ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Quad Cities River Bandits beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 13-5 at Neuroscience Group Field at Fox Cities Stadium. Luca Tresh led the River Bandits offense with four hits and three RBI. Quad Cities had eighteen hits and scored in seven of the nine innings in the game.

PAINT IT BLACK: Tyler Black went 4-for-4 with two singles and two doubles for the Timber Rattlers last night for his second career four-hit game. Black also reached on a hit batsman, scored two runs, and drove in one run in the game.

BLAST OFF: The River Bandits put the leadoff batter on base in seven of nine innings last night. That leadoff hitter scored six times. Wisconsin leadoff hitters reached base five times to start innings on Tuesday, but only scored twice. Last night was also the sixth time in the last seven games the opponent has scored a first inning run against the Timber Rattlers.

BAD SIX PACK: Wisconsin is on its first six-game losing streak of the season. The Rattlers were 2-for-14 with runners in scoring position and left eleven runners on base last night. In their last six games, Wisconsin has stranded 46 runners and is 8-for-53 with runners in scoring position.

WELCOME BACK...AND LOOK OUT! Darrien Miller returned to the Wisconsin lineup for the first time since June 3 when he was the starting catcher. He was on base four times. Miller walked once and was hit by pitches three times.

REHABBING: Milwaukee Brewers infielder Mike Brosseau was the starting third baseman for the Rattlers last night and was 0-for-2 with two walks and left after six innings. Brewers reliever Trevor Gott pitched the fifth inning and allowed three runs on four hits with no walks and two strikeouts to be charged with the loss. Brewers starting pitcher Brandon Woodruff will be making a rehab start for the Timber Rattlers tomorrow night.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo from 1969-1976, Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#7), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Zavier Warren (#17), and Cam Robinson (#26). Carlos Rodríguez (#21) is on the Wisconsin injured list. MLB Pipeline has three current River Bandits on their Top 30 list of Kansas City Royals prospects: Peyton Wilson (#11), Luca Tresh (#23), and Diego Hernandez (#30).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ZACH MORT: Signed with Milwaukee as a Minor League Free Agent on January 14, 2021.

ORIGIN STORY: Mort was drafted by the Chicago Cubs in the 8th round of the 2018 draft out of George Mason University.

PATRIOTIC DUTY: Mort appeared in 57 games - 28 starts - over three seasons at George Mason. He went 12-12 with nine saves and a 3.72 ERA and 205 strikeouts over 227-1/3 innings pitched during his collegiate career.

IN THE CUBS DEN: Mort spent two seasons (2018 and 2019) in the Cubs organization after signing with them. He made ten relief appearances (0-4, 5.79) with the Eugene Emeralds in 2018. In 2019, Mort was 3-3 with a 3.72 ERA in Eugene and 6-2 with a 3.13 ERA for South Bend.

POSTSEASON: Mort was the winning pitcher in Game One of the Midwest League Championship Series against the Clinton LumberKings on September 11, 2019. Mort went three scoreless innings, allowed one hit and two walks with four strikeouts as a reliever. The South Bend Cubs went on to sweep the best-of-five series from Clinton.

LAST SEASON: Mort started 2021 with the Timber Rattlers and was 1-4 in sixteen games - thirteen starts. He was moved to Carolina in August and was 4-1 in six starts for the Mudcats. Mort had a 6.22 ERA and 101 strikeouts over 97 innings pitched between the two levels last year.

LAST START: Mort was charged with the loss at Great Lakes on June 16. He allowed eight runs on ten hits with no walks, two hit batsmen, and two strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings.

VS. QUAD CITIES (2022): Mort is 1-0 in two relief appearances against the River Bandits this season. He has allowed one run on three hits with no walks and four strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings versus Quad Cities this year.

QUAD CITIES SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

 \mbox{LHP} RYLAN KAUFMAN: Selected by the Kansas City Royals in the 12^{th} round of the 2018 draft out of San Jacinto Junior College.

GATOR: Kaufman was 7-1 in fourteen games - twelve starts - in his draft season at San Jacinto Junior College. Kaufman had a 2.18 ERA and 59 strikeouts in 53-2/3 innings pitched

TWO AT A TIME: Kaufman pitched for the AZL Royals and Idaho Falls Chukars in 2018 after signing with Kansas City. In 2019, he was limited to just eight innings in two starts between Idaho Falls and Burlington in the Appalachian League due to an injury.

BACK AT IT: Kaufman spent all of 2021 with the Columbia Fireflies in the Low-A East. He was 2-5 with a 5.95 ERA in 23 games - twenty starts with Columbia. He had 94 strikeouts over 81-2.3 innings pitched.

MOVING ON UP: Kaufman started this season with the Fireflies and was 1-2 with a 5.49 ERA in six games - three starts. The Royals sent him to Quad Cities on May 17. Kaufman has made six starts with a 1-3 record and a 5.28 ERA since joining the River Bandits.

LAST START: Kaufman had a no decision against South Bend on June 16 at home. He allowed a run on two hits with a hit batsman, four walks, and six strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Kaufman has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. This is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
