**LAST ACTION:** [The Wisconsin beat the Great Lakes Loons 7-3 at Neuroscience Group Field on Sunday afternoon.](#) Tayden Hall got the Rattlers on the board with a solo homer in the second inning and Daniel Dickinson tied the game 2-2 on an RBI double in the third. Luis Castillo gave the Rattler the lead with an RBI single and Adrick Nava added a sacrifice fly in the fourth. Braylon Payne provided insurance with a three-run home run in the fifth inning. Jayden Dubanewicz allowed three runs over five innings with five strikeouts for the win in his Midwest League debut. Quinton Low (3IP) and Garrett Hodges (IP) tossed four innings of shutout relief to close out the game. The Rattlers took four of six in the series from the Loons.

**SO LONG & THANKS FOR THE FISH!** The Milwaukee Brewers announced the promotion of Andrew Fischer to Biloxi on Monday. Fischer hit 20 homers, drove in 50 runs, and finished his Timber Rattlers career with a 30-game on-base streak. He is one of eight Timber Rattlers hitters to reach twenty home runs in a season. Fischer led the MWL in homers, total bases (129), and OPS (1.118)

**BIG JOSH:** Milwaukee also announced the promotion of Josh Adamczewski to Biloxi on Monday. Adamczewski was second in the league in average (.331), OBP (.464), and third in OPS (.1.036). Adamczewski and Fischer were tied for the most multi-hit games by a Rattler this season (16).

**BIG WOO:** Milwaukee Brewers pitcher Brandon Woodruff will make a rehabilitation start tonight for the Timber Rattlers.

**HE GETS ON BASE:** Josiah Ragsdale went 0-for-3 and was hit by a pitch in the fifth inning to extend his on-base streak to 21 games. He stole second and third and scored on Payne's home run in the fifth, too. Ragsdale is 28-for-76 (.368) with sixteen walks, eighteen runs scored, and an OBP of .484 during the streak.

**ABOUT QUAD CITIES:** The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

**ABOUT THE ROYALS:** The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

# STARTING PITCHERS

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED RELIEVER:

**RHP BRAYLON OWENS:** The Milwaukee Brewers selected Owens in the tenth round of the 2025 draft out of the University of Texas-San Antonio.

**FOUR SEASONS AS A ROADRUNNER:** Owens spent all four seasons of his college career at UTSA. He was 14-7 with four saves and a 4.76 ERA in 63 games – 22 starts – in college. Owens had 196 strikeouts in 181-2/3 innings at Texas-San Antonio.

**VICTORIAN AGE:** Owens pitched three summers for the Victoria Generals of the Texas Collegiate League and went 10-1 with a 2.76 ERA in eighteen games – fourteen starts with the Generals.

**NO PRO:** Owens did not pitch professionally after signing with the Brewers. He was 7-2 with three saves in 21 games – fourteen starts – as he helped the Roadrunners make the NCAA tournament and advance to a Super Regional against the UCLA Bruins in his final season.

**NAILED IT DOWN:** Owens earned the save against Texas in the Austin Regional on [May 31, 2025](#). He allowed a run on a hit with seven strikeouts over the final four innings to lock down a 9-7 win over the Longhorns. Owens was named to the All-Regional Team for his performance.

**A MAJOR AWARD:** The Brewers named Owens as their Minor League Pitcher of the Month for May.

**LAST START:** Owens had a no decision against Great Lakes at home on [June 9](#). He allowed five runs – four earned – on six hits with three walks and five strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings.

**VS. QUAD CITIES:** Owens is 1-0 in three games – one start – against the River Bandits this season. He won in relief at Modern Woodmen Park on [April 7](#) and had no decisions as a starter on the road on in game two of a doubleheader on [April 12](#) and as a reliever at home on [May 1](#). Owens has allowed four runs on eight hits with six walks and 24 strikeouts over 13-1/3 innings against Quad Cities.

## QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP CORY RONAN:** The Kansas City Royals signed Ronan as a Non-Drafted Free Agent on July 21, 2025. Ronan had been pitching for the Mahoning Valley Scrappers of the MLB Draft league after his junior season at the University of Hawaii.

**I'VE BEEN EVERYWHERE, MAN:** Ronan, a native of Jacksonville, Illinois, pitched three seasons of college baseball at the University of Hawaii. He was 5-3 with a save and a 4.87 ERA in 35 games – ten starts – and had 64 strikeouts in 57-1/3 innings for the Rainbow Warriors. Ronan pitched for the Eau Claire Express of the Northwoods League in 2022 and 2023 with a 4-3 record in thirteen games – ten starts. The West Virginia Black Bears of the MLB Draft League were Ronan's team in 2024, and he was 1-2 in seven starts. As a Scrapper in 2025, Ronan was 1-1 in four games before signing with the Royals.

**LAST YEAR:** Ronan made his pro debut with the Quad Cities River Bandits and had no record with no runs, no walks, and five strikeouts in three innings over two games.

**LAST START:** Ronan made his first professional start on [June 5](#) at South Bend. He allowed three runs on four hits with two walks and three strikeouts over 1-2/3 innings for a no decision.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Ronan had a no decision at Beloit on [June 13](#). He pitched a perfect inning with two strikeouts.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Ronan is 2-0 in four relief appearances against the Timber Rattlers this season. He has allowed two runs on four hits and four walks with four strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings.
