LAST ACTION: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers lost 8-1 to the Quad Cities River Bandits at Modern Woodmen Park on Sunday.](#) Quad Cities scored five runs in the bottom of the first inning to take the early lead. Wisconsin was held to three hits in the game.

HIGHWAY ROBBERY: Luiyin Alastre took a home run away from Carter Frederick in the bottom of the fifth inning by making a leaping catch at the wall. Frederick had doubled and tripled in his first two at bats of the game.

ON THE BOARD: Eduardo Garcia had an RBI single in the top of the sixth inning to drive in Wisconsin's only run of the game. That helped the Rattlers avoid being shutout for the fourth time this season.

ON ASSIGNMENT: Steward Berroa is on a minor league rehab assignment for the Milwaukee Brewers. He walked, struck out and was hit by pitches twice on Sunday. Berroa is 2-for-5 with three walks, a stolen base and two runs scored in three games with the Rattlers.

BACK HOME AGAIN: The Timber Rattlers are back at Neuroscience Group Field tonight for the first time since July 13. Wisconsin went 3-6 on their nine-game road trip as they were 1-2 at Cedar Rapids and 2-4 at Quad Cities.

AREINAMO APPRECIATION: The Milwaukee Brewers traded Jader Areinamo to the Tampa Bay Rays organization last night. Areinamo was the Midwest League Post-Season All-Star at second base and the league batting champion in 2024. Areinamo was leading the league in hits (109) and total bases (170) this season. He was also tied second in the league in doubles (24) and tied for second in the league in average (.297). In his career with the Timber Rattler, Areinamo played 211 games with 239 hits, 55 doubles, 21 homers, 120 RBI, 114 runs scored, and stole 47 bases with a .785 OPS.

ABOUT THE LAKE COUNTY CAPTAINS: Lake County joined the Midwest League in 2010 from the South Atlantic League. They started out as the Columbus RedStixx in Georgia before moving to Eastlake, Ohio after the 2002 season. The Captains are the Midwest League affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. The franchise has been affiliated with Cleveland since it was known as the Columbus Indians in 1991. Lake County won the Midwest League title in 2010 and lost to Kane County in the 2014 Midwest League Championship Series. They were the East Division Champions in 2022 and lost to the South Bend Cubs in the Midwest League Championship Series. Lake County defeated the Timber Rattlers in the 2024 Midwest League Championship Series.

ABOUT THE GUARDIANS: Cleveland was the parent club of the old Appleton Papermakers in 1941, 1942, and 1946. Mike Garcia was the most notable Papermaker to play of the Indians. Cleveland's affiliation history in the Midwest League dates includes the Dubuque Packers from 1962-64 and Waterloo from 1977-1988 before the Captains.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

LHP ROBERT GASSER: The Milwaukee Brewers acquired Gasser from the San Diego Padres in a trade with Taylor Rogers, Esteury Ruiz, and Dinelson Lamet for Josh Hader on August 1, 2022. Gasser is currently the #13 prospect in the Milwaukee system according to MLB Pipeline and on an MLB rehabilitation assignment.

ORIGIN STORY: Gasser was selected by the Padres in Competitive Balance Round B with the 71st overall pick of the 2021 draft out of the University of Houston.

ONCE UPON A TIME: Gasser made a start against the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers at Neuroscience Group Field on [May 8, 2022](#) as a member of the Fort Wayne TinCaps. He allowed on hit, hit a batter, walked three, and struck out six over six scoreless innings for a no decision. Gasser was 4-9 with a 4.18 ERA in 18 starts with 115 strikeouts over 90-1/3 innings for Fort Wayne before the trade. Milwaukee sent Gasser to Biloxi, their Double-A affiliate, after the trade. He finished that season with Nashville.

WHERE THINGS STAND: Gassner made his MLB debut with Milwaukee on May 10, 2024. He was 2-0 with a 2.57 ERA in five starts. He was placed on the injured list on June 5, 2024 with a left flexor strain and underwent Tommy John Surgery on June 24, 2024.

LAST START: Gasser had a no decision at Quad Cities on [July 24](#). He allowed two runs on one hit and a walk over an inning.

VS. LAKE COUNTY: Gasser made two starts against the Captains in 2022 – [June 8](#) and [July 9](#) – as a member of the Fort Wayne TinCaps. He had no record, allowed three runs on ten hits with one walk and 21 strikeouts over thirteen innings.

LAKE COUNTY STARTING PITCHER:

LHP MICHAEL KENNEDY: The Guardians acquired Kennedy in a trade with the Pittsburgh Pirates on December 10, 2024. Cleveland sent Spencer Horwitz to the Pirates and received Luis Ortiz, Josh Hartle, and Kennedy.

ORIGIN STORY: Pittsburgh selected Kennedy in the fourth round of the 2022 draft out of Troy (NY) High School.

PRE-TRADE: In 2024, Kennedy spent the majority of his season with Bradenton in the Florida State League, where he was 2-5 with a 4.07 ERA in sixteen games – fifteen starts. Kennedy also made two starts for Greensboro in the South Atlantic League with no record as he allowed one run. He struck out 95 and walked nineteen in 83-2/3 innings combined last season.

THIS SEASON: Kennedy started the season with the Captains but was placed on the Injured List on May 7 and sent to the Arizona Complex League on a rehab assignment on June 12. He was returned to Lake County on June 26. Kennedy is 2-1 in nine games – four starts for the Captains this season.

LAST START: Kennedy lost at West Michigan on [July 8](#). He allowed five runs on six hits with a walk and three strikeouts over 2-1/3 innings.

LAST APPEARANCE: Kennedy beat Lansing as a reliever on [July 22](#) at home. He gave up a run on two hits with no walks and two strikeouts over four innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Kennedy has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers. Tonight is also his first appearance against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
