INDY BITS

ABOUT WEDNESDAY: Following a back-and-forth battle in extras, Shawn Ross drove a ground-ball single through the left side to give the Indianapolis Indians a 5-4 walk-off victory over the Toledo Mud Hens in 12 innings on Wednesday afternoon at Victory Field. All three of Indy's home wins in 2025 have come via walk-off. Reliever Peter Strzelecki held Toledo scoreless in the top of the 12th before the game-winning bottom half. A ground ball by Ji Hwan Bae moved Alika Williams, as the automatic runner at second base to begin the inning, 90 feet away before Ross notched the game-winning hit in his Triple-A debut off position player Riley Unroe.

LATE-INNING HEROICS: The Indians captured their third walk-off of the campaign yesterday, with all three of the team's home wins this season coming via extra-inning walk-off plate appearances. The squad improved to 4-0 in extra innings this season, with one road win in 10 innings on April 13 at Louisville. Four of Indy's six wins this season have been in come-from-behind fashion.

HAVE A DAY, ROSS: Catcher Shawn Ross made his Triple-A debut yesterday, going 2-for-5 with one RBI, two runs and a walk-off single. It was his second multi-hit game of the campaign and first in Indianapolis, last collecting a pair of hits with Double-A Altoona on April 8 at Akron. In seven games this season between Altoona and Indy, Ross is hitting .273 (6-for-22) with one double, three RBI, four walks and three runs. He has reached base safely in five of his six games with a plate appearance this season.

FULL STOP, FULM START: Right-hander Carson Fulmer made his third start of the season yesterday, tossing a season-high 5.2 innings with three hits, two walks and three strikeouts. He has made three consecutive starts of 5.0-plus innings since a six-game string from May 25-June 21, 2018, with Charlotte. He has a 1.72 ERA (3er/15.2ip) and is holding opponents to a .224 batting average (13-for-58) this season.

SOLAK ECLIPSE: Nick Solak extended his hitting streak to eight games yesterday, matching Liover Peguero for the team's longest hitting streak on the campaign. Solak went 1-for-3 with one walk, one RBI, one run and two stolen bases. It was his first multi-steal game since taking two bags June 18, 2022 with Round Rock vs. Sugar Land. He is hitting .300 (9-for-30) with one double, two home runs, five RBI, two walks, six runs and two stolen bases in this span. He has struck out just five times this season and only once in his past 17 plate appearances.

SOMEONE COOKED HERE: Billy Cook went 2-for-4 with one double, one RBI and one walk in yesterday's game, extending his on-base streak to six games and hitting streak to five games. With a three-hit performance on Tuesday, he has posted back-to-back multi-hit games for the first time since September 6 and 7, 2024 at Toledo. In this six-game run, he is hitting .364 (8-for-22) with three doubles, one triple, two RBI, four walks, a 1.053 OPS and just two strikeouts in 26 plate appearances.

DARING TODAY, AREN'T WE?: Darick Hall extended his hitting streak to six games on Tuesday, going 1-for-4 with a walk, and has reached base safely two-plus times in three straight games. He is hitting .381 (8-for-21) in those six games with one double, one RBI, three walks and just one strikeout in this span. This, on the heels of going hitless (0-for-12) and striking out one-plus times in each of his first four games. From Game Two on Saturday through Sunday's contest, he posted back-to-back multi-hit games for the first time since July 24 and 25, 2024, with Lehigh Valley at Rochester.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians continue this week's six-game set against the Toledo Mud Hens at 6:35 PM tonight. Right-hander Thomas Harrington, the Pirates No. 3 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 76 overall prospect, is set to make his first start with the Indians this season. He made his season debut with the club on Sunday at Louisville, tossing 2.0 shutout innings with two hits and three strikeouts. He began the season with Double-A Altoona, but did not make an appearance before having his contract selected by Pittsburgh on April 1, 2025. He made his major league debut that day in a start against the Tampa Bay Rays at George M. Steinbrenner field in Tampa, Fla. In his second career appearance, he earned his first MLB save on April 7, tossing the game's final 4.0 innings to seal a Pirates win. Harrington posted a 10.13 ERA (9er/8.0ip) with seven strikeouts in his first MLB stint. Last season with Indy, he went 5-1 in eight starts with a 3.33 ERA (17er/46.0ip) with 38 strikeouts opposed to just eight walks. He posted a 0.93 WHIP and held opponents to a .212 batting average (35-for-165) in those games. In two career games against Toledo, Harrington is 0-0 with a 5.40 ERA (7er/11.2ip) with 10 hits, one walk, one hit batter and nine strikeouts. Taking the mound for the Mud Hens is lefty Dietrich Enns. He is set to make his fourth start of the season, posting a 0-1 record with a 2.84 ERA (4er/12.2ip). Enns is 1-2 with a 5.40 ERA (10er/16.2ip) in three career starts against the Indians with 17 hits, six walks, three home runs against and 13 strikeouts.

ON THIS DATE IN 1991: In front of 13,899 fans – Bush Stadium's largest Opening Night crowd ever – the Indians were no-hit by Oklahoma City for eight innings but still won the game 1-0 thanks to a bases-loaded walk drawn by shortstop Wil Cordero in the bottom of the sixth that forced home left fielder John Vander Wal. OKC's starting pitcher Roger Pavlik walked seven in 5.1 innings pitched to suffer the loss. Indy drew 10 walks offensively, and Mark Gardner (4.2ip, 0h, 5bb, 7k), Dana Ridenour (W, 3.1ip, 2h, 0bb, 4k) and Doug Piatt (S, 1.0ip, 0h, 0bb, 0k) combined on the two-hit shutout.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Thomas Harrington: The Campbell University alum entered the season as the Pirates' No. 3 prospect and MiLB's No.76 prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

Major League Debut: Harrington had his contract first selected by Pittsburgh on April 1, 2025 and debuted with a 4.0 inning start the same night at Tampa Bay. Picked up his first career save in his next appearance on April 7 vs. St. Louis.

Last Outing: Harrington made his first Triple-A appearance of the season on April 13 at Louisville, pitching 2.0 scoreless innings of relief while allowing two hits and striking out three.

Against the Mud Hens: Harrington has previously made two starts versus Toledo, pitching to a 5.40 ERA (7er/11.2ip) with nine strikeouts and a 0.94 WHIP against the Mud Hens. In Harrington's last time out against Toledo on Sept. 5, 2024, he twirled 6.0 innings of four-hit, two-run ball with five strikeouts.

Miscellaneous: Harrington was selected by Pittsburgh in the first round (36th overall) of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft.

2024 Highlights

» Was named Indianapolis' May Player of the Month after hitting nine home runs in 23 games, good for a .720 slugging percentage and 1.050 OPS; His nine home runs in the month were the third-most by an Indians batter in a single month since 2005 and the most since Michael Ryan launched 10 in July 2007.

» Launched 10 home runs in an 18-game stretch from 5/16-6/2 with a .328 batting average (21-for-64), three doubles, two triples, 27 RBI, .906 slugging percentage and 1.276 OPS; in that time, he led all International League batters in home runs, RBI, slugging percentage, OPS, extra-base hits (15), total bases (58) and triples (T-1st, 2).

2023 Highlights

» Began the season with Double-A Altoona and hit .238 (85-for-357) with 56 runs, 16 doubles, two triples, 17 home runs and 54 RBI in 93 games.
