### **INDY BITS**

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Indianapolis Indians shined with a 4-1 series-opening win over the Columbus Clippers at Victory Field on Tuesday. The Indians took the lead in the third inning on a wild pitch by Slade Cecconi to score Ji Hwan Bae. Billy Cook then logged Indy's first RBI hit in the fourth with a single through the infield. Jack Suwinski brought home some insurance in the seventh with a towering fly ball single, marking his second RBI on the night following a first-inning sacrifice fly. The Clippers were shut down over 4.0 hitless innings by rehabber Dauri Moreta, Nick Dombkowski and Isaac Mattson, who also combined for seven strikeouts to end the game. The pitching staff struck out a season-high tying 14 batters last night, doing os for the sixth time this season. Their two hits allowed matched a season best, last doing so on May 2 at Omaha.

PAIR O' PIRATES: First baseman Spencer Horwitz and right-handed pitcher Dauri Moreta had their rehab assignments transferred to Indianapolis yesterday. Horwitz was placed on the 10-day injured list on March 27, retroactive to March 24, after undergoing right wrist surgery on Feb. 12. Moreta was placed on the 60-day injured list on Feb. 16 after undergoing Tommy John surgery and being sidelined for the entire 2024 season. Nearly 14 months after his last professional appearance, the right-hander began a rehab assignment with High-A Bradenton on April 29 and tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in two games. Horwitz went 2-for-4 with one double and one run last night in his debut rehab performance. Moreta tossed a scoreless sixth inning with one walk, striking out the side in last night's win.

MIKE CHECK; Last night. Mike Burrows earned his first win of the season as he struck out seven batters over 5.0 one-run innings, retiring each of his final seven hitters faced and not allowing a runner in scoring position following a second-inning home run, Following C.J. Kayfus' homer in the second. Burrows fanned six of his final 12 batters to finish his outing. His seven total strikeouts set a season-high for the right-hander, and it was his first appearance without a walk since April 1 vs. lowa (3.2ip). In his past two outings, Burrows has tossed 8.0 innings with three hits, one run, one walk and 12 strikeouts

BAEWATCH: Ji Hwan Bae extended his on-base streak to 18 games and hitting streak to nine games last night, going 1-for-5 with two runs and one stolen base. It is the longest on-base streak by an Indian this season and is tied for the fourth longest active streak in the International League. His nine-game hitting streak is tied for the second longest active streak in the league. He is hitting .290 (21for-74) with six doubles, five RBI, eight walks, 19 runs and six stolen bases in this span. Since making his season debut with Indy on April 8, Bae's 22 runs scored rank second in the International League behind Lehigh Valley's Otto Kemp (24r). In addition to his hitting streak. Bae has recorded a knock in 12 of his past 13 and 15 of the 18 games in his active on-base streak. He has scored one-plus run in 13 of the 18 games and one-plus walk in seven of those games. Bae scored a career-high tying four runs on April 17 vs. Toledo (3x, MR: 9/11/22 at OMA). He tallied a stolen base in four straight games from April 17-22, marking his first time stringing four straight games with a steal since July 8-14, 2021, with Altoona. The four consecutive games with a steal are tied for the longest streak by an International

JACK ATTACK: Jack Suwinski reached base safely three times last night, going 1-for-1 with two RBI, two walks, one run and one stolen base. Since making his season debut in Game 1 on April 25 at St. Paul, he is hitting .323 (10-for-31) with two doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, seven walks, six runs, two stolen bases and a 1.017 OPS. He extended his on-base streak to nine games, reaching in each game since being optioned. He has one-plus hit in eight of those, one-plus RBI in six and one-plus walk in six.

EXIT MUSIC (FOR A BASEBALL): Nick Yorke continued his strong run at the plate, going 1-for-4 in last night's contest. Across his last 14 games, Yorke is hitting .321 (17-for-53) with two home runs, seven RBI, five walks, six runs and three stolen bases. He has a hit in five straight contests and multiple hits in three of those. He launched his third home run of the season in the seventh inning on Friday night, going 2-for-5 with a home run, two RBI, two runs and two stolen bases. It marked his first time homering in back-to-back games since June 8 and 9, 2024, with Worcester. Additionally, he posted back-to-back multi-hit games and multi-RBI games for the first time this season. He swiped two-plus bags in that game for the first time since September 13, 2023, with Portland vs. Hartford. He swatted his second home run of the season in the first inning on Thursday, going 3-for-5 with two RBI and one run. It marked his second three-hit game of the campaign, last doing so on April 22 at St.

TODAY'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians continue this week's six-game series against the Columbus Clippers today at 1:35 PM as Minor League Baseball's Free Game of the Day. Bubba Chandler is set to make his seventh start of the season following a dominant performance on May 1 at Omaha in which he struck out a season-high nine batters. Chandler made one career start against the Clippers on Aug. 22, 2024, at Columbus, where he did not factor into the decision, tossing 5.0 innings with five hits, three runs, one walk and six strikeouts. Taking the mound for the Clippers is southpaw Ryan Webb, making his seventh appearance and fifth start of the season. He made one career start against Indy on Aug. 24, 2024, earning the win with 5.0 innings, five hits, one run no walks and two

BUBBA ON THE BUMP: Bubba Chandler was named the International League April Pitcher of the Month on Monday, taking home the first monthly award of his career and the first by an Indian since Zach Duke in May of 2005. In April, he led all minor league pitchers with at least 20.0 innings in fewest hits allowed (seven) and batting average against (.106, 7-for-66). Chandler went 1-0 with a 1.33 ERA (3er/20.1ip), 27 strikeouts and a 0.64 WHIP across five starts in the month. In addition to his minor league leading marks, he led IL pitchers with at least 20.0 innings in WHIP and finished third in ERA. In just 13 career starts with Indianapolis, Chandler is 6-0 with a 1.67 ERA (12er/64.2ip) and 90 strikeouts. Among all Indianapolis pitchers since 2005 with at least 40.0 career innings, he ranks first in WHIP (0.90), batting average against (.161, 36-for-224) and opponent OPS (.480). He also ranks second in ERA (1.67, 12er/64.2ip) and strikeouts per 9.0 innings (12.53). Chandler has thrown 13 pitches at 100.0 MPH or higher this season, with his fastball topping out at 101.5 on April 13 at Louisville. He is one of just seven starting pitchers in MiLB to hit triple-digits this season, with his eight pitches thrown at least 100.3 MPH marking the fastest pitches thrown by a starting pitcher in High-A or above.

ON THIS DATE IN 2002: Left-handed pitcher Jimmy Osting tossed his first of three complete games on the season, the only to span a full 9.0 innings, in a 5-1 win at Pawtucket. Osting allowed just two hits, one of which was a home run, and struck out eight in the game. Osting is tied for third among Indians starting pitchers for most complete games thrown in the Victory Field era behind only Giovanni Carrara (5) and Casey Sadler (4).
