ABOUT LAST NIGHT: <u>The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers</u> beat the South Bend Cubs 4-2 at Four Winds Field.

Cameron Wagoner allowed one run over six innings and struck out seven for the win. Eduardo García had two hits, including an RBI triple, and scored two runs while Alex Hall added three hits and an RBI for the offense. The series is even at one win for each team. **QUALITY IS JOB ONE:** Wagoner pitched six innings in a game as a professional for the first time in his career and earned his first quality start, too. Wagoner allowed three hits and a run in the first two innings, but nothing else after that. He is 2-1 in his last three starts. **TRIPLE DECKER:** García's RBI triple in the fourth

inning broke a 1-1 tie to give the Rattlers a lead they would never relinquish. That triple was also Wisconsin's first three-base hit since July 6 when Jose Acosta tripled against Beloit on July 6.

BIG SAM: Wisconsin reliever Sam Gardner pitched a scoreless seventh and a scoreless eighth. He left the game with two on and no outs in the bottom of the ninth with only one of those runs scoring. That was the first run scored against Gardner since July 6 against Beloit. He had gone thirteen innings over six appearances between giving up a run.

SHEARING THE SHEEP: Tanner Shears took over for Gardner in the ninth and – despite a walk, two wild pitches, and allowing an inherited run to score – picked up his fifth save of the season thanks to a flyout and back-to-back strikeouts to end the game with the winning run at the plate. Shears is 2-0 with a save and eight strikeouts over three innings in his last three appearances.

ROLL OUT THE WELCOME MAT: Wisconsin has added Bradley Blalock and Brock Wilken in the last two days. Blalock, a pitcher, was picked up from the Greenville Drive after Luís Urías was traded to the Boston Red Sox. ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. They are the defending Midwest League Champions after finishing 73-58 last season, beating Cedar Rapids in the Western Division Finals, and Lake County in the Championship Series. South Bend also won Midwest League pennants in 1989, 1993, 2005, and 2019. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, and Carlos Gonzalez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, and Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

SEASON SO FAR: South Bend went 30-35 in the first half and finished in fourth place in the West Division, 9-1/2 games behind the Cedar Rapids Kernels. The Cubs went 2-8 in the last ten games of the first half. The Cubs were in Peoria before this series started and won the first four games of the series before dropping the final two games to the Chiefs at Dozer Park.

THAT CHAMPIONSHIP SEASON: South Bend won the second half West Division title in 2022 with a 39-26 record 5-1/2 games in front of the Timber Rattlers. The Cubs beat Cedar Rapids 2-1 in the best-of-three West Final and Lake County 2-1 in the best-of-three Championship Series. PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places

five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Robert Moore (#8), Hendry Mendez (#13), Bradley Blalock (#15), Eduardo García (#20), and Matthew Wood (#25). Eric Brown Jr (#6) and Joseph Hernandez (#25) are currently on Wisconsin's IL. <u>MLB Pipeline</u> has five active South Bend players on their list of Cubs prospects: Kevin Alcántara (#4), James Triantos (#11), Michael Arias (#13), Moises Ballesteros (#18), and Ed Howard (#22).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ALEXANDER CORNIELLE: Milwaukee signed Cornielle as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on June 15, 2019.

FAST DEBUT: Cornielle made his professional debut with one inning of relief against the Cubs #2 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League on August 2, 2019. He allowed one run on no hits with two walks in one inning. Cornielle made three appearances in the DSL in 2019 with no record and one run allowed over four innings.

HIT PLAY: Cornielle started the 2021 season with the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and was 4-2 in nine games – four starts – with a 4.64 ERA and 50 strikeouts over 33 innings pitched. He was called up to Carolina at the end of the season and was 0-1 in two starts with ten strikeouts in eight innings.

WEEKLY AWARD: Cornielle was named the ACL's Pitcher of the Week on September 6, 2021 after his performance against the White Sox on August 31, 2021. He allowed one run on one hit and two walks with six strikeouts over five innings in the game.

FEELING 2022: Cornielle was 9-7 in 22 games – 19 starts – with a 3.19 ERA and 124 strikeouts over 101-2/3 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats this season before joining the Timber Rattlers on August 23. He was second in the Carolina League in strikeouts and third in the Carolina League in ERA before his promotion to Wisconsin. Cornielle was 1-0 in three starts with Wisconsin and allowed four runs with six walks and 21 strikeouts over 17-1/3 innings pitched.

LAST START: Cornielle had a no decision at Dayton on <u>July 20</u>. He allowed two runs – one earned – on four hits with four walks and four strikeouts over four innings.

LAST APPEARANCE: Cornielle came on in relief of Brandon Woodruff at home on <u>July 27</u> against the Cedar Rapids Kernels. Cornielle allowed an unearned run on three hits with a walk and seven strikeouts over five innings. He was not involved in the decision.

VS. SOUTH BEND: Cornielle was the starting pitcher against the Cubs at home on May 12. He allowed five runs on four hits with two walks and eight strikeouts but was not involved in the decision.

SOUTH BEND SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP BRANDON BIRDSELL: The Cubs selected Birdsell in the fifth round of the 2022 draft out of Texas Tech.

GETTING TECHNICAL: Birdsell was 9-3 with a 2.75 ERA in fifteen starts in his final season at Texas Tech. He walked 29 and struck out 106 over 85 innings and was named the Big 12 Pitcher of the Year. Birdsell pitched two seasons for Texas Tech was 13-4 with a 2.84 ERA and 142 strikeouts over 120-1/3 innings.

SEARCHING FOR A HOME: Birdsell began his collegiate career at Texas A&M in 2019 and transferred to San Jacinto Junior College for the 2020 season before going to Texas Tech.

DELAYED DEBUT: The Cubs did not have Birdsell pitch in a game as a professional after signing him last season. He made his first pro appearance with three scoreless, hitless innings as a reliever <u>at Quad</u> <u>Cities on April 9, 2023</u>.

LAST START: Birdsell had a no decision at Peoria on July 28. He allowed a run on four hits with two walks and two strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Birdsell had a no decision at Wisconsin on May 9 in his first appearance against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. He allowed a run on three hits with a walk and a strikeout over four innings.
