ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Mike Jarvis tied the game with a RBI single and Nick Yorke punched a go-ahead single to center field in the ninth inning as the Indianapolis Indians defeated the Syracuse Mets, 6-5, at NBT Bank Stadium on Tuesday night. Trailing, 5-3, Alika Williams led off the ninth inning with a single and Brett Sullivan reached on a fielding error. The pair then executed a double steal to put the tying run in scoring position. Tsung-Che Cheng cut the deficit to one with a run-scoring groundout before Jarvis laced a ball to left field for a 5-5 game. Jarvis stole second base, the Indians' third steal of the inning, and Yorke followed with a single to give them the winning run. Jared Young put the Mets on the board first with a RBI bunt single in the first inning. Cheng doubled home Bowen in the third frame to tie the game, 1-1. Another double from Cheng gave Indy a 3-1 lead in the seventh inning, bringing home Sullivan and Bowen. Luisangel Acuña led the charge in a Syracuse comeback, doubling home a run and coming around to score with a steal of third base and a throwing error by Rafael Flores. With the game knotted, 3-3, a two-run home run from Joey Meneses in the bottom of the eighth inning gave the Mets a 5-3 lead. The Indians then mounted their comeback against Chris Devenski. Hunter Barco tossed 3.0 innings of one-run ball before bridging to the bullpen. Ryder Ryan followed with 3.0 shutout frames. Beau Burrows picked up his first win with Indianapolis, and Cam Sanders blanked Syracuse in the ninth for the win.

CARDIAC KIDS: The Indians tallied their 32nd comeback win of the season last night, the most for the Indians to this point in the season since they also recorded 32 through Aug. 19, 2013. Their comeback win total is tied for the fourth most in the International League this season and is already tied for the seventh most in a single season for the Indians since at least 2005. Indy leads International League clubs this season with a .277 batting average when they are trailing or tied. Indy's pitching staff has contributed by allowing the fourth-fewest hits of any Triple-A staff in the same situation. In addition to this, the Indians also improved to 26-12 in one-run games this season, establishing their highest winning percentage (.684) in one-run games to this point in the season since at least 2015, surpassing their 28-21 record (.571) through Aug. 19, 2015.

EAST COAST CONQUEST: The Indians have scored five or more runs in each of their last seven games dating back to the first day of their East Coast road trip on Aug. 12 at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. The streak matches the Indians' longest of the season from April 13-20 and is tied with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre for the longest active streak in the International League. The Indians' offense is hitting .273 with a .758 OPS across this stretch and has racked up the third-most hits (70) among International League teams.

BARC'ING UP THE WRONG TREE: Hunter Barco tossed his third straight start with one run or less allowed since Aug. 7 vs. Omaha. In that span, he's held opponents to a 0.91 WHIP and a .200 batting average (8-for-40) while racking up 13 strikeouts, allowing just one extra-base hit and ranking among Triple-A pitchers (min. 10.0ip) in ERA (5th, 0.82, 1er/11.1ip) and opponent's OPS (6th, .463). He lowered his opponent's batting average in the second half to .197 (30-for-152) and improved his second-half ERA to 2.81 (13er/41.2ip), which rank fourth and sixth respectively among Triple-A pitchers (min. 40.0ip).

I LIKE ALIKA: Alika Williams went 2-for-4 with a triple, a stolen base and a run scored in last night's win. Williams has hit safely in 11 of 13 games in August and in 14 of 17 games since July 26. In August, he is hitting .340 (16-for-47) with two doubles, a triple, four homers and nine RBI while ranking among International League hitters in slugging percentage (T-5th, .681) and OPS (7th, 1.088). Williams' four home runs and seven extra-base hits each mark his most in a calendar month since he recorded four homers and 10 extra-base hits in July 2023 with Indy.

CHA CHENG: Tsung-Che Cheng went 2-for-4 with two doubles and four RBI last night, matching single-game career highs in both extra-base hits and RBI. It's the first time he has recorded multiple extra-base hits in a Triple-A game. He last did so on July 4, 2024, vs. Double-A Harrisburg. It's the second time he's recorded four RBI in a game this season (also: 7/4/25 vs. LOU), the seventh time in his career and the first time he's done so twice in a single season since 2023 between High-A Greensboro (5/19 @ ASH) and Double-A Altoona (9/3 @ ERI).

BB-BOWEN: Jase Bowen has reached base safely in all 10 games he has played with Indy since Aug. 7 and has drawn a walk in each of his last seven contests since Aug. 12. Bowen's seven-game walk streak is the longest by an Indian since Chris Owings drew a free pass in seven games from Sept. 12-21, 2023. With a walk tonight, he would establish the longest streak of games with a walk since Canaan Smith-Njigba's eight-game run from April 29-May 8. Since debuting with Indy, Bowen is hitting .273 (9-for-33) with two doubles, a home run, three RBI, a .400 on-base percentage and a .824 OPS.

COLONEL SANDERS: Cam Sanders tossed a scoreless ninth with one punchout last night, notching his third save of the season and the eighth of his Triple-A career. Sanders has not allowed a run in 10 of 11 appearances with Indy since July 2. In that stretch, he has pitched to a 1.35 ERA (2er/13.1ip) with a 0.90 WHIP while ranking third among Triple-A pitchers (min. 10.0ip) in opponent's batting average (.114, 5-for-44). Last night marked Sanders' second appearance with the Indians since having his contract selected by the Pirates on Aug. 5. He made his MLB debut the same day at San Francisco, tossing 2.0 scoreless innings and fanning two batters, including Christian Koss, his first major league strikeout victim. Four of Sanders' five appearances with Pittsburgh were scoreless.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians and Syracuse Mets meet in Game 2 of their six-game set at NBT Bank Stadium tonight at 6:35 PM. A win tonight would snap a string of three straight losses in the second game of a series for Indy since July 30. Tonight's pitching matchup features a pair of southpaws with Nick Dombkowski set to make his 21st appearance and sixth start of the season for Indy across from Mets' starter and former Indian (2018-19) Brandon Waddell. This will mark Dombkowski's first appearance against Syracuse. Waddell has made two relief appearances against the Indians since his departure, both with Memphis in 2021, and has pitched to a 2.25 ERA (1er/4.0ip) with four strikeouts.

ON THIS DATE IN 2004: Right-handed pitcher Ben Hendrickson pitched his second complete game of the season, the team's fourth and the Indians' first 9.0-inning complete game since 2002 in a 1-0 shutout over Toledo at Victory Field. Indianapolis' last 9.0-inning complete-game shutout came on June 26, 2002, when Tim Harikkala went the distance at Durham. In his 10th of 11 wins on the season, Hendrickson allowed just two hits, one walk and struck out six.
