W 5-1 DOING HIS PART: Ryan Birchard pitched five innings and struck out five as the Rattlers starting pitcher last night. He set a single-game high as a pro in innings pitched and matched his single-game professional high for strikeouts with his performance. He held the Kernels to three hits and walked one. Khadim Diaw walked, stole second, took third on a wild pitch, and scored on an errant throw to third on the play to give the Kernels the lead in the fifth.

DOING THEIR PART: Wisconsin starting pitchers have a 2.88 ERA in seventeen games this season. The Rattlers starters are ranked second in Midwest League and fourth in the High-A classification of Minor League Baseball in ERA. Only Quad Cities (2.10), Brooklyn (2.22), and Aberdeen (2.50) are ahead of the Wisconsin rotation.

A FAST GAME THAT TOOK A LONG TIME: Last night's official game time was two hours. However, the 88-miunte rain delay made the night at the ballpark last longer.

COMEBACK TRAIL: Wisconsin put two runners on base immediately after the restart of the game with Eduardo Garcia drawing a walk and Jadher Areinamo hitting a double. Matt Wood drove in Garcia with a grounder. In the ninth, Garcia singled, stole second, and took third on a wild pitch. Areinamo drove him in with an RBI grounder.

DID YOU KNOW: Wisconsin has scored two or fewer runs in a game eight times this season. The Rattlers are 1-7 in those games.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence in 1949 as the Cedar Rapids Rockets, an unaffiliated team in the Central Association. They moved to the Three-I League as the Cedar Rapids Indians, an affiliate of Cleveland in 1950. They were affiliated with the Milwaukee Braves from 1954 through 1962. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins from 2013 through 2023, including a 2023 Midwest League Championship. That streak ended last year when the Kernels missed the playoffs. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, and Milwaukee Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook. Hall of Famers John McGraw (1891 Canaries), Lou Boudreau (1938 Raiders), Ted Simmons (1967 Cardinals), and Trevor Hoffman (1991 Reds) played for earlier pro teams in Cedar Rapids.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

### WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CHANDLER WELCH: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Welch in the sixth round of the 2024 draft out of Tulane University.

CATCH A GREEN WAVE: Welch pitched three seasons at Tulane. He was 15-13 with three saves and a 5.42 ERA in 67 games – 29 starts in college. Welch had 204 strikeouts over 199-1/3 innings with Tulane. As a junior – his final season of college baseball, Welch was 7-4 with a 4.65 ERA. In his final collegiate start, Welch was the starting pitcher for Tulane against Oregon State in the NCAA Regional at Corvallis on May 31, 2024. He allowed six runs on seven hits with two walks and a strikeout over four innings against the Beavers.

**CHAMPIONS:** Tulane won the AAC Conference Tournament in Welch's sophomore and junior seasons.

**LET'S GET IT STARTED:** Milwaukee assigned Welch to Carolina on September 8, 2024 and he made his pro debut for the Mudcats against Delmarva. He was transferred to Wisconsin and made a relief appearance in the playoffs against Lake County.

**LAST START:** Welch lost the night game of a day/night doubleheader with the Lansing Lugnuts on April 18. He allowed three runs on six hits with three walks and two strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings before rain halted play in the top of the fifth.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: Welch made the start against the Kernels at home on April 6. He allowed four runs on seven hits with a walk and a strikeout over three innings for a no decision.

### CEDAR RAPIDS STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CHASE CHANEY: The Minnesota Twins signed Chaney as a minor league free agent on December 12, 2024.

**ORIGIN STORY:** Chaney was selected by the Los Angeles Angels in the 16<sup>th</sup> round of the 2018 draft out of Mountain View High School in Lawrenceville, Georgia. Chaney made it as high as Rocket City in the Double-A Southern League at the end of the 2023 season and all of 2024. He elected Free Agency on November 4, 2024.

**TRASH PANDA:** Chaney was 7-11 with a 4.30 ERA in 26 games – 25 starts – for Rocket City in 2024. He walked 44 and struck out 103 in 113-2/3 innings.

**LAST START:** Chaney had a no decision at Tulsa on April 16 as the starting pitcher for the Wichita Wind Surge of the Double-A Texas League. He allowed an unearned run on six hits with no walks and a strikeout over 4-2/3 innings. Chaney had no record and allowed six earned runs over 11-2/3 innings in three games – two starts – for the Wind Surge before being transferred to the Kernels.

VS. WISCONSIN: Chaney has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. He made three appearances – two starts – against the Biloxi Shuckers, Milwaukee's affiliate in the Southern League, in 2024. Chaney was 1-1 with a 1.59 ERA and thirteen strikeouts in seventeen innings against the Shuckers last season.
