**SATURDAY IN THE PARK:** [The South Bend Cubs beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 11-3 yesterday at Four Winds Field.](#) Felix Stevens homered twice for the Cubs, including a grand slam in the bottom of the sixth inning to give South Bend a 6-3 lead. Wisconsin still leads the series 3-2 with the final game on tap for this afternoon.

**MIKE CHECK:** Mike Boeve was 2-for-3 with a walk and scored Wisconsin's first run of the game. Boeve's on-base streak is at eight as he has reached base in every game this season. Boeve is 11-for-24 with nine walks, an OBP of .588 and an OPS of 1.088.

**EARLY ADVANTAGE:** The Timber Rattlers had a 3-0 lead after they scored three runs in the top of the fourth inning. Jesús Chirinos drove in Boeve with a sacrifice fly. Gregory Barrios scored on a balk for the second run. Eduarqui Fernández doubled with two outs to knock in the final run of the frame.

**IN CONTROL AT FIRST:** Alexander Cornielle retired the first nine batters in a row and twelve of the first thirteen. Cornielle struck out seven over five innings.

**RADIO SILENT:** Boeve singled with two outs in the top of the fifth inning to knock South Bend starting pitcher Luis Devers out of the game. The Cubs bullpen retired the final thirteen Timber Rattlers hitters in a row to close out the game.

**SIDEWAYS:** Stevens homered on the first pitch of the fifth inning. The Cubs added a run in the inning on a two-out single by Reivaj Garcia to pull to within 3-2. In the bottom of the sixth, Cornielle walked the lead-off batter and gave up a single. Jake Polancic entered from the Wisconsin bullpen and hit the first batter he faced before Stevens hit his grand slam to put South Bend up 6-3. The Cubs added three more runs in the seventh and two runs in the eighth to pull away from Wisconsin.

**ABOUT SOUTH BEND:** The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. South Bend has won Midwest League titles in 1989, 1993, 2005, 2019, and 2022. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, Carlos Gonzalez, and current Timber Rattlers manager Victor Estevez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982. Nick Lovullo, the son of Arizona Diamondbacks manager Torey Lovullo, is in his first year as South Bend's manager.

**ABOUT THE CUBS:** The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, and Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP EDWIN JIMENEZ:** Milwaukee signed Jimenez as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on October 11, 2018.

**HEADING TO THE CO-OP:** Jimenez was assigned to the Dominican Summer League Co-op team shared between Milwaukee and Cleveland for the 2019 season. Jimenez was 1-5 with a 3.05 ERA in twelve games – eight starts. He walked 26 and struck out 32 over 41-1/3 innings in his first professional season.

**FROM THE ISLAND TO THE DESERT:** Jimenez started the 2021 season with Milwaukee's number two affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. He was assigned to the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League on August 7, 2021. Jimenez went 1-1 with a 1.72 ERA in five games – four starts – in the DSL and 0-4 with a save and a 5.25 ERA in the ACL. He walked twelve and struck out 48 over 39-2/3 innings combined between his two stops in the system that season.

**THE FULL-SEASON JOURNEY:** Jimenez was 4-7 in 25 games – seventeen starts – with the Carolina Mudcats in 2022. He had a 4.75 ERA, walked 41, and struck out 104 over 113-2/3 innings pitched in the Carolina League last season. Jimenez started the 2023 season with Carolina and went 2-0 in four games – one start – with five walks and 23 strikeouts over eighteen innings before his promotion to Wisconsin on May 2. Once he was a Timber Rattler in 2023, Jimenez was 7-5 with a 4.50 ERA in 21 games – 15 starts – with 93 strikeouts over 102 innings pitched.

**NEAR MISS:** Jimenez was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on July 31, 2023 after a taking a no-hitter into the eighth inning against Cedar Rapids on [July 30](#). He earned the award by striking out ten Kernels over 7-1/3 scoreless innings. Jimenez walked three and didn't allow a hit until there was one out in the eighth inning.

**LAST START:** Jimenez beat Peoria at home on [April 7](#). He allowed three runs on seven hits with three walks and four strikeouts over six innings.

**VS. SOUTH BEND:** Jimenez made two appearances – one start – against the Cubs in 2023. He worked three scoreless, hitless innings with two strikeouts in relief on [May 13 at home](#). Jimenez was the starting pitcher at South Bend in game two of a doubleheader on [August 6](#). Jimenez allowed three runs on six hits with two walks and three strikeouts in four innings to be charged with the loss as the Cubs beat Wisconsin 3-0.

## SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP TYLER SCHLAFFER:** The Chicago Cubs selected Schlaffer in the ninth round of the 2019 draft out of Homewood-Flossmoor Community High School in Flossmoor, Illinois.

**SIGNING OVER SCHOOL:** Schlaffer had committed to pitch for the University of Illinois-Chicago prior to the draft. He signed with the Cubs on August 6, 2019 and was assigned to the Arizona League. Schlaffer made three brief relief appearances in the AZL and had five strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings pitched before the end of that season.

**THE WAITING IS THE HARDEST PART:** Schlaffer did not pitch during the COVID-19 shutdown.

**BACK AT IT:** Schlaffer was on the mound for the Arizona Complex League Cubs when the 2021 season started. He went 2-1 in three starts before a promotion to Myrtle Beach in the Carolina League on July 19. Schlaffer finished the 2021 season with Myrtle Beach and was 2-5 in nine starts with 40 strikeouts over 40-2/3 innings.

**ON THE SHELF:** Schlaffer started his 2022 season with Myrtle Beach and was 4-3 with a 3.82 ERA in eighteen starts before he was promoted to South Bend. Schlaffer made a start for the Cubs on July 27 against Lake County but went on the injured list. He needed Tommy John Surgery and missed all of 2023.

**LAST START:** Schlaffer made his 2024 debut with a start at Quad Cities on [April 7](#). He allowed three hits, hit a batter, walked one, and recorded a strikeout over three scoreless innings for a no decision.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Schlaffer has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers. He last pitched against a Milwaukee Brewers affiliate in 2022 when he made two starts ([June 7](#) and [June 12](#)) at Carolina against the Mudcats. Schlaffer went 1-0 with ten strikeouts and a walk over nine innings pitched in the series. He allowed six runs – five earned – on June 1 and two run – both earned – on June 12.
