**LAST ACTION:** [The Quad Cities River Bandits beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 12-3 at Neuroscience Group Field on Sunday afternoon.](#) Eric Bitonti tied the game 1-1 with a solo home run in the second inning. An error after a double by Josiah Ragsdale allowed Daniel Dickinson to score for a 2-1 lead. The River Bandits scored three runs in the fourth and three in the fifth to take the lead. Quad Cities added two runs in the seventh, two in the eighth, and one in the ninth to pull away from the Rattlers. Derlin Figueroa and Asbel Gonzalez both had two homers in the game for Quad Cities. The Bandits won four of the six games in the series.

**HOME RUN NOTES:** Quad Cities hit eleven home runs in the six-game series. They have hit seventeen home runs in their twelve games against the Rattlers this season.

**SERIES NOTES:** Quad Cities outscored the Timber Rattler 51-23 in the series. Wisconsin's two wins in the series were both by one run.

**POWER UP:** Bitonti's homer was Wisconsin's 32<sup>nd</sup> of the season. The Timber Rattlers are tied with Lake County and Cedar Rapids for the most home runs in the Midwest League this season. Bitonti has four home runs this season.

**MULTI-BALL:** Josh Adamczewski had two hits, a walk, and an RBI on Sunday. He has eight multi-hit games this season to lead the Rattlers in that category. Ragsdale also had two hits in the game, his fifth multi-hit game of the season.

**FIRST TIME:** The Timber Rattlers lost a series for the first time this season with Sunday's loss.

**WE'LL MEET AGAIN:** Wisconsin has a half game lead over the River Bandits in the West Division standings. Wisconsin and Quad Cities are even through twelve games with six win for both teams. They will play again at Modern Woodmen Park from June 16 to 21. The games on June 16, 17, & 18 are the final three games of the first half of the season.

**ABOUT PEORIA:** The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, Yadier Molina, Nolan Gorman, and Victor Scott II.

**ABOUT THE CARDINALS:** St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

[MLB Pipeline](#) has five Peoria players on their list of Top 30 Cardinals prospects: Rainiel Rodriguez (#3), Tanner Franklin (#11), Yhoiker Fajardo (#13), Tai Peete (#18), and Jesús Báez (#20). There are three of Pipeline's Top 100 prospects in this series: Peña (#20), Rodriguez (#31), and Fischer (#88).

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP CHANDLER WELCH:** The Milwaukee Brewers selected Welch in the sixth round of the 2024 draft out of Tulane University.

**CATCH A GREEN WAVE:** Welch pitched three seasons at Tulane. He was 15-13 with three saves and a 5.42 ERA in 67 games – 29 starts in college. Welch had 204 strikeouts over 199-1/3 innings with Tulane. As a junior – his final season of college baseball, Welch was 7-4 with a 4.65 ERA. In his final collegiate start, Welch was the starting pitcher for Tulane against Oregon State in the NCAA Regional at Corvallis on [May 31, 2024](#). He allowed six runs on seven hits with two walks and a strikeout over four innings against the Beavers.

**CHAMPIONS:** Tulane won the AAC Conference Tournament in Welch's sophomore and junior seasons.

**LET'S GET IT STARTED:** Milwaukee assigned Welch to Carolina on September 8, 2024 and he made his pro debut for the Mudcats against Delmarva. He was transferred to Wisconsin and made a relief appearance in the playoffs against Lake County.

**LAST YEAR:** Welch started the 2025 season with Wisconsin and went 0-3 with a 5.85 ERA in seven starts. The Brewers sent him to Carolina on May 15 where he was 0-3 with a 5.91 ERA in five starts before he was placed on the injured list on June 18 to end his season.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Welch had a no decision against Quad Cities with three innings of scoreless relief on [April 30](#) at home. He allowed three walks, no hits, and struck out four.

**LAST START:** Welch lost at Lynchburg on [June 14, 2025](#). He allowed six runs on nine hits with three walks and two strikeouts over five innings.

**VS. PEORIA:** Welch won in relief against the Chiefs at home on [April 18, 2026](#) when he allowed two runs on one hit over two innings. He made a start on [May 7, 2025](#) at Dozer Park and allowed three runs – two earned – on five hits and seven walks over 5-1/3 innings.

## PEORIA STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP LEONEL SEQUERA:** The St. Louis Cardinals signed Sequera as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on January 15, 2022.

**IT'S COMPLEX:** Sequera started his professional career in the Dominican Summer League at the age of sixteen. He moved to the Florida Complex League in 2023 and began the 2024 season in the FCL.

**UP A LEVEL:** Sequera was bumped up to the Palm Beach Cardinals on July 25, 2024 for his debut with a full-season team. He made seven appearances – six starts – for Palm Beach and went 1-0 with a 2.13 ERA

**LAST YEAR:** Sequera spent the entire 2025 season with Palm Beach. He went 5-10 with a 4.22 ERA in 24 starts. Sequera struck out 99 and walked 41 in 108 innings.

**LAST START:** Sequera had a no decision at Great Lakes on [April 30](#). He allowed three runs – two earned – on six hits with a walk and five strikeouts over four innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Sequera had a no decision at Neuroscience Group Field on [April 16](#). He allowed four runs – two earned – on five hits with two walks and five strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings. Braylon Payne homered off Sequera in the game.
