LAST ACTION: The West Michigan Whitecaps beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 5-3 at LMCU Ballpark on Sunday afternoon. Jadher Areinamo and Hedbert Pérez homered early for Wisconsin to help the Rattlers take a 3-1 lead. Kevin McGonigle tied the game with a two-run home run in the bottom of the fifth. Max Clark, who homered in the first inning for the Whitecaps, followed with a bunt single, stole second, and scored the go-ahead run on a two-out single by Austin Murr. West Michigan tacked on an insurance run in the seventh inning on a home run by John Peck, West Michigan's third home run of the game.

IT GOES TO ELEVEN! Areinamo is on an elevengame hitting streak after he went 2-for-4 on Sunday. He is 18-for-44 (.409) during the streak. Areinamo has six doubles, two homers, fourteen RBI, and eight runs scored with a 1.131 OPS during the streak. Blake Burke holds the longest hitting streak by a Rattler this season at twelve games.

SO CLOSE: The Rattlers lost the final four games of the series with the Whitecaps, who needed a save from four different pitchers in those games.

ROAD WORK: Wisconsin finished their two-week road trip to Michigan with a 5-6 record. They were 4-2 at Great Lakes and 1-4 with a rainout here against the Whitecaps. The Timber Rattlers are 18-17 on the road this season.

SETTLE IN: Tonight is the start of a six-game series at Neuroscience Group Field against the Quad Cities River Bandits. Wisconsin plays fifteen of their next eighteen games at home. The Rattlers were 16-17 at home in the first half.

WHAT'S AT STAKE? Quad Cities and the Rattlers both missed on the West Division Playoff spot in the first half. They will play eighteen times in the second half of the season. Additionally, the teams split the sixgame series at Modern Woodmen Park in April. The winner of this series will take the lead in the season series

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

#### WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP ANTHONY FLORES:** The Milwaukee Brewers signed Flores as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on June 4, 2022.

**ON AN ISLAND:** Flores pitched the 2022 and 2023 season in the Dominican Summer League. He combined to go 3-8 with a 4.42 ERA and 87 strikeouts over 79-1/3 innings in 22 games – eighteen starts.

**COMING TO AMERICA:** Flores made twelve appearances in the Arizona Complex League and seven appearances with the Carolina Mudcats in 2024. He combined to go 5-4 with a 5.17 ERA and 85 strikeouts and 27 walks over 69-2/3 innings.

**LAST START:** Flores lost at West Michigan on <u>June 19</u>. He allowed five runs on eight hits with no walks and three strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Flores made a relief appearance at Quad Cities on April 11. He was charged with a blown save and a loss as he allowed two runs on four hits with a walk and five strikeouts over three innings in a 2-1 River Bandits victory.

#### QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JOSH HANSELL: The Royals selected Hansell in the sixteenth round of the 2023 draft out of Arizona State University.

HE'S FROM EVERYWHERE: Hansell started his collegiate career at Wichita State in 2021. He transferred to Arizona State in 2022 with a trip to Alaska to play for the Anchorage Bucs in the Alaskan Summer League in 2022 before returning to Arizona State for 2023. In his final season at ASU, Hansell was 2-1 with a 7.47 ERA in seventeen games – four starts.

**LIKE FATHER; LIKE SON:** Hansell is the son of Greg Hansell, who made a total of 106 relief appearances in the Major Leagues with the Los Angeles Dodgers, Minnesota Twins, Milwaukee Brewers, and Pittsburgh Pirates. Greg Hansell also pitched three seasons for the Hanshin Tigers of the Japanese Central League from 2000 to 2002.

**MOVING ON UP:** Hansell started his pro career with the ACL Royals with two brief relief appearances in 2023. He was in Columbia in 2024 and was 4-2 with a save and a 2.52 ERA in 21 games – six starts – for the Fireflies. Hansell was back in Columbia to start the 2025 season and was 1-2 with a 4.73 ERA in eight starts before a promotion to Quad Cities on May 20.

**LAST START:** Hansell had a no decision at home against Lansing on June 18. He allowed a run on five hits with three walks and a strikeout over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Hansell has never faced the Timber Rattlers before tonight. He made a start against the Carolina Mudcats, the Carolina League affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers on April 24. Hansell allowed an unearned run on seven hits with a walk and seven strikeouts over five innings for a no decision.
