**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** [The Quad Cities River Bandits beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 11-1 at Modern Woodmen Park.](#) Quad Cities scored five runs in the first inning and added six runs in the seventh. The Timber Rattlers had four hits, committed four errors, and hit into three double plays.

**EARLY DEFICIT:** Blake Mitchell hit a two-run home run as the second batter of the game. Ramon Ramirez followed with a solo home run and Wisconsin went down 3-0 three batters into the game.

**A BIT EXCESSIVE:** The first six River Bandits to the plate in the bottom of the seventh reached base and all six scored. Quad Cities was 0-for-16 with sixteen runners left on base in the first two games of the series. Last night they were 6-for-14 with runners in scoring position.

**TRENDING:** Wisconsin did not commit an error in the first three games of the season. They have been charged with seven errors in the last two games.

**STREAKING:** Marco Dinges singled in the fourth inning to extend his hitting streak to four games – 4-for-12, .333. Eric Bitonti walked in the fourth inning to extend his on-base streak to five games 3-for-16, 3 walks, .316 OBP

**RALLY KILLERS:** The Timber Rattlers had a run in with runners at first and second with one out in the top of the second inning. The River Bandits got an inning-ending 4-6-3 double play off the bat of David Garcia. In the third inning, Daniel Garcia was at first with one out and was running on a pitch to Andrew Fischer, who hit a fly ball to left. Garcia did not get back to first in time for a 7-3 double play. In the top of the seventh, there were runners on first and second with one out when Garcia hit into a 3-6-1 double play.

**STOPPED:** Wisconsin's winning streak ended at three games with last night's loss. The Timber Rattlers longest winning streak in 2025 was four games and they achieved it three times.

**ABOUT QUAD CITIES:** The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

**ABOUT THE ROYALS:** The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

# PITCHING MATCHUPS

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP BRYCE MECCAGE:** The Milwaukee Brewers selected Meccage in the second round of the 2024 draft out of The Pennington School in New Jersey

**FAMILY TIES:** Meccage is the son of Jeremy Meccage, the former Pitching Coach at Princeton University and the nephew of Justin Meccage, current pitching coach of the San Francisco Giants.

**GOING PRO:** Meccage signed with Milwaukee over a college commitment to the University of Virginia.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** Meccage is rated as the #21 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline. *Baseball America* has placed him at #26 in their rankings of Brewers prospects.

**CAROLINA ON MY MIND:** Meccage made his professional debut with the Carolina Mudcats in 2025. He was 1-4 with a 4.35 ERA in nineteen starts. Meccage walked 26 and struck out 69 over 70-1/3 innings.

**LAST START:** Meccage had a no decision in game one of a doubleheader against Beloit at home on [April 4](#) in the season opening game for his Midwest League debut. He allowed three runs on three hits with five walks and a strikeout over 2-2/3 innings.

**VS. QUAD CITIES:** Meccage has never faced the River Bandits prior to this evening. He made two starts against the Columbia Fireflies – the Carolina League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals – in 2025 ([April 24](#) and [June 18](#)). He allowed two runs on six hits with two walks and eight strikeouts over 10-1/3 innings without a decision.

## QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP AIDEN JIMENEZ:** The Royals selected Jimenez in the fifth round of the 2025 draft out of the University of Arkansas.

**THE COLLEGE JOURNEY:** Jimenez pitched for Oregon State University – mainly as a reliever – in 2023. He was 5-2 with a save, a 5.68 ERA and 35 strikeouts in 38 innings over 22 games – one start. During the summer of 2023, Jimenez pitched for Chatham in the Cape Cod League. He transferred to Arkansas for the 2025 season and was 4-1 with a save and a 3.40 ERA. Jimenez struck out 40 in 42-1/3 innings in 22 games – two starts.

**NO PRO:** Jimenez did not pitch professionally after signing with the Royals.

**LAST START:** Jimenez had a no decision against North Dakota State in a game at Arkansas on May 30, 2025. He allowed two runs on five hits with four walks and three strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Jimenez has never pitched against the Rattlers. This is his first appearance against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
