournament team.

TO THE BRINK: Hjerpe's final start at Oregon State was a win over Auburn on [June 12, 2022 in Game Two](#) of the Super Regional to even the series at 1-1 and set up a decisive Game Three. Hjerpe allowed three runs on three hits with two walks and six strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings for the victory.

HOW DOES HE RATE? MLB Pipeline places Hjerpe as the #6 prospect in the Cardinals organization. *Baseball America* puts him at #8 in the St. Louis System.

LAST SEASON: Hjerpe was 2-3 with a 3.51 ERA in ten games – eight starts – for the Chiefs in 2023, which was his first professional season. He walked 25 and struck out 51 in 41 innings pitched. He missed three months due to arthroscopic surgery on his pitching elbow last year. Hjerpe made it back to the Chiefs for the end of the season and also pitched 8-1/3 innings over seven relief appearances in the Arizona Fall League for Scottsdale in 2023.

LAST START: Hjerpe had a no decision against Great Lakes [at home on May 23, 2023](#). Hjerpe worked six no-hit innings, hit a batter, walked three, and struck out five in the game. He did not make another start for the Chiefs the rest of the season and was on their IL until September.

LAST APPEARANCE: Hjerpe worked a scoreless inning against Beloit at home on [September 7, 2023](#). He walked one and struck out one without allowing a hit in his second relief outing off Peoria's IL.

VS. WISCONSIN: Hjerpe was 1-1 in two starts against the Timber Rattlers in 2023. He [lost at Wisconsin on April 14](#) and [won at Peoria on May 3](#). Hjerpe allowed four runs on six hits with three walks and five strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings. Joe Gray Jr and Ben Metzinger both homered off Hjerpe in the game.
