LAST ACTION: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Peoria Chiefs 4-3 at Dozer Pak on Saturday. Wisconsin scored three runs in the top of the fourth inning to take a 4-1 lead. Peoria scored twice in the bottom of the sixth, but the Rattlers held on for the win to take a 3-2 lead in the series. Jesús Made went 2-for-3 with a walk and a run scored for the Rattlers. Three Wisconsin pitchers walked ten and struck out ten while holding the Chiefs to three runs on three hits and a 2-for-16 performance with runners in scoring position.

WELCOME BACK: Marco Dinges returned to the Wisconsin line up for the first time since his in-game injury against Quad Cities at home on June 29. Dinges went 1-for-2 with two walks, an RBI, and a run scored last night.

THE "W": Ryan Birchard was the winning pitcher for Wisconsin. He allowed one hit, walked five, and struck out three over five innings. He gave up the tying run in the third inning but retired nine of ten batters faced until he gave up a single and a walk to the first two Chiefs in the bottom of the sixth.

CLIFFHANGERS: Aaron Rund took over for Birchard. A throwing error by Dinges allowed a run to score with an RBI double by Ryan Campos pulling the Chiefs to within a run. Peoria loaded the bases with one out in the inning, but Rund escaped the sixth with the lead. In the seventh, Peoria had the tying run at third with one out before Rund escaped the jam again. Yerlin Rodriguez entered in the eighth inning. The Chiefs loaded the bases with no outs on two walks and an error before two strikeouts and a force play at third ended the inning. Peoria got the tying run to second with two outs in the bottom of the ninth. Rodriguez got a strikeout to end the game for his third save of the

IT GOES TO ELEVEN: Rodriguez has not allowed an earned run in a game in his last eleven games. He has walked ten and struck out 21 over 13-1/3 innings during the streak.

ABOUT GREAT LAKES: The Great Lakes Loons came into existence in 2007 after the Midwest League team left Battle Creek, Michigan at the end of the 2006 season. The team in Battle Creek had been known as the Michigan Battle Cats, Battle Creek Yankees, and the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays. The Loons have been affiliated with the Los Angeles Dodgers since 2007. They have made the Midwest League playoffs nine times since 2007. The Loons won the Midwest League title in 2016 and lost to Cedar Rapids in the Midwest League Championship Series in 2023. Notable Great Lakes alumni include Clayton Kershaw, Kenley Jansen, Nathan Eovaldi, Joc Peterson, Julio Urias, Walker Buehler, and Gavin Lux. Jair Fernandez, who played in 52 games with the Timber Rattlers in 2007, is in his second season as the manager of the Loons

ABOUT THE DODGERS: The Los Angeles Dodgers were only in the Midwest League for a few seasons prior to affiliating with the Loons. They were in Dubuque in 1967 and in Clinton from 1977 to 1979. Orel Hershiser and Steve Sax were notable Dodgers to play in Clinton.

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TRAVIS SMITH: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Smith in the fifteenth round of the 2024 draft out of the University of Kentucky.

WILDCAT: Smith pitched two seasons at Kentucky and was 7-7 with a 5.44 ERA and 76 strikeouts over 86 innings in 26 games – nineteen starts.

CAROLINA ON MY MIND: Smith made his pro debut with the Carolina Mudcats in the Carolina League in 2025. He was 4-4 with a 3.20 ERA in nineteen starts. Smith walked twenty and struck out 57 over 76 innings with the Mudcats before his promotion to Wisconsin.

LAST START: Smith had a no decision at Peoria in game one of the series at Dozer Park on <u>August 5</u>. He allowed two runs on three hits with two walks and three strikeouts over four innings.

VS. GREAT LAKES: Smith had never pitched against the Loons prior to tonight. This evening is also his first appearance against an affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers.

GREAT LAKES STARTING PITCHER:

LHP WYATT CROWELL: The Los Angeles Dodgers selected Crowell in the fourth round of the 2023 draft out of Florida State University.

THREE YEARS IN TALLAHASSEE: Crowell was 10-4 with three saves and a 2.15 ERA in 46 games – one start – with the Seminoles from 2021 through 2023.

USA! USA! USA! Crowell pitched for USA Baseball's Collegiate National Team for a tournament in the Netherlands in 2022. He appeared in two games in the tournament.

MAKING THE MILES: Crowell did not pitch professionally in 2023. He started his professional career on the Injured List of the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes before being sent to the Arizona Complex League for a Minor League rehabilitation assignment in May, 2024. Crowell made four brief starts totaling six innings and allowed four runs on two hits and four walks with nine strikeouts with no record for the ACL Dodgers. He was sent to Rancho Cucamonga of the California League on June 21, 2024 and had no record over seven starts while allowing three runs on six hits and eleven walks with 26 strikeouts in 17-1/3 innings. Crowell joined the Loons on August 4, 2024 and has been with them since April 16 this year.

LAST START: Crowell had a no decision against Lansing at home on <u>August 6</u>. He allowed three hits, walked none, and struck out seven over six scoreless innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Crowell is 1-0 in two appearances against Wisconsin – a start on <u>August 23, 2024</u> and a relief outing on <u>June 14, 2025</u>. He has allowed three runs on five hits with four walks and eleven strikeouts over six innings against the Rattlers.
