INDY BITS

ABOUT YESTERDAY: With a 7-7 tie in the bottom of the sixth inning in Game 1, Chase DeLauter doubled off Eddy Yean to lead off the frame and came around to score on a Jhonkensy Noel single to give Columbus (31-38) their game-winning advantage. The game resumed yesterday afternoon after being suspended in the top of the fourth inning on Wednesday with the Indians trailing, 4-3. Indy struck first upon the continuation of Game 1. A single and a walk set up Nick Yorke to knot the game at four with an RBI single and Nick Solak followed with a two-RBI double off Ryan Webb to give Indy the lead. The Clippers responded with a run on a sacrifice fly in their half of the fourth and pulled ahead with a two-run fifth frame. Alika Williams struck with his second home run of the season in the top of the sixth to briefly tie the contest before Columbus' bottom half. Indianapolis stormed back from a 6-0 deficit in Game 2 and won, 8-6, in seven innings. Indy completed their comeback in the fifth inning. Darick Hall started the rally with a single and moved to third on a double by Liover Peguero. Malcom Nuñez brought both home on a double of his own to tie the game and came in to score on a pop up from Eli Wilson that landed between all four infielders to put Indy on top. Columbus surged to a four-run lead in the second inning with a trio of singles and a three-run home run by Milan Tolentino. The Clippers added their final two runs in the third on DeLauter's second home run in as many games. The Indians set up their comeback with a sacrifice fly from Nuñez and a three-run home run from Eli Wilson to cut their deficit to two before the game-deciding sixth frame.

LUCKY SEVENS: The Indians offense has scored seven runs in four straight games since June 15 for the first time this season after doing so twice in 2024. That is tied for the second-longest streak by an International League club this season. Across their streak, the Indians lead Triple-A teams in batting average (.324, 44-for-136), rank third in runs scored (29) and fourth in OPS (.917). They also have the second-highest batting average (.326, 15-for-46) and the fourthhighest OPS (.991) with runners in scoring position of any Triple-A offense in this span.

ALIKA'S ALL OVER IT: Alika Williams went 3-for-5 with a home run in Wednesday's suspended game, which is his first game with three hits and a home run since July 21, 2023, at lowa. He extended his hitting streak to eight games since June 11, which is tied with Liover Peguero for the longest active streak on the team. Across his run, Williams is hitting .400 (12-for-30) with a double, four RBI and a .939 OPS. He has racked up three three-hit games in June and has hit safely in 11 of 14 games, good for a .321 batting average (17-for-53) in the month.

NEW YORK(E) STATE OF MIND: Nick Yorke racked up his third straight multi-hit game in Wednesday's suspended game. Yorke has hit safely in 23 of his last 29 games dating back to May 15 vs. Louisville. In that stretch, he is hitting .318 (34-for-107) with six doubles, a triple, a home run, 15 RBI and 16 runs scored. During this span, he ranks third among International League hitters with a .282 batting average (20-for-71) in two-strike counts (min. 65 PA). Yorke is also hitting .375 (12-for-32) with three doubles, a triple, 13 RBI and a 1.005 OPS with runners in scoring position in this stretch.

JUST LIKE NU': Malcom Nuñez played in his first game with Indy since May 9 vs. Columbus in yesterday's regularly scheduled contest and recorded the gametying hit with a two-RBI double in the fifth inning. Before being placed on the seven-day injured list on May 11, Nuñez was hitting .320 with a .830 OPS while leading Indians hitters in extra-base hits (12) and ranking second in hits (30), RBI (15) and total bases (46). He had reached base safely in 12 of 14 games before his injury from April 22-May 9, good for a .395 batting average (17-for-43) that ranked sixth among International League hitters in that span.

SOLAK ECLIPSE: Nick Solak picked up a hit in both games yesterday, including a go-ahead two-run double in the resumption of Wednesday night's game to record his second and third RBI of the contest. Solak has reached base safely in 11 of 12 games played and has hit safely in 10 games since returning to Indy on June 5. On the season, Solak leads Triple-A hitters with at least 150 plate appearances in batting average (.358, 57-for-159) and ranks ninth in OPS. Solak's batting average is the highest by an Indians hitter (min. 150 PA) at this point in the season since Jake Elmore hit .362 (59-for-163) through June 19, 2019.

BIG FLY FOR ELI: Eli Wilson's three-run home run in yesterday's regularly scheduled contest spurred Indianapolis' comeback win. It was his second-career Triple-A homer, with his first coming in a pinch-hit effort on April 14, 2024, at Toledo. It was also his first three-run home run since June 7, 2023, at Wilmington while with Greensboro and the first for an Indians hitter this season.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians look to clinch at least a series split with a win against the Columbus Clippers tonight at 7:05 PM from Huntington Park. Indy is 9-3 in Friday games this season and are 5-1 in such games since May 2. The Indians' pitching staff has the second-most strikeouts (127) and second-lowest ERA (3.40, 40er/106.0ip) of any Triple-A club on Fridays. Thomas Harrington, MiLB's No. 78 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, will make his 12th start of the season for Indianapolis against veteran righty Vince Velasquez. Harrington has faced the Clippers twice in his career and has held them to a 1.74 ERA (2er/10.1ip) with 13 strikeouts. Velasquez made his only career appearance against Indy earlier this season, on May 9 at Victory Field, and tossed 5.0 scoreless innings while striking out six.

YOU'RE A PITCHER, HARRI: In Thomas Harrington's last start on June 14 vs. St. Paul, he struck out a Triple-A single-game high 10 batters across 6.0 innings of work, marking his most strikeouts in a game since July 20, 2024, while with Double-A Altonna at Erie. Harrington is currently on a run of three consecutive quality starts since June 3 at Memphis, which is the longest by an Indians pitcher since Cam Alldred also ran off three from June 16-19, 2023. A fourth quality start tonight would seal the first string of four quality starts for an Indians pitcher since J.T Brubaker's four start run from July 25-Aug. 11, 2018. Across his streak, Harrington has earned a 2-1 record with a 2.50 ERA (5er/18.0ip) with 18 strikeouts while holding opposing hitters to a .159 batting average (10-for-63).

ON THIS DATE IN 1974: The Indians overcame a 5-0 deficit in an exhibition with the Cincinnati Reds at Bush Stadium and scored seven unanswered runs on their way to victory. In front of 10,161 fans, Ken Griffey and Tom Spencer each hit two-run homers to lead Indy's offense. Johnny Bench and Hal King both homered for the Reds.

Thomas Harrington: The Campbell University alum is currently the Pirates' No. 3 prospect and Minor League Baseball's No. 80 overall prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

Major League Debut: Harrington had his contract first selected by Pittsburgh on April 1, 2025 and debuted with a 4.0 inning start the same night at Tampa Bay. Picked up his first career save in his next appearance on April 7 vs. St. Louis.

Last Outing: Harrington struck out a Triple-A single-game high 10 hitters across 6.0 innings while allowing five hits and two runs on June 14 vs. St. Paul.

Against the Clippers: Harrington has made two starts against the Clippers and has picthed to a 1-1 record with a 1.74 ERA (2er/10.1ip) with 13 strikeouts.
