SATURDAY IN THE PARK: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers and Lansing Lugnuts split a pair of games that were completed on Saturday at Neuroscience Group Field. Lansing won 4-3 in the conclusion of the night game of Friday's split doubleheader. Wisconsin ended their five-game losing streak with a 2-0 victory in the regularly scheduled game.

GAME ONE RECAP: Lansing took a 3-2 lead with three runs in the pouring rain in the top of the fourth on Friday night. The game resumed with one out in the top of the fifth. The Lugnuts added an insurance run with two outs in the top of the seventh on Saturday afternoon. Matt Wood knocked in a run in the bottom of the seventh with a pinch-hit single and the Rattlers had the tying and winning runs on base with no outs, but could not complete the comeback.

GAME TWO RECAP: Tyson Hardin and Zach Peek combined on a five-hit, 2-0 shutout in the regularly scheduled game. Eduardo Garcia and Yhoswar Garcia both drove in a run for the Rattlers in the nightcap. Game two, a seven-inning game, wrapped up in 87 minutes.

HARD DAY'S NIGHT: Hardin allowed four hits, walked one, and struck out seven over 5-2/3 scoreless innings on Saturday. In three starts this season, Hardin has pitched 14-2/3 innings with no runs, two walks, and sixteen strikeouts.

THE FIRST DECADE: Jadher Areinamo is on a ten-game hitting streak, tied with Alfonsin Rosario of Lake County for the second longest in the Midwest League this season. Areinamo is 13-for-38 (.342) with an OPS of .960 during the streak. Only Josue Briceño of West Michigan has a longer hit streak in the league this season.

NOTHING NEW: Areinamo had an eighteen-game hitting streak with Wisconsin's last year. He tied Spencer Nivens of Quad Cities for the longest hit streak in the MWL in 2024.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence in 1949 as the Cedar Rapids Rockets, an unaffiliated team in the Central Association. They moved to the Three-I League as the Cedar Rapids Indians, an affiliate of Cleveland in 1950. They were affiliated with the Milwaukee Braves from 1954 through 1962. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins from 2013 through 2023, including a 2023 Midwest League Championship. That streak ended last year when the Kernels missed the playoffs. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, and Milwaukee Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook. Hall of Famers John McGraw (1891 Canaries), Lou Boudreau (1938 Raiders), Ted Simmons (1967 Cardinals), and Trevor Hoffman (1991 Reds) played for earlier pro teams in Cedar Rapids.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Bishop Letson (#14), Blake Burke (#16), Jadher Areinamo (#23), Juan Baez (#26), and Manuel Rodriguez (#29). [MLB Pipeline](#) has eight active Kernels on their list of Minnesota prospects: Brandon Winokur (#7), Carlee Soto (#8), Kyle DeBarge (#12), Billy Amick (#14), Gabriel Gonzalez (#17), Danny De Andrade (#25), Jose Olivares (#28), and Khadim Diaw (#29). Kaelen Culpepper (#4) and Rayne Doncon (#15) are currently on the Cedar Rapids IL.

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP MANUEL RODRIGUEZ: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Rodriguez as an International Free Agent out of Mexico on April 5, 2022.

WHIRLWIND: Rodriguez had a very busy 2022. After signing with Milwaukee in April, he began his professional career in the Dominican Summer League in June and went 1-5 with a 4.54 ERA in twelve games – five starts. Later in the year he pitched for Mexico in the U-18 World Cup of Baseball. Rodriguez went 1-1 in the tournament with a win over Australia and a loss to the Netherlands.

PLAYOFF EXPERIENCE: Rodriguez has pitched in the postseason in each of the last two seasons. He made a relief appearance for the ACL Brewers in the Arizona Complex League Semifinal Game in 2023 and was the starter in Game Two of the Carolina League Playoffs for the Mudcats against Fredericksburg.

CHECK THE RATING: MLB Pipeline moved Rodriguez into their Top 30 list of Brewers Prospects at #30 after Yophery Rodriguez was traded to Boston on April 7, 2025 and up to #29 when Isaac Collins graduated from the list on April 19, 2025. *Baseball America* lists Rodriguez as the #25 prospect in the Milwaukee System in their 2025 *Prospect Handbook*.

LAST START: Rodriguez had a no decision against Lansing at home on [April 16](#). He allowed three hits, walked one, and struck out three over six scoreless innings. The Rattlers led 1-0 when he left the game, but Wisconsin dropped the game 3-1.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: Rodriguez was the starter on [April 4, 2025](#) against the Kernels at home. He allowed an unearned run on three hits with one walk and eleven strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings. Rodriguez was charged with the loss in the 4-1 defeat.

CEDAR RAPIDS STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JOSE OLIVARES: The Twins signed Olivares as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on January 15, 2021.

SHORT SEASONS: Olivares pitched in the Dominican Summer League in 2021 and the Florida Complex League in 2022. He pitched fifteen innings in ten appearances in the DSL and 33-2/3 innings in ten appearances in Florida. Olivares was 5-4 with a save, 55 strikeouts, and 27 walks in those first two seasons.

HOLDING DOWN THE FORT: Olivares made 21 appearance – twenty starts – with Fort Myers in the Florida State League in 2023. He was 3-4 with a 6.22 ERA with 83 strikeouts in 85-1/3 innings. Olivares only made thirteen appearances – ten starts – with the Mighty Mussels in an injury-plagued 2024. He was 2-3 with 47 strikeouts in 46 innings last year in the Florida State League.

PLAYER RATING: MLB Pipeline ranks Olivares as the #28 prospect in the Minnesota system.

LAST START: Olivares allowed one hit over 4-2/3 scoreless innings for a no decision against Beloit at home on [April 8](#). He walked three and struck out six in the game.

VS. WISCONSIN: Olivares has never faced Wisconsin prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
