LAST ACTION: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Beloit Sky Carp 6-5 at Neuroscience Group Field on Friday night.](#) Eduardo Garcia hit two home runs, including a homer that tied the game 5-5 in the eighth, for the Timber Rattlers. Zack Raabe and Antonio Piñero had back-to-back doubles later in the eighth to give Wisconsin the lead and James Meeker pitched a scoreless ninth for his seventeenth save of the season.

HIT THE HOMER...HIT THE HOMER: Garcia had the first multi-homer game as a pro on Friday. He also hit a solo home run in the second inning to give the Rattlers a 1-0 lead. Garcia added a single in the sixth inning for his fourth three-hit game as a Timber Rattler.

BACK-AND-FORTH: Wisconsin had a 3-0 lead after the bottom of the second. The Sky Carp tied the game with three runs in the top of the third. Beloit took a 4-3 lead on a sacrifice fly by Dalvy Rosario in the fifth. The Sky Carp added an insurance run on an infield single by Brady Allen in the seventh. Rosario and Allen each had two RBI in the game for Beloit.

BULLPEN BITS: The Beloit run in the seventh inning was their first run off the Wisconsin bullpen in this series. Rattler relievers have covered sixteen innings during the first four games of the series with Beloit.

SAVINGS PLAN: James Meeker gave up a walk with one out in the top of the ninth before getting a game-ending 6-4-3 double play. Since August 1, Meeker is 11-for-12 in save opportunities and has allowed one earned run over 18-1/3 innings pitched in fifteen appearances.

DID YOU KNOW? The Timber Rattlers have reached at least 40 home wins for the eighth time in team history. The 2022 Rattlers are 40-24. The franchise record for home wins in a season is 48 and was set by the 1997 team.

ON ASSIGNMENT: The Milwaukee Brewers have sent outfielder Jonathan Davis and reliever Trevor Gott to the Timber Rattlers on a rehab assignment. Davis was 0-for-3 as the starting centerfielder for Wisconsin on Friday.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp are in their first season as the Sky Carp and their second season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and [moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3.](#) Jorge Hernandez is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have a history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) puts four active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jackson Chourio (#1), Jeferson Quero (#7), Carlos F. Rodríguez (#19), and Eduardo García (#21). Tyler Black (#6), Russell Smith (#20), and Carlos D. Rodríguez (#22) are on the Wisconsin injured list. [MLB Pipeline](#) has three Beloit players on their list of Marlins prospects: Jose Salas (#5), Victor Mesa Jr (#16), and MD Johnson (#28). Cody Morissette (#23) is on the Sky Carp's IL.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP STIVEN CRUZ: Signed by Milwaukee as an International Free Agent out of Nicaragua on July 2, 2019.

DELAYED START: Cruz began his pro career with the Brewers-1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He was 3-3 with a 1.37 ERA and 73 strikeouts over 52-2/3 innings pitched in twelve games – eleven starts.

MUDDY WATERS: Cruz started the 2022 season with the Carolina Mudcats in the Carolina League. He went 3-5 with a 4.60 ERA in fifteen starts for Carolina. Cruz walked 18 and struck out 89 over 72-1/3 innings pitched.

ON TO WISCONSIN: Cruz joined the Timber Rattlers on August 16, 2022.

IT'S A MAJOR AWARD: Cruz joined the Timber Rattlers on August 16, 2022.

AWARD WINNING: Cruz beat Lansing at home on August 24. He allowed a hit with a walk and seven strikeouts over six scoreless innings in the game. Cruz was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on August 29 for this game.

LAST START: Cruz had a [no decision at Peoria on September 4](#). He allowed two hits with no walks and two strikeouts over three scoreless innings.

VS. БЕЛОИТ: Cruz has never faced the Sky Carp prior to this afternoon. Today is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

БЕЛОИТ STARTING PITCHER

RHP GABE BIERMAN: The Marlins selected Bierman in the 7th round of the 2021 draft out of the University of Indiana.

HOOSIER TIME: Bierman was 11-5 with two saves in 36 games – 21 starts – in three seasons at Indiana. He had 150 strikeouts over 144 innings pitched in his collegiate career.

LET'S GET IT STARTED: Bierman started his professional career with stints in the Florida Complex League and with Jupiter in the Florida State League after signing with the Marlins. He was 1-0 with a save, a 4.50 ERA, and 31 strikeouts over 28 innings in eight games – seven starts as a pro in his first year.

ON JUPITER: Bierman began this season in the Florida State League with the Jupiter Hammerheads. He was 6-6 with a 4.76 ERA in twenty games – seventeen starts – before his promotion to Beloit on August 25. Bierman walked 47 and struck out 105 in 96-1/3 innings pitched with the Hammerheads.

LAST START: Bierman [lost to Quad Cities at home on September 10](#). He allowed a run on two hits with no walks, a hit batsman, and seven strikeouts over six innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Bierman has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this afternoon. This is also the first time Bierman will face an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
