## SUNDAY IN SOUTH BEND: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the South Bend Cubs 9-8 in eleven innings at Four Winds Field.](#)

The Timber Rattlers had a 5-0 lead after the top of the third inning. The Cubs rallied to tie the game. The teams traded runs in the tenth inning. Wisconsin scored three runs in the top of the eleventh. South Bend scored twice in the bottom of the eleventh but stranded the tying and winning runs and the Rattlers held on for the win. Wisconsin ended their first three-game winning streak with Sunday's win. The Timber Rattlers are 2-0 in extra-innings games in 2024.

**A+ PERFORMER:** Jadher Areinamo was 3-for-5 with a homer, a stolen base, two runs, and four RBI on Sunday for Wisconsin. He was 11-for-23 with ten RBI and five runs scored for the Timber Rattlers in the six-game series at South Bend. Areinamo is on an eight-game hitting streak, the longest by a Timber Rattler this season. He is 13-for-31 (.419) with eleven RBI with six stolen bases in six attempts during the streak.

**CAN OF CORN:** Wisconsin starting pitcher Alexander Cornielle saw his scoreless innings streak end at 20-2/3 innings when the Cubs scored a run in the bottom of the third on Sunday. In four starts in May, Cornielle allowed two runs over 23-2/3 innings with nineteen strikeouts. He was 2-0 and had 5-0 leads in his last two starts but had no decisions in those games.

**SAVING THE DAY:** Steven Cruz took over for an injured Edwin Jimenez with the bases loaded and one out in the bottom of the eleventh inning with the Rattlers up by two runs. Cruz gave up a run on a sacrifice fly, but got a force play to end the game for his first save of the season.

**STANDINGS CHECK:** Wisconsin trails West Division-leading Cedar Rapids Kernels by ½-game.

**ABOUT FORT WAYNE:** The Fort Wayne TinCaps franchise started in Mattoon, Illinois for the 1947 season. That franchise moved to Keokuk, Iowa to become the Keokuk Cardinals from 1958 through 1962. The team moved again to Wisconsin Rapids, Wisconsin for 1963. They were affiliated with the Washington Senators in 1963 and became a Minnesota Twins affiliate after the Major League team moved to Minneapolis for the 1964 season. Wisconsin Rapids moved to Kenosha, Wisconsin for the 1984 season and remained an affiliate of the Twins. Fort Wayne joined the Midwest League after the Kenosha Twins were in 1992 and the franchise moved to Fort Wayne, Indiana for the 1993 season. The team renamed themselves as the Fort Wayne Wizards and stayed an affiliate of the Twins through the 1998 season. Fort Wayne affiliated with the San Diego Padres and has remained in that relationship to this day. There was one more move for the franchise. The team moved from Memorial Stadium to Parkview Field to start the 2009 season. They also changed their name to TinCaps for 2009. The TinCaps won the only MWL Pennant for the Fort Wayne entry of the franchise in 2009. Notable former Fort Wayne players include Torri Hunter, Jake Peavy, AJ Pierzynski, Josh Barfield, LaTroy Hawkins, Corey Kluber, David Freese, and Fernando Tatis Jr.

**ABOUT THE PADRES:** San Diego's relationship with Midwest League teams began in 1990 when they started an affiliation with the Waterloo Diamonds. That partnership moved to the Springfield Sultans with the Waterloo franchise for 1994. The Padres were the parent club of the Clinton LumberKings from 1995 through 1998 before joining with the Fort Wayne franchise for 1999.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP PATRICIO AQUINO:** The Milwaukee Brewers signed Aquino as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on January 15, 2021.

**LET'S GET IT STARTED:** Aquino made his professional debut with the Brewers #1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He made eleven starts and was 1-2 with a 2.66 ERA and 54 strikeouts in 44 innings pitched.

**LET'S GO TO ARIZONA:** Aquino was 2-1 with a 4.72 ERA in eight games – seven starts – for the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League during the 2022 season. He had 49 strikeouts over 34-1/3 innings pitched.

**ON TO CAROLINA:** Aquino was 5-3 with a 2.75 ERA in 21 games – 19 starts – with 86 strikeouts over 88-1/3 innings pitched during the 2023 regular season.

**PLAYOFF CALL:** Aquino was the starting pitcher for the Mudcats in Game Two of the first round Carolina League playoff series against the Down East Wood Ducks. He had a no decision with six scoreless innings. The Mudcats would lose the game 6-5 in ten innings.

**HOW DOES HE RATE?** MLB Pipeline rates Aquino as the #28 prospect in the Brewers organization.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Aquino had a no decision at South Bend on [May 21](#) as a reliever. He allowed a run on three hits with a walk and two strikeouts over four innings.

**LAST START:** Aquino beat Beloit at home on [May 14](#). Aquino pitched six innings, allowed one run on five hits, walked one, and struck out five for a quality start.

**VS. FORT WAYNE:** Aquino has never faced the TinCaps prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the San Diego Padres.

## FORT WAYNE STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP ENMANUEL PINALES:** The San Diego Padres signed Pinales as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on January 15, 2022.

**DELAYED DEBUT:** Pinales did not pitch professionally until the 2023 season and would pitch at two levels in the San Diego system during that year. He started with the ACL Padres and was 1-2 with a 7.15 ERA in six games – three starts. Pinales was assigned to the Lake Elsinore Storm on July 21, 2023 and was 3-0 with a 2.87 ERA in nine games – six starts – in the California League. He walked nineteen and struck out 63 over 60-1/3 innings over his 2023 season.

**FALL OF THE YEAR:** The Padres assigned Pinales to the Peoria Javelinas for the 2023 Arizona Fall League. He was 1-0 in eight relief appearances. He allowed ten runs on seven hits with eleven walks and thirteen strikeouts over 11-2/3 innings in the AFL.

**LAST START:** Pinales beat Lansing at home on [May 21](#). He allowed one hit and struck out nine over seven scoreless innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Pinales has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
