ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Beloit Sky Carp 4-2 at Neuroscience Group Field.](https://www.wisconsinradio.com/)

Beloit took a 2-0 lead on a two-run home run by Josh Zamora in the second inning. The Timber Rattlers scored single runs in the third, sixth, seventh, and eighth to go in front of the Sky Carp. Wisconsin's pitching combo of Brian Fitzpatrick and Yujanyer Herrera held Beloit to two runs as they scattered nine hits. Fitzpatrick, the starter, set a new single-game high for innings pitched as a pro with five. Herrera pitched through a few issues over four scoreless innings as the reliever to get the win.

TWO-FER: Wisconsin's Dylan O'Rae reached base four times with two singles and two walks. He also stole two bases and scored two runs. O'Rae leads the Midwest League in steals (19), is tied for the league lead in runs (32), and is tied for fifth in walks (26).

WALK THIS WAY: Timber Rattlers hitters drew eight walks last night. In the first four games of the series with Beloit, Wisconsin hitters have walked twenty times. Wisconsin pitchers have only walked nine in the first four games.

DÉJÀ VU: Zamora hit a home run in the second inning of game three for Beloit. The Sky Carp have scored first in the first four games of the series.

PECKING AWAY: Jadher Areinamo doubled to drive in O'Rae in the third inning for Wisconsin's first run. Jheremy Vargas tied the game with an RBI single in the sixth. Tayden Hall beat out an infield single with two outs to score O'Rae in the seventh to give Wisconsin the lead. Luis Lara's sacrifice fly drove in an insurance run in the eighth.

ESCAPE ARTIST: The Sky Carp had runners at second and third in the top of the seventh with the score tied 2-2. Herrera got out of the jam with a line drive to shallow center that was caught by Lara, a strikeout, and a grounder to first.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's third season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Billy Gardner Jr is in his second season as the manager of the Sky Carp. Prince Fielder, Rickie Weeks, Chris Bosio, Greg Vaughn, Joey Meyer, BJ Surhoff, Tim Dillard, and Mitch Stetter played in Beloit.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ALEXANDER CORNIELLE: Milwaukee signed Cornielle as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on June 15, 2019.

FAST DEBUT: Cornielle made his professional debut with one inning of relief against the Cubs #2 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League on August 2, 2019. He allowed one run on no hits with two walks in one inning. Cornielle made three appearances in the DSL in 2019 with no record and one run allowed over four innings.

HIT PLAY: Cornielle started the 2021 season with the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and was 4-2 in nine games – four starts – with a 4.64 ERA and 50 strikeouts over 33 innings pitched. He was called up to Carolina at the end of the season and was 0-1 in two starts with ten strikeouts in eight innings.

WEEKLY AWARDS: Cornielle was named the ACL's Pitcher of the Week on September 6, 2021. He also won the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week Award on September 11, 2023.

BACK IN 2022: Cornielle was 9-7 in 22 games – 19 starts – with a 3.19 ERA and 124 strikeouts over 101-2/3 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats this season before joining the Timber Rattlers on August 23. He was second in the Carolina League in strikeouts and third in the Carolina League in ERA before his promotion to Wisconsin. Cornielle was 1-0 in three starts with 21 strikeouts over 17-1/3 innings pitched.

LAST SEASON: Cornielle was 1-3 in twenty games – eighteen starts – for Wisconsin. He walked 34, struck out 92, and compiled a 4.55 ERA in 89 innings pitched for the Rattlers.

LAST START: Cornielle won at Quad Cities on [May 11](#). He pitched seven scoreless innings with seven strikeouts. Cornielle allowed two hits and walked three.

VS. БЕЛОИТ (2023): Cornielle was 1-0 in four starts against the Sky Carp last season. He allowed seven runs on seventeen hits, walked four, and struck out 24 over 19-2/3 innings pitched versus Beloit in 2023.

БЕЛОИТ STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ІKE BUXTON: The Miami Marlins selected Buxton in the fifteenth round of the 2022 draft out of the Lipscomb University. He is rated as the #27 prospect in the Marlins system by MLB Pipeline.

STARTING OUT IN IDAHO: Buxton began his collegiate career at Boise State University. He was a redshirt in 2019 and made four relief appearances during the shortened 2020 season before transferring to Lipscomb for 2021.

NASHVILLE: Buxton pitched two seasons at Lipscomb. He was 11-8 with a save and a 4.45 ERA in 33 games – 24 starts – in his two seasons for the Bison. In his final season at Lipscomb, Buxton was 7-3 with 66 strikeouts over 74-2/3 innings in fifteen games – fourteen starts.

IT'S COMPLEX: Buxton made three relief appearances with the Marlins affiliate in the FCL after signing with Miami. He walked eight, struck out five, and allowed five runs over 4-2/3 innings as a pro in 2022.

UNDEFEATED IN FLORIDA: Buxton was 4-0 with a 1.62 ERA in twelve games – five starts – with the Jupiter Hammerheads to start the 2023 season. He had walked 25 and struck out 46 in 39 innings before his promotion to Beloit on July 25. Buxton was 2-2 with a 3.71 ERA in seven starts for the Sky Carp after the promotion. He also pitched four scoreless innings as a starter for Pensacola in one game for the Marlins Southern League affiliate.

LAST START: Buxton lost to Peoria at home on [May 11](#). He allowed six unearned runs on three hits with two hit batsmen, a walk, and a strikeout in 2/3 of an inning.

VS. WISCONSIN: Buxton lost to the Timber Rattlers at Beloit on [August 30, 2023](#). He allowed a run on four hits with two walks and seven strikeouts over five innings.
