FRES-NOTES

PLAYOFF BOUND IN THE "GROWL"IFORNIA LEAGUE: For the second straight season, the Fresno Grizzlies are headed back to the playoffs after a 4-2 win over the Modesto Nuts on June 22nd from Chukchansi Park. Over those two years, Fresno has clinched both times against Modesto. The Grizzlies claimed the California League Northern Division and the best record in the California League after winning both the first and second half. This is the first time in Grizzlies history that the team has made the playoffs in back-to-back seasons. The last time Fresno baseball made it to the postseason in back-to-back years were the Fresno Cardinals in 1955-1956. Since the Grizzlies won both halves, the team with the second best divisional record (San Jose Giants) would earn the second Northern Division playoff spot. The Grizzlies and Giants will meet in a best-of-three series starting next Tuesday at Excite Ballpark. Game 2 and if necessary, Game 3 will be held at Chukchansi Park in Fresno. The winner of the series will face the champion from the Southern Division Lake Elsinore Storm, 1st Half Champion and Inland Empire 66ers, 2nd Half Champion) in a best-of-three series the following week.

JORDY VARGAS TIME: Tonight's scheduled starter is 18-year old Jordy Vargas, who will be making his sixth start in a Fresno uniform. Prior to his promotion, Vargas went 2-1 with a 2.36 ERA over seven games (five starts) with the ACL Rockies. He tossed 26.2 innings, not allowing a homer and had a 10.1 K/BB ratio (40/4). Vargas is listed as one of the top Rockies overall prospects after signing with Colorado for \$500,000 when the 2020-21 international signing period opened in January of 2021. Vargas is the son of former big league reliever Yorkis Perez (who was coached by Grizzlies pitching coach Mark Brewer). He can already touch the mid-90s with his fastball, throwing it with good spin rates and resulting life. His curve has the chance to be a plus pitch, with outstanding downward action and spin. Vargas is also working on a changeup that will come with time. You can read more about Vargas on Page 2.

DON'T POKE THE BEAR: The Grizzlies are first in all of Minor League Baseball with a +206 run differential (Charleston, +175). Fresno also ranks second in all of Minor League Baseball with 124 hit-by-pitches (Modesto, 140). The 124 hit-by-pitches are the most in Grizzlies franchise history for a single-season (87, 2005). They also rank second with 275 doubles (EI Paso, 297), second with a 276 batting average, third with an 852 person of the 125 batting average, third with an 852 person of the 125 batting average, third with 769 RBI, fourth with 715 his, fourth with 2,077 total bases and fourth weith 155 sacrifice files. Fresno has the fourth fewest parmount of strikeouts (1,054) in all of Minor League Baseball and lead the California League in homers (161, +13, San Jose).

AMADOR'S AMAZING ACHIEVEMENTS: Grizzlies shortstop and Rockies #3 overall prospect Adael Amador is now ranked in the Top 10 in franchise single-season walks. Amado is now at 86 walks, passing Jon Singleton (2016) for second all-time. Up next is Damon Minor (2000, 1st), who had 87 walks in his respective season. Amador also has 97 runs, which passed Tony Kemp (2017) for fluir in single-season runs. Up next is Felipe Crespo (1999), who d89 runs in his respective season.

BRITO IS BRILLIANT: Grizzlies second baseman Juan Brito currently has 29 doubles, two shy of joining the Top 10. Jack Mayfield (2018), Nate Schierholtz (2007) and Calvin Muray (1999) each recorded 31 doubles in their respective seasons. Brito currently has six triples, one shy of joining the Top 10. Preston Tucker (2017), Nate Schierholtz (2007), Jasor Elisson (2004) and Calvin Muray (1999) each registered seven triples in their respective years. Brito is now ranked in the Top 10 in franchise single-season runs with 90. Up next is lodd Linden (2004-5th), who recorded 93 runs in his respective year. Finally, Brito is now ranked in the Top 10 in franchise single-season walks with 77. Up next are Felipe Crespo (1999), Michael Byas (2000) and Justin Leone (2007), who recorded 78 walks in their respective season.

FERNANDEZ FLEXING INTO THE RECORD BOOKS: Grizzlies outfielder and Rockies #12 overall prospect Yanquiel Fernandez is now the all-time leader in Grizzlies franchise single-season RBI. On September 8th at San Jose, Fernandez crushed a clout, giving him 109 RBI on the season. He passed Scott McClain (2008) and A.J. Reed (2018) with this honor. Fernandez powered his 33rd double of the year, putting him a representable of the Top 10 in franchise single-season doubles. On September 1st versus Modesto, Fernandez powered his 33rd double of the year, putting him a tie for sixth with Matt Downs (2009) for that feat. Up next are Pedro Feliz (2000) and Brett Pill (2010), who had 34 doubles in their respective seasons. Fernandez also has five triples, two shy of joining the Top 10. Preston Tucker (2017), Nate Schierhoftz (2007), Jason Ellison (2044) and Calvin Murray (1999) each registered seven triples in their respective years. Finally, Fernandez is now ranked in the Top 10 in franchise single-season total bases (241, 10th). Up next is Scott McClain (2007), who had 242 total bases in his respective season.

GUERRERO IS GREAT: Grizzlies outfielder Juan Guerrero is now ranked in the Top 10 in franchise single-season runs with 89. Up next is Jason Ellison (2004), who recorded 90 runs in his respective year.

MONTGOMERY IS MASHING: Grizzlies outfielder Benny Montgomery is riding a 13-game hitting streak, the longest by a Fresno batter in 2022. In that span, Montgomery is 24-55 (436) with two homers, one triple, eight doubles, 15 RBI, 14 runs, seven walks, two hit-by-pitches and three stolen bases. Juan Guerrero, Yanquiel Fernandez and Zach Kokoska had 12-game hit streaks this season, the initial longest span by a Fresno batter in 2022.

2022 HIGHLIGHTS

2022: Enters 2nd professional season with the Colorado Rockies organization...listed as the Rockies #29 overall prospect...over seven games (five starts), went 2-1 with a 2.36 ERA with ACL Rockies... tossed 26.2 innings, striking out 40 and walking four...has not allowed a professional homer...had a 0.64 WHIP before being assigned to Fresno from ACL Rockies on August 6th...struck out four over four innings of work in Fresno debut 8/9 at IE (4 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 3 BB)... was dominant in his 2nd start donning the Grizzlies threads (first win with Fresno), tied his career-high with five shutout frames, allowed one hit and walk while fanning eight, permitted a two-out single in the 1st and issued a 5th inning walk, his eight strikeouts were one shy of his career-best and he punched out seven of the nine Rawhide starters 8/16 at VIS...named California League Pitcher of the Week (August 15-21) for his efforts on 8/16 at VIS...made home debut 8/23 vs STK. tossing career-high five innings, allowing leadoff homer and four hits while fanning four...earned second win with Fresno after five innings of two-run ball (both solo shots), striking out four 8/30 vs MOD...four innings of four-run ball, allowing five hits and three walks while punching out one 9/6 at SJ.

CAREER NOTES

2021: Spent the entire season with DSL Colorado...made an immediate impression by spending the summer dominating the Dominican Summer League at the age of 17, with a 1.30 ERA over 34 2/3 innings...had a 0.98 WHIP, and a 46:16 K:BB ratio without allowing a home run.

Personal: The son of former big league reliever Yorkis Perez, Vargas signed with the Rockies for \$500,000 when the 2020-21 international signing period opened in January 2021... at 6-foot-3, has the type of projectible frame that should be able to handle a lot more strength, with more velocity highly likely as he matures...already has a good idea of his delivery and is largely around the strike zone...like a lot of young pitchers with premium stuff, he can get into trouble by hunting strikeouts, but as he learns to be more of a pitcher than a thrower, Minor League hitters better watch out...Rockies didn't bring Vargas to instructs last fall, building anticipation for his United States debut in 2022..he can already touch the mid-90s with his fastball, throwing it with good spin rates and resulting life...his curve has the chance to be a plus pitch, with outstanding downward action and spin. Working on a changeup will come with time...middle name is Miguel
