ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Timber Rattlers beat the Peoria Chiefs 6-1 at Dozer Park. Three Wisconsin pitchers combined for nineteen strikeouts in the game. Victor Castañeda set a new single-game high as a professional with nine over five innings. Arman Sabouri and Evan Reifert each struck out five.

WHAT A RELIEF: Reifert pitched 2-1/3 scoreless innings with a hit, two walks, five strikeouts, and stranded two runners last night. In his last five appearances, Reifert has allowed two hits, walked three, and struck out sixteen without allowing a run over 8-1/3 innings. He has also inherited five runners in his last five appearances and hasn't allowed any to score.

TIE-BREAKER: Nick Kahle broke the 1-1 tie with a two-run single in the top of the fifth inning.

HOW ABOUT THAT: The Chiefs had a runner a first and Brady Whalen at the plate in the bottom of the fifth. Wisconsin's defense was set up with three infielders on the right of second base and Chad McClanahan, the third baseman, playing in the shortstop position. Whalen hit a ball into the defensive shift and the Rattlers turned an inning-ending 4-5-3 double play with McClanahan making the turn a second base.

INSURANCE: The Timber Rattlers added two runs in the top of the sixth inning on a bases-loaded walk to McClanahan and an RBI, infield single by Yeison Coca.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1957 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1956 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels in 1983. They changed their name to the Chiefs and their affiliation to the Chicago Cubs for the 1984 season. They became a Cardinals affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. Chris Swauger is back as the manager of the Chiefs this year. Swauger managed the Chiefs in 2017 and 2018 when Peoria was in the Midwest League. The Chiefs made the Midwest League Championship Series but lost to Bowling Green in the Finals under Swauger in 2018. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, and Yadier Molina.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to Springfield from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first time with Peoria. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) puts five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Carlos Rodríguez (#14), Hayden Cantrelle (#16), Nick Kahle (#20), Thomas Dillard (#22), and David Hamilton (#27). [MLB Pipeline](#) has two current Chiefs on their list of St. Louis prospects: Jordan Walker (#6) and Jhon Torres (#7). Ian Bedell (#11) is on the Peoria IL.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP REESE OLSON: Selected by Milwaukee in the 13th round of the 2018 draft out of North Hall High School in Gainesville, Georgia.

NOT GOING TO GET TECHNICAL: Olson signed with the Brewers over a scholarship to Georgia Tech.

MY OLD SCHOOL: Olson was a junior when North Hall High School won the Georgia State 3A Baseball Championship in 2017. The Bulldogs made the state playoffs again in 2018.

DESERT DEBUT: Olson went 0-2 with a 5.23 ERA in four games – two starts – for the AZL Brewers in 2018. He walked four and struck out six in 10-1/3 innings pitched.

FIRST PRO WIN: Olson came on in relief at Lansing on May 1 after the April 30 game had been suspended at Cooley Law School Stadium. He pitched five innings and picked up the win for his first professional victory.

2019: Olson was 4-7 with a 4.66ERA in 27 games – 14 starts – with Wisconsin in 2019. Olson walked 47 and struck out 84 in 94-2/3 innings.

LAST START: Olson had a no decision [at Beloit on July 1](#). He allowed an unearned run on two hits and two walks with five strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings. The Rattlers were up 2-1 when Olson left the game, but the Snappers rallied for a 5-4 win in eleven innings.

VS. PEORIA (2021): Olson is 2-0 in four starts against the Chiefs this season. He had a no decision [at Peoria on May 13](#), beat them at Neuroscience Group Field [on June 1](#) and [on June 6](#), and had a no decision in game one of a doubleheader [at home on June 25](#). Olson has allowed six runs on seventeen hits with twelve walks and 27 strikeouts in 20 innings pitched against the Chiefs this season.

PEORIA STARTING PITCHER:

RHP MICHAEL YASENKA: The Cardinals selected YaSenka in the 17th round of the 2019 draft out of Eastern Illinois University.

NIGHT PANTHER: YaSenka made 15 starts in his junior season at Eastern Illinois. He was 4-7 with an ERA of 5.56 and 100 strikeouts over 90-2/3 innings pitched.

AS A PRO IN 2019: YaSenka split time between Johnson City in the Appalachian League and State College in the New York-Penn League after signing with the Cardinals. He was 2-1 with a 0.56 ERA in seven games – five starts – for Johnson City and 1-1 with a 2.45ERA in three starts for State College. YaSenka walked 13 and struck out 49 in 47 innings between those two levels in the Cardinals system.

LAST START: YaSenka had a no decision [at Cedar Rapids on July 8](#). He allowed three hits, walked one, and struck out eight over six scoreless innings. The game was scoreless through nine innings and the Kernels would win 4-1 in twelve innings.

VS. WISCONSIN (2021): YaSenka has no record in three starts against the Timber Rattlers this season. He pitched against Wisconsin [at Dozer Park on May 14](#), [at Neuroscience Group Field on June 2](#), and in the first game of a doubleheader in the [Fox Cities on June 25](#). He has allowed ten runs on fourteen hits with six walks and sixteen strikeouts over 12-1/3 innings against the Timber Rattlers in 2021.
