CIRCLE CITY ROUNDUP

ABOUT SUNDAY: The Indianapolis Indians jumped out to a 2-1 lead but were overcome by a six-run third inning from the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders as they took the series finale, 7-5, at PNC Field on Sunday afternoon. Omar Martinez and Jorbit Vivas each reached on singles for the RailRiders in the third, setting up T.J. Rumfield to smack a three-run shot to take the lead. Spencer Jones, Jose Rojas and Jeimer Candelario each followed with doubles to score two runs and Braden Shewmake plated Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's final run with an RBI single, pushing the lead to 7-2. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre struck first in the second inning as Bryan De La Cruz tripled with one out and Candelario brought him home on a sacrifice fly. The Indians briefly took the lead in their half of the third. Jase Bowen walked, Ji Hwan Bae reached on an error and Nick Solak knocked both in with a two-out double, tagging RailRiders' starter Erick Leal with two unearned runs. The Indians tacked on three runs after the RailRiders' big inning but could not mount a large enough rally to complete the comeback. Matt Fraizer slugged a two-run homer in the seventh inning and Alika Williams doubled and scored on an error in the ninth. Drake Fellows matched a season-high with 5.0 innings pitched despite allowing all the RailRiders' runs. Jarod Bayless and Cam Sanders followed Fellows with 3.0 innings of scoreless relief with four punchouts. Scott Effross allowed an unearned run in the ninth but picked up the save for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

YOU CAN PUT IT ON THE BOARD: The Indians' offense has not been shut out in 70 games since May 26 vs. Nashville, their longest string of games in a single season with at least one run since 2013, when they plated a run in 76 straight games from April 21-July 8. Across this run, the Indians rank among International League teams in hits (2nd, 645), triples (2nd, 19), batting average (3rd, 272) and on-base percentage (3rd, 355). The Indians' streak is the second longest by an International League team this season, only trailing Durham's 77-game run from April 24-July 27. Indy is the only International League team to have not been shut out since May 26 and join El Paso and Oklahoma City to make up the three Triple-A teams that have not been blanked in that span.

ILIKE ALIKA: Alika Williams went 2-for-4 with a double and a run scored on Sunday. Williams has hit safely in 10 of 12 games in August and in 13 of 16 games since July 26. In August, he is hitting .326 (14-for-43) with two doubles, four homers and nine RBI while ranking among International League hitters in slugging percentage (9th, .651) and OPS (10th, 1.051). Williams' four home runs in August are his most in a calendar month since July 2023 with Indianapolis (4) and is one shy of his career high in a month, set in June 2022 with High-A Bowling Green.

FLAVA FRAIZ: Matt Fraizer extended his hitting streak to a season-high eight games since Aug. 9 with a two-run home run on Sunday. Across his streak, Fraizer leads qualified International League hitters in hits (14) and ranks third in batting average (.424) while racking up two doubles, a triple, six RBI, three stolen bases and a 1.093 OPS. On Tuesdays this season, Fraizer leads IL hitters (min. 10 PA) with a .647 batting average (11-for-17) and ranks fourth with a 1.566 OPS. Additionally, in 25 road games, he is hitting .323 (30-for-93) with seven doubles, a triple, a homer, nine RBI, seven stolen bases and a .840 OPS.

RIDICULOUS-NICK: Nick Solak recorded a two-RBI double on Sunday, extending his hitting streak to nine games since Aug. 8. He has hit safely in 42 of his last 47 games since June 12 (1) vs. St. Paul and in 73 of 84 games overall this season with Indy. On the season, Solak leads qualified full-season minor league hitters in batting average (.354, 112-for-316), ranks fourth in on-base percentage (.430) and seventh in OPS (.958). His batting average is the highest by a qualified Indians hitter to this point in the season since at least 2005, surpassing Miguel Andujar's .349 clip through Aug. 18, 2023. In the first inning, he ranks third among full-season farmhands (min. 70 PA) with a .403 batting average (27-for-67) and a 1.080 OPS. Additionally, he leads full-season hitters with a .342 batting average (52-for-152) in two-strike counts and ranks second with a .886 OPS.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians and Syracuse Mets begin a six-game series at NBT Bank Stadium tonight at 6:35 PM. It's the first time the two teams have met since July 25, 2019, at Syracuse. Indy has won 7 of its last 10 series openers since June 10 and have not dropped a series opener on the road since the first game out of the All-Star break on July 18 at Nashville. Southpaw Hunter Barco is set to make his 16th start of the season for Indy and his first career start against Syracuse. He will be opposed by RHP Brandon Sproat, the Mets' No. 5 overall prospect according to MLB Pipeline, who is also making his first career start against the Indians. In eight starts since June 28 (1), Sproat has earned a 4-1 record with a 2.13 ERA (10er/42.1ip), 49 strikeouts and a 0.90 WHIP.

BARCO BUMP DAY: Hunter Barco, MiLB's No. 86 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, is coming off two consecutive starts of 4.0 scoreless innings. Across those two starts, on Aug. 7 vs. Omaha and Aug. 13 at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, he's allowed four hits while recording nine punchouts and holding opponents to a WHIP of 0.63. With another scoreless outing, he will be the first Indians southpaw to toss three straight scoreless starts since Zach Matson tossed three straight as an opener from June 29-July 16, 2022. If he does so in 40 innings or more, he will be the first Indians lefty since at least 2005 to twirl three consecutive starts of 4.0-plus scoreless innings. In nine second half starts since June 23, Barco ranks among Triple-A pitchers with at least 35.0 innings pitched in opponent's batting average (4th, .187), opponent's OPS (5th, .587) and ERA (8th, 2.79, 12er/38.2ip). He has held right-handed hitters to a .164 batting average (22-for-134) on the season, which is the lowest mark by a left-handed pitcher with at least 130 at bats against righties.

ON THIS DATE IN 1954: Indians southpaw Herb Score set the American Association all-time strikeout record with a 12-strikeout, complete-game effort at Columbus, boosting his season total to 269. The former record of 264 punchouts was held by Columbus' Charlie "Heine" Berger in 1906. Score would go on to strike out an American Association record 330 batters, a record that still stands.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Hunter Barco: The southpaw ranks as Pittsburgh's No. 4 prospect and Minor League Baseball's No. 86 overall prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

Historic Zeroes: Barco did not allow a run in his six starts with Double-A Altoona, totaling 25.2 consecutive scoreless innings to begin the season, marking the longest scoreless streak in Curve history.

Last Outing: Barco blanked Scranton/Wilkes-Barre across 4.0 innings on 8/13, allowing three hits and no walks while striking out five. It was his second consecutive start of 4.0 scoreless innings after allowing one hit and one walk on 8/7 vs. Omaha.

Against the Mets: Tonight will mark Barco's first career start against Syracuse.

EAS Pitcher of the Month: Barco was awarded the 2025 Eastern League April Pitcher of the Month Award after leading the league (min. 20ip) in ERA (0.00, 20.2ip) and batting average against (.132, 9-for-68), while ranking second in WHIP (0.63) and tied for fourth in strikeouts (30).

Mowing Them Down: Barco finished his award-winning April with back-to-back eight-strikeout starts, the last of which came in just 3.0 innings of work on April 27 at Double-A Chesapeake. He became the first Pirates full-season farmhand to strike out eight or more batters in 3.0 innings or less since Osvaldo Bido also struck out eight in 3.0 innings vs. Triple-A Louisville on Aug. 4th, 2022.

Miscellaneous: Barco was selected by the Pirates in the second round (44th overall) of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Florida (Gainesville).
