INDY BITS

ABOUT TUESDAY NIGHT: The Indianapolis Indians were defeated, 2-1, by the Iowa Cubs on Opening Night at Victory Field. It marked Indy's fourth consecutive home-opener loss since last winning, 4-3, vs. Toledo on May 11, 2021. The Indians took a 1-0 lead in the third inning on an RBI groundout from Matt Gorski that scored Nick Yorke. The Indians took that lead into the ninth inning before Iowa's Chase Stumpf drew a bases-loaded walk to tie the game. The following batter, Christian Franklin, grounded into a reverse double play that scored the go-ahead run on the ensuing rundown between second and third base. The Indians had a chance to extend the game but stranded the tying run at second base to conclude the night. Seven of nine players in Indy's starting lineup recorded a hit, with Bryce Johnson's second-inning double tallying the team's lone extra-base hit. Six different Indians recorded a walk and the first four in the batting order recorded both a hit and a walk. Starting pitcher Mike Burrows blanked the Cubs across 3.2 innings in his season debut, allowing three hits and no walks with four strikeouts. Newly-acquired reliever Chase Shugart shined out of the bullpen, allowing just two walks with three strikeouts across 2.0 scoreless frames.

TWO FOR ONE: With the Indians game postponed due to inclement weather last night, there will be a split doubleheader with two seven-inning games today. Game one's first pitch is scheduled for 12:35 PM ET and game two begins at its regularly scheduled time of 6:35 PM. Game one features Minor League Baseball's Free Game of the Day, where right-hander and Pirates top prospect (MLB No. 15) Bubba Chandler makes his season debut against Cubs prospects. Last season, the Indians finished with a 13-5 record against the Cubs, posting a 4-2 record at home and 9-3 mark at Iowa. The road victories were highlighted by a six-game sweep of the Cubs from July 23-28, marking the Indians first-ever sweep (4+ games) against the Iowa dating back to 1988 and the team's first-ever six-game sweep under Minor League Baseball's weekly schedule format that began in 2021.

DOUBLE BUBBA: Bubba Chandler is set to make his season debut in game one today and it marks his first career start against Iowa. In seven starts with the Indians last season, Chandler went 4-0 with a 1.83 ERA (8er/39.1ip), 54 strikeouts, .183 opponent average (26-for-142) and a 1.04 WHIP. Opposite Chandler is right-hander Caleb Kilian who also makes his season debut. Kilian made two appearances against the Indians last season, allowing a season-high six earned runs across 1.2 innings on July 23 and posting 3.0 shutout frames on July 28 later in the series.

HONE THE 'CRAFT: Right-hander Braxton Ashcraft starts game two for the Indians tonight, making his second start of the season. On Opening Day in St. Paul on March 28, Ashcraft surrendered three runs across 3.1 innings with five strikeouts in the loss. He made one career start vs. Iowa on June 16, 2024 and did not factor into the decision, tossing 4.1 shutout innings on three hits, three walks and four strikeouts. Starting for the Cubs in game two is right-hander Cade Horton, the organization's No. 2 and Minor League Baseball's No. 50 overall prospect. Horton makes his season debut and second career start opposite Indianapolis, last tossing 5.0 innings of two-run ball against the club at Iowa on May 22, 2024.

SOMEONE COOKED HERE: Pittsburgh Pirates No. 12 prospect (*Baseball America*) Billy Cook posted a hit and a walk Tuesday night, reaching base safely in three of his nine plate appearances this season. He roped a ninth-inning double Friday night at St. Paul for the Indians lone extra-base hit in the contest. Cook spent most of the 2024 season in Triple-A, split between Triple-A Norfolk and Indianapolis after being traded to Pittsburgh from Baltimore at the deadline. In 100 total games, he hit .278 (102-for-367) with 61 runs, 22 doubles, three triples, 16 home runs, 64 RBI and a .862 OPS. Cook also showed off in the field on Friday, beginning a relay that caught Ryan Fitzgerald trying to score at home in the fourth inning.

ONLY UP FROM HERE: Friday's 11-run loss to St. Paul was Indy's largest margin of defeat on Opening Day since losing to Toledo at Victory Field, 16-5, in 2009. The Indians have been shut out in the season opener three times since 1997 – in 2016 at Columbus, 2015 vs. Columbus and 2008 at Pawtucket. It was their fourth straight loss on Opening Day since 2022 and their ninth loss in 14 Opening Day contests on the road in the Victory Field era. Friday was also just the second time the two teams have faced off on Opening Day, with the last season lidlifter coming on April 18, 1940, at Perry Stadium at 1501 West 16th St. in Indianapolis. In that contest, the Indians trailed 2-0 in the top of the first before scoring three unanswered runs to take a 3-2 victory.

ABOUT LAST SEASON: Behind third-year manager Miguel Perez, the Indianapolis Indians finished with a 77-70 record in 2024 for the sixth-best record in the 20-team International League and their first winning record since 2018. It was a tale of two halves as the Indians posted a 33-40 record in the first half and a 44-30 record in the second half, finishing third in the IL second-half standings, 4.0 games behind the first-place Columbus Clippers after making a playoff run late into August. The full-season winning record was their 10th in 19 seasons as the Pittsburgh Pirates' Triple-A affiliate dating back to 2005. The Indians went 45-31 at Victory Field, marking their best home record since posting a 44-27 mark in 2017 and the highest home win total since 48 victories in 2012. Since moving to the ballpark at the corner of West and Maryland in 1996, the Indians have finished with a winning record in 21 of 28 campaigns.

YOUNG BUCS: Six prospects ranked among the Pirates top 30 according to MLB Pipeline began the season in Triple-A, led by right-hander Bubba Chandler as the organization's No. 1 (MLB's No. 15) overall farmhand. It marks the second consecutive year that the Pirates top prospect will begin the season with the Indians, following right-hander and 2024 MLB Rookie of the Year Paul Skenes. Other prospects on the 2025 Opening Day roster include utilityman Nick Yorke (No. 5), Opening Day starter and right-hander Braxton Ashcraft (No. 6), right-hander Mike Burrows (No. 15), infielder Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 17) and outfielder Billy Cook (No. 18). Last season, the Indians featured six of the Pirates top 30 prospects (according to *Baseball America*).

ON THIS DATE IN 2003: On Opening Day in Columbus, right fielder Mark Budzinski went 4-for-4 with two RBI, one run and a stolen base while batting leadoff in Indy's 8-4 win.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Bubba Chandler: Right-hander Bubba Chandler is set to make his season debut tonight vs. Iowa. He is currently rated the No. 15 overall prospect in Minor League Baseball according to MLB Pipeline and is the Pirates No. 1. He made seven starts for the Indians last year posting a 1.83 ERA (8er/39.1ip) with 54 strikeouts. He struck out eight-plus batters in four of those seven starts, reached the double digit mark in strikeouts twice and matched a career high with 11 strikeouts on Aug. 16, 2024, at St. Paul. Tonight marks his first career start opposite Iowa.

Last Outing: Chandler tossed 5.1 innings of two-run ball with eight strikeouts at St. Paul on Sept. 17, 2024.

IL Pitcher of the Week: Chandler was named the International League Pitcher of the Week for Aug. 5-11, 2024, after tossing 7.0 shutout innings with two hits, one walk and six strikeouts while he secured the win.

EAS Pitcher of the Week: Chandler was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on June 23, 2024, after tossing 7.0 shutout innings with two hits, one walk and 10 strikeouts while he secured the win.

Miscellaneous: Selected by Pittsburgh in the third round (72nd overall) of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of North Oconee (Bogart, GA.) High School. . Selected to the 2024 All-Star Futures Game and struck out Royals prospect Gavin Cross.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Braxton Ashcraft: The right-hander and Pittsburgh's No. 6 prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

Opening Day Starter: Ashcraft made his second career Opening Day start on March 28 at St. Paul, last doing so on June 14, 2019, with Class-A short season West Virginia.

Last Outing: Ashcraft took the loss allowing three runs across 3.1 innings with a career-high four walks and five strikeouts.

Against the Cubs: Ashcraft made one career start vs. Iowa on June 16, 2024. He did not factor into the decision, tossing 4.1 shutout innings on three hits, three walks and four strikeouts.

Prospectus: Ashcraft enters the 2025 season rated as Pittsburgh's No. 6 prospect according to MLB Pipeline and No. 4 according to *Baseball America*. Since being drafted by the Pirates in 2018, No. 4 is his highest ranking according to *BA*, elevated from No. 10 last season.
