ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Cedar Rapids Kernels 1-0 at Veterans Memorial Stadium. Bishop Letson, Bayden Root, Dikember Sánchez, and Aaron Rund combined on the four-hit shutout. The Timber Rattlers scored their run when Juan Baez grounded into a double play in the top of the sixth. Wisconsin has won two in a row to even the series after four games.

LET'S GO! Letson allowed four hits over 5-1/3 innings with no walks and four strikeouts as the starting pitcher for Wisconsin. He left the game after allowing a single with one out in the sixth on his 70th pitch of the night. He threw 50 strikes in his outing and earned his first Midwest League win. On the season, Letson has walked three and struck out seventeen over 16-1/3

RELIEF WORK: Root got the final two outs of the sixth inning and pitched a perfect seventh with one strikeout. Sánchez pitched around a two-out walk in the eighth. got the first two outs in the ninth, but walked Danny DeAndrade on a full count. Rund took over at that point and saw Nate Baez reach on an error before striking out Kevin Maitan on a 2-2 pitch to earn the save.

FOR THREE: Last night was Wisconsin's third shutout of the season. They are tied with Beloit and Dayton for the second in shutouts by a Midwest League team this season. Quad Cities leads with five shutouts as a staff.

THE RALLY: The Rattlers were held scoreless through five innings by Kernels starting pitcher Alejandro Hidalgo. In the sixth, Jadher Areinamo singled, Blake Burke walked, and Matt Wood singled to load the bases as the first three batters to face Jacob Wosinski. Baez hit a grounder past Wosinski that was fielded near second by DeAndrade, who turned the 4-3 double play as Areinamo scored the run.

THE OFFENSE: Wisconsin was held to four hits in the game. Both Areinamo and Wood had two singles.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence in 1949 as the Cedar Rapids Rockets, an unaffiliated team in the Central Association. They moved to the Three-I League as the Cedar Rapids Indians, an affiliate of Cleveland in 1950. They were affiliated with the Milwaukee Braves from 1954 through 1962. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins from 2013 through 2023, including a 2023 Midwest League Championship. That streak ended last year when the Kernels missed the playoffs. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, and Milwaukee Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook. Hall of Famers John McGraw (1891 Canaries), Lou Boudreau (1938 Raiders), Ted Simmons (1967 Cardinals), and Trevor Hoffman (1991 Reds) played for earlier pro teams in Cedar Rapids.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Bishop Letson (#14), Blake Burke (#16), Jadher Areinamo (#23), Juan Baez (#26), and Manuel Rodriguez (#29). MLB Pipeline has eight active Kernels on their list of Minnesota prospects: Kaelen Culpepper (#4), Brandon Winokur (#7), Carlee Soto (#8), Kyle DeBarge (#12), Billy Amick (#14), Gabriel Gonzalez (#17), Danny De Andrade (#25), Jose Olivares (#28), and Khadim Diaw (#29). Rayne Doncon (#15) is currently on the Cedar Rapids IL.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TYSON HARDIN: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Hardin in the 12th round of the 2024 draft out of Mississippi State University.

BULLDOG: Hardin was 3-3 and two saves with a 6.59 ERA and 61 strikeouts over 56 innings in forty games – two starts – at Mississippi State.

DAYTONA 500: Hardin pitched two seasons at Daytona State College (2021 and 2022). He was the team's pitcher of the year as a freshman and was 8-5 with two saves in 38 appearances – fifteen starts – at DSC.

BREAKING OUT: Hardin worked two innings in Milwaukee's 2025 Spring Breakout Game against the Cincinnati Reds on <u>March 16</u>. He allowed one hit and struck out three without a walk in two scoreless innings.

LAST START: Hardin beat Lansing at home on April 19. He allowed four hits, walked one, and struck out seven over 5-2/3 innings.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: Hardin has never faced the Kernels prior to this afternoon. Today is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the

CEDAR RAPIDS STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TANNER HALL: The Minnesota Twins selected Hall in the fourth round of the 2023 draft out of the University of Southern Mississippi.

A GOLDEN EAGLE: Hall pitched three seasons at Southern Miss. He was 22-8 in 55 games – 36 starts – with an ERA of 2.92 and 302 strikeouts over 250 innings in college. He was 12-4 with a 2.48 ERA and 124 strikeouts in 112-1/3 innings in his final season.

MUSSEL UP: Hall did not pitch professionally in 2023. He made his pro debut with the Ft. Myers Mighty Mussels in 2024. He was 4-0 with a 4.44 ERA in fifteen games – nine starts in the Florida State League before was promoted to Cedar Rapids on August 12. Hall had 59 strikeouts over 46-2/3 innings.

LAST START: Hall beat Peoria on the road on <u>April 19</u>. He allowed one run on two hits over five innings. Hall walked four and struck out three in the game.

VS. WISCONSIN: Hall had a no decision at Wisconsin on April 6. He allowed five runs on five hits, including homers by Jadher Areinamo and Blake Burke over five innings. He walked one and struck out six. Hall lost to Wisconsin at Cedar Rapids on September 8, 2024. He allowed six runs on five hits with two walks and two strikeouts over four innings. Cooper Pratt and Eduardo Garcia both homered in the first inning of that game against Hall.
