ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Peoria Chiefs shut out the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 4-0 at Neuroscience Group Field. Brandon Knarr allowed one run over six innings as the Wisconsin starting pitcher and took the loss. Dionys Rodríguez pitched five scoreless innings for the Chiefs and picked up the win. Last night was Peoria's second straight shutout win over the Rattlers.

MISSED OPPORTUNITY: Wisconsin trailed 2-0 in the bottom of the eighth inning. They loaded the bases with no outs on two walks and a single by Zavier Warren. The Chiefs escaped the inning with two strikeouts and a flyout to maintain the lead.

DÉJÀ VU: Knarr had his personal seven-game winning streak come to an end last night. Knarr is 7-2 this season with both of his losses via shutouts at home against the Chiefs.

DID YOU KNOW? The Timber Rattlers have been shut out four times this season. Peoria has three of those shutouts. Wisconsin's scoreless streak is at 23-1/3

ZAVIER'S ELEVEN: Zavier Warren had two hits last night to give him eleven multi-hit games this season. He is tied with Tyler Black and Tristan Peters for the team lead in multi-hit games.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1957 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1956 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels in 1983. They changed their name to the Chiefs and their affiliation to the Chicago Cubs for the 1984 season. They became a Cardinals affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his first year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, and Yadier Molina.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts seven Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#6), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Zavier Warren (#17), Carlos Rodríguez (#21), and Cam Robinson (#26). MLB Pipeline has three current Chiefs on their list of Cardinals prospects - one active and two on the injured list: Austin Love (#20) is on the active list. Ian Bedell (#21) and Jhon Torres (#23) are on the Peoria Injured List.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP ANTOINE KELLY: Selected by the Brewers in the second round of the 2019 draft out of Wabash Valley College in Mt. Carmel, Illinois. He is rated as the #14 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline. Baseball America places Kelly at #10 for their in-season update of Milwaukee

WARRIORS...COME OUT TO PLAY: Kelly was 9-0 with 112 strikeouts in thirteen starts for the Warriors prior to the draft. He allowed 21 hits, 19 earned runs, and 31 walks over 52-2/3 innings pitched at Wabash Valley

SAYING NO TO SAN DIEGO: The San Diego Padres selected Kelly in the thirteenth round of the 2018 draft after his senior season at Maine East High School in Park Ridge, Illinois. Kelly chose junior college over signing with

THE BOYHOOD DREAM COMES TRUE: Kelly has been a Milwaukee Brewers fan since he was young.

WHAT'S BREWING? Kelly made his pro debut in the AZL with the Brewers Blue and made one start for the Rattlers in 2019. He spent 2020 with the Brewers Alternate Training Site. He underwent surgery for Thoracic Outlet Syndrome on November 5, 2020 and has worked his way back to Wisconsin after a relief appearance in Arizona and seven starts with Carolina before joining the Rattlers near the end of the 2021 season.

LAST START: Kelly lost at Cedar Rapids on May 28. He allowed six runs five earned – on four hits and four walks with seven strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings. Kelly also gave up a home run, the first he had allowed this season.

VS. PEORIA (2022): Kelly had a no decision at Peoria on April 29. He allowed three runs - two earned - on two hits and three walks with four strikeouts over three innings.

PEORIA SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP AUSTIN LOVE: The Cardinals selected Love in the third round of the 2021 draft out of the University of North Carolina.

TARHEEL TIME: Love appeared in 61 games for North Carolina between 2019 and 2021 and compiled a record of 19-8 with a 3.72 ERA and 210 strikeouts over 183-2/3 innings in his career.

CAROLINA BLUE: Love capped his college career by going 10-4 with a3.71 ERA in seventeen games - sixteen starts - with the Tarheels in 2021. He walked 32 and struck out 129 over 102 innings pitched. Love's last start at UNC was a win over UCLA on June 4, 2021 in the first game of the Lubbock Regional in the NCAA Tournament.

FIRST YEAR IN THE PROS: Love made five brief starts for the Florida Complex League of the Cardinals and two relief appearances for the Palm Beach Cardinals after signing with St. Louis. He had no record, allowed one earned run, walked one, and struck out thirteen over eight pro innings in 2021.

RATING BY THE BOOK: Baseball America and MLB Pipeline both rate Love as the #20 prospect in the St. Louis system..

LAST START: Love lost to Lake County at home on May 28. He allowed two runs on seven hits with two walks and five strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN (2022): Love had a no decision against the Timber Rattlers at home on April 29. He gave up six runs on seven hits including three home runs - with two walks and four strikeouts over three innings.
