SATURDAY IN THE PARK: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Fort Wayne TinCaps 6-3](http://TheWisconsinTimberRattlers.com). Wisconsin built a 6-0 lead with two runs in the first, three runs in the third, and a run in the fourth. Russell Smith pitched five scoreless innings, allowed one hit, and struck out seven for the win.

GRAY AREA: Joe Gray Jr was 1-for-3 with a homer, a sacrifice fly, and two RBI on Saturday. Gray is on a six-game hitting streak (7-for-19, .368).

FIRST! Smith's win was his first as a professional. He set a new single-game high as a professional for innings pitched and strikeouts, too.

TAKING THE FIFTH: Wisconsin's lead was cut to three runs and the TinCaps had runners on the corners with no outs in the bottom of the eighth. Cam Robinson entered the game from the bullpen and got a strikeout and a 1-4-3 double play to end the inning. Robinson worked around a pair of two-out walks in the top of the ninth to pick up his fifth save of the season.

ONLY SEVENTEEN: Tristan Peters had an RBI single in the first and a walk in the third to go 1-for-3 on Saturday to move his on-base streak to seventeen games, the longest on the team this year. Colt Keith of West Michigan is on a 23-game on-base streak, the longest in the MWL this season.

WALK 500 MILES: Wes Clarke drew three walks on Saturday. It's the second game in a row for Clarke to be walked three times. He is tied with Corey Rosier for the Midwest League lead in walks. Both players have 23 walks this season. Wisconsin hitters walked seven times on Saturday to give them a total of 34 walks in the first five games of the series.

STARTING STRONG: The five starting pitchers for Wisconsin in this series have allowed one run over 27 innings (ERA = 0.33). Brandon Knarr and TJ Shook each worked six scoreless frames. Smith and Antoine Kelly both pitched five scoreless innings. Justin Jarvis allowed one run over his five innings of work.

ABOUT FORT WAYNE: The Fort Wayne TinCaps franchise started as the Mattoon Indians in Illinois for the 1947 season. That franchise moved to Keokuk, Iowa to become the Keokuk Cardinals from 1958 through 1962. The team moved again to Wisconsin Rapids, Wisconsin for 1963. They were affiliated with the Washington Senators in 1963 and became a Minnesota Twins affiliate after the Major League team moved to Minneapolis for the 1964 season. Wisconsin Rapids moved to Kenosha, Wisconsin for the 1984 season and remained an affiliate of the Twins. Fort Wayne joined the Midwest League after the Kenosha Twins were in 1992 and the franchise moved to Fort Wayne, Indiana for the 1993 season. The team renamed themselves as the Fort Wayne Wizards and stayed an affiliate of the Twins through the 1998 season. Fort Wayne affiliated with the San Diego Padres and has remained in that relationship to this day. There was one more move for the franchise. The team moved from Memorial Stadium to Parkview Field to start the 2009 season. They also changed their name to TinCaps for 2009. The TinCaps won the only MWL Pennant for the Fort Wayne entry of the franchise in 2009. Notable former Fort Wayne players include Torri Hunter, Jake Peavy, AJ Pierzynski, Josh Barfield, LaTroy Hawkins, Corey Kluber, David Freese, and Fernando Tatis Jr.

ABOUT THE PADRES: San Diego's relationship with Midwest League teams began in 1990 when they started an affiliation with the Waterloo Diamonds. That partnership moved to the Springfield Sultans with the Waterloo franchise for 1994. The Padres were the parent club of the Clinton LumberKings from 1995 through 1998 before joining with the Fort Wayne franchise.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP MAX LAZAR: Selected by Milwaukee in the 11th round of the 2017 draft out of Coral Springs (FL) High School.

THE OWLS ARE NOT WHAT THEY SEEM: Lazar signed with the Brewers over a commitment to Florida Atlantic University.

AS A RATTLER IN THE PAST: Lazar was 7-3 with a 2.39 ERA in nineteen games – ten starts – for Wisconsin in 2019. He had 109 strikeouts and just fifteen walks in 79 innings pitched that season.

GET BACK TO WHERE YOU ONCE BELONGED: Lazar missed the 2020 season due to the pandemic and the 2021 season due to injury. He allowed one run on seven hits with no walks and ten strikeouts over seven innings at Peoria on August 20 to pick up the win. Lazar set a new professional single-game for strikeouts and innings pitched in that start.

LAST APPEARANCE: Lazar earned the save with three scoreless innings [against Fort Wayne at home on May 3](#). He allowed two hits, walked none, and struck out two.

LAST START: Lazar had [a no decision at Peoria on April 27](#). He allowed an unearned run on three hits and two walks with no strikeouts over 3-1/3 innings.

VS. FORT WAYNE: Lazar's relief appearance on May 3, 2021 was his first appearance against the TinCaps. It was also his first appearance against an affiliate of the San Diego Padres in his career.

FORT WAYNE SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP ROBERT GASSER: The Padres selected Gasser in the Competitive Balance-B Round with the 71st overall pick of the 2021 draft out of the University of Houston.

STARTING OUT: Gasser was at the University of New Mexico in 2018 to start his college career. He was 2-4 with a 7.05 ERA in 21 games – eleven starts – with 27 walks and 52 strikeouts over 52-1/3 innings.

DELTA HOUSE: Gasser was the ABCA National Junior College Pitcher of the Year in 2019 as a sophomore at San Joaquin Delta (CA) College. He was 14-0 in eighteen games – seventeen starts – with 139 strikeouts and 45 walks in 102 innings pitched.

COUGARTOWN: Gasser spent the abbreviated 2020 season and all of 2021 at the University of Houston. In his final season with the Cougars, Gasser was 6-6 with a 2.63 ERA and 105 strikeouts in 85-2/3 innings pitched.

AS A PRO: Gasser made a one-inning start for the Padres Arizona Complex League after signing with the Padres. He was promoted to Lake Elsinore after that start and made five starts for the Storm in the Low-A West to end the season. Gasser had no record with a 1.29 with two walks and thirteen strikeouts over fourteen innings pitched as a pro in 2021.

LAST START: Gasser lost [to Dayton at home on May 1](#). He allowed four runs on six hits with no walks and nine strikeouts over four innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Gasser has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers prior to this afternoon. This will also be the first time he will face an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
