**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Cedar Rapids Kernels 7-6 in eleven innings at Neuroscience Group Field.](#) Zavier Warren drove in pinch-runner Arbert Cipion with a fielder's choice in the bottom of the eleventh inning.

**NUMBER NINE:** Warren went 1-for-5 last night to extend his hitting streak to nine games. He has the longest hitting streak by a Rattler this season.

**FLYING HIGH IN APRIL:** Wisconsin erased an early 1-0 deficit to take a 4-1 lead with a run in the third, a run in the fourth, and two runs in the fifth. Starting pitcher Russell Smith went six innings, allowed a run on three hits with no walks and six strikeouts.

**SHOT DOWN IN MAY:** The Kernels rallied to take a 6-4 lead with two runs in the seventh and three runs in the eighth. All three of the runs in the eighth inning scored after two outs.

**BACK ON TOP IN JUNE:** Wisconsin tied the game in the bottom of the eighth on an RBI double by Tyler Black and a sacrifice fly by Darrien Miller and the Rattlers eventually won in the eleventh.

**CALL HIM THE WORKING MAN:** James Meeker allowed three runs – two earned – in the top of the eighth but worked a perfect ninth and struck out the side in a scoreless tenth to keep the game tied. He made 62 pitches in three innings.

**PAINT IT BLACK:** Tyler Black went 4-for-5 with two doubles, two RBI, a walk, and a run scored on Saturday night. Black is hitting .298 (4<sup>th</sup> in the Midwest League) and an OPS of .413 (3<sup>rd</sup> in MWL).

**WHEN YOU'RE HOT, YOU'RE HOT:** Wisconsin has won four games in a row and nine of their last ten. The Timber Rattlers have reached thirteen games over .500 for the first time this season.

**ADD IT UP:** Last night was Wisconsin's eighth walkoff win of the season. Warren has been involved in the winning play three times – scoring the winning run twice earlier in the season and driving in the winning run last night.

**ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS:** The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League, in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins – including 2022. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons.

**ABOUT THE TWINS:** Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) puts six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#7), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Zavier Warren (#17), and Cam Robinson (#26). Carlos Rodríguez (#21) is on the Wisconsin injured list. [MLB Pipeline](#) has five current Cedar Rapids players on their Top 30 list of Twins prospects: Aaron Sabato (#14), Alerick Soularie (#21), Cade Povich (#23), Christian Encarnacion-Strand (#25), and David Festa (#30).

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP ZACH MORT:** Signed with Milwaukee as a Minor League Free Agent on January 14, 2021.

**ORIGIN STORY:** Mort was drafted by the Chicago Cubs in the 8<sup>th</sup> round of the 2018 draft out of George Mason University.

**PATRIOTIC DUTY:** Mort appeared in 57 games – 28 starts – over three seasons at George Mason. He went 12-12 with nine saves and a 3.72 ERA and 205 strikeouts over 227-1/3 innings pitched during his collegiate career.

**IN THE CUBS DEN:** Mort spent two seasons (2018 and 2019) in the Cubs organization after signing with them. He made ten relief appearances (0-4, 5.79) with the Eugene Emeralds in 2018. In 2019, Mort was 3-3 with a 3.72 ERA in Eugene and 6-2 with a 3.13 ERA for South Bend.

**POSTSEASON:** Mort was the winning pitcher in Game One of the Midwest League Championship Series against the [Clinton LumberKings on September 11, 2019](#). Mort went three scoreless innings, allowed one hit and two walks with four strikeouts as a reliever. The South Bend Cubs went on to sweep the best-of-five series from Clinton.

**LAST SEASON:** Mort started 2021 with the Timber Rattlers and was 1-4 in sixteen games – thirteen starts. He was moved to Carolina in August and was 4-1 in six starts for the Mudcats. Mort had a 6.22 ERA and 101 strikeouts over 97 innings pitched between the two levels last year.

**LAST START:** Mort took the [loss against the Kernels in game one of this series on June 28](#). He allowed five runs on five hits with two walks and three strikeouts over three innings.

**VS. CEDAR RAPIDS (2022):** Mort faced the Kernels one other time this season prior to last Tuesday. He had a [no decision as a reliever at Cedar Rapids on May 28](#). Mort allowed two runs on two hits with a walk and six strikeouts. He gave up a home run to Alerick Soularie in the game.

## CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP PIERCE BANKS:** The Twins signed Banks as a Minor League Free Agent on June 6, 2022.

**YO! ADRIAN!** Banks pitched collegiately at Adrian College. He won 36 games and had 307 strikeouts over 325-1/3 innings with a 2.99 ERA in 56 games – 51 starts during his career with the Bulldogs. He was 11-1 with a 2.38 ERA in his senior season to help Adrian reach the NCAA Division III College World Series in 2021. The 2021 D-III College World Series was held in Cedar Rapids.

**ON THE SHORE:** Banks pitched for the East Side Diamond Hoppers of the United Shore Baseball League after his college career ended. He was 1-4 with a 3.19 ERA and 39 strikeouts over 36-2/3 innings in nine starts. He signed with the Twins just before the start of the 2022 USBL season.

**IT'S COMPLEX:** Banks started his career with the Twins with two relief appearances in the Florida Complex League. He allowed a hit, walked one, struck out two, and picked up a win without allowing a run over 3-1/3 innings in those games.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Banks picked up the [win on the road against the GCL Red Sox in relief on June 25, 2022](#). He allowed a hit with a walk and two strikeouts over three scoreless innings.

**LAST START:** Banks had a no decision against the Utica Unicorns on September 11, 2021 in a USBL game. He allowed two runs on five hits with a walk and four strikeouts over five innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Banks has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this afternoon. Today is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
