ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Quad Cities River Bandits beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 9-5 at Neuroscience Group Field. The River Bandits broke a 4-4 tie with five runs in the top of the ninth inning. Wisconsin had a 3-0 lead after two innings. Quad Cities rallied with a run in the third and three in the fourth to take a 4-3 lead. The Rattlers tied the game in the bottom of the sixth.

TOP GUYS! Andrew Fischer and Jesús Made combined for seven hits for the Timber Rattlers. Fischer, the #1 pick of the Milwaukee Brewers in the 2025 draft, went 3-for-4 with two RBI and his first professional homer. Fischer has five multi-hit games out of eleven played with the Rattlers. Made, the #1 prospect of the Brewers, went 4-for-5 with two doubles to collect his second four-hit game of the season. He had four hits in a game with Carolina earlier this season. Made has an OPS of .989 in eighteen games

WELCOME BACK: The Brewers have announced that Luke Adams has been sent to the Timber Rattlers on a Minor League Rehab assignment. Adams last played in a game for the Biloxi on June 19 when he was injured in a collision at the plate. He had been named the Southern League Player of the Week on June 8 and had an OPS of 1.102 in June before the injury. Adams was a member of last year's Timber Rattlers team that won the West Division Title.

DOWN THE STRETCH: Quad Cities picked up ground in the playoff race on both the Beloit Sky Carp and the South Bend Cubs last night as the teams tied for the top spot lost last night. Beloit has the tiebreaker on South Bend. Quad Cities has the tiebreaker on both Beloit and South Bend. The Rattlers loss officially eliminated them from playoff contention.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP RYAN BIRCHARD: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Birchard in the 5^{th} round of the 2023 draft out of the Niagara County Community College.

PLAYER OF THE YEAR: Birchard was named the Western New York Athletic Conference Player of the Year in 2023. He was 8-0 in ten games – nine starts – with a 1.08 ERA and 95 strikeouts over fifty innings pitched. Birchard was also named a First Team All-NJCAA Division III All-American in 2023.

QUICK TRIP TO TRENTON: Birchard made four appearances – two starts – for Trenton in the MLB Draft League after the end of his college season. He allowed one run, walked one, and struck out sixteen over nine innings before signing with Milwaukee.

DELAYED START: Birchard did not pitch professionally in 2023. He made a start for the Carolina Mudcats on April 6, 2024 (4.0IP, H, R, 0ER, 2BB, 6K) but was placed on the IL after that game. He next pitched with the ACL Brewers on July 16 and July 22. Birchard rejoined Carolina for appearances on July 28 and August 3 before being sent to Wisconsin on August 13.

AS A RATTLER (2024): Birchard made five regular season starts for Wisconsin last season. He was 0-3 with an 8.71 ERA. He walked fourteen and struck out thirteen in 10-1/3 innings with the Timber Rattlers.

LAST START: Birchard lost at Beloit on <u>August 22</u>. He allowed three runs on six hits with three walks and five strikeouts over five innings.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Birchard is 0-1 in three starts – May 17, July 3, and July 23 – against the River Bandits this season. He has allowed two runs on eight hits and eleven walks with fifteen strikeouts over thirteen innings.

QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

RHP LOGAN MARTIN: The Kansas City Royals selected Martin in the 12th round of the 2023 draft out of the University of Kentucky.

WILD CAT: Martin was 1-1 in nine games – eight starts – for Kentucky in 2023, his only season at the SEC school. Martin had a 4.44 ERA with 30 strikeouts in 26-1/3 innings.

WHERE DID HE COME FROM? Martin pitched three years at Sewanee: The University of the South, an NCAA Division III school of the Southern Athletic Association in Sewanee, Tennessee before transferring to Kentucky. In 2022, his final season of DIII ball, Martin had 98 strikeouts in 69-1/3 innings with a 1-5 record and a 3.89 ERA.

LAST START: Martin had a no decision at Cedar Rapids in game two of a doubleheader on <u>August 16</u>. He allowed one hit with no walks and two strikeouts over 2-2/3 scoreless innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Martin has made four starts – <u>April 8</u>, <u>April 13</u>, <u>June 26</u>, and <u>July 24</u> – against the Timber Rattlers this season. He is 1-1 and has allowed five runs – three earned – on eleven hits with seven walks and eighteen strikeouts over 17-1/3 innings.
